What can I do this week to come to know God better?



FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

As we enjoy these two weeks of the Christmas season, when the Church gives us an extended period to give thanks to God for the birth of the Child Jesus and to praise Him for the Incarnation, it is good to reflect on Christmas traditions. One of the traditions is to sing Christmas carols. Most of us are familiar with "The Twelve Days of Christmas". However, perhaps you were not aware that the song contains much symbolism which points to a number of Christian teachings and doctrine. (cf. Fr. Hal Stockert, "The Twelve Days of Christmas, An Underground Catechism", <http://www.cin.org/twelvday.html>)

Off and on, from 1558 to 1829, Catholics in England were persecuted. For much of this period, it was against the law to be a Catholic. Many Catholic clergy and lay people were martyred. "The Twelve Days of Christmas" was written in England as a catechism song. The idea of the hymn was to assist young Catholics in learning about the Catholic faith, in the form of a type of memory aid. It was important that one memorized the truths of the faith rather than carry them around in a book or piece of paper on your person because if you were caught with anything in writing about the Catholic faith, it could be used as evidence against you and could lead to you being imprisoned, punished and even put to death.

Each of the gifts in the song points to a different Catholic teaching. The "true love" mentioned in the song refers to God. The "me" who receives the gifts refers to every baptized person. The partridge in a pear tree is Jesus Christ, the Son of God. In the song, Christ is symbolically presented as a mother partridge which feigns injury to decoy predators from her helpless nestlings, much in memory of the expression of Christ's sadness over the fate of Jerusalem: "Jerusalem! Jerusalem! How often would I have sheltered thee under my wings, as a hen does her chicks, but thou wouldst not have it so..." (Lk 13:34)

The other symbols point to the following aspects of Catholic doctrine:

- 2 Turtle Doves = the Old and New Testaments
- 3 French Hens = Faith, Hope and Charity, the theological virtues
- 4 Calling Birds = the four Gospels and/or the four Evangelists
- 5 Golden Rings = The first five books of the Old Testament, the "Pentateuch"
- 6 Geese A-laying = the six days of creation
- 7 Swans A-swimming = the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, the seven sacraments
- 8 Maids A-milking = the eight beatitudes
- 9 Ladies Dancing = the nine fruits of the Holy Spirit
- 10 Lords A-leaping = the Ten Commandments
- 11 Pipers Piping = the eleven faithful apostles
- 12 Drummers Drumming = the twelve points of

doctrine in the Apostle's Creed

As we enjoy this beautiful season of Christmas, I encourage you to sing some Christmas carols with family members, loved ones and friends. Singing is good for the soul. And singing about the gift of the birth of baby Jesus during this time is most appropriate!

May you have most blessed Christmas season!

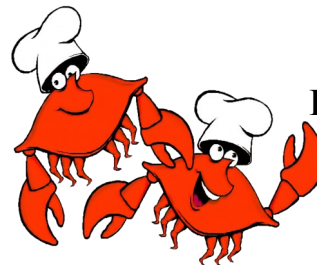
Job Opening for a Full Time Maintenance Worker

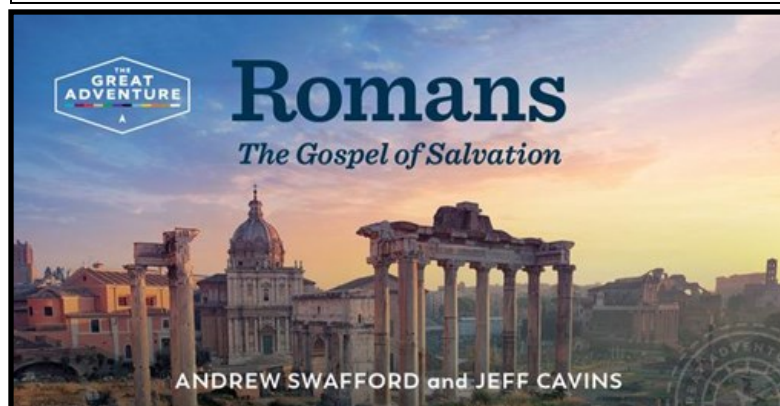

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Esta semana me gustaría compartir con Ustedes una parte de la homilía di Epifanía 2014 del Papa Francisco:

Los Magos consiguieron superar aquel momento crítico de oscuridad en el palacio de Herodes, porque creyeron en las Escrituras, en la palabra de los profetas que señalaba Belén como el lugar donde había de nacer el Mesías. Así escaparon al letargo de la noche del mundo, reemprendieron su camino y de pronto vieron nuevamente la estrella, y el Evangelio dice que se llenaron de «inmensa alegría» (Mt 2,10). Esa estrella que no se veía en la oscuridad de la mundanidad de aquel palacio.

Un aspecto de la luz que nos guía en el camino de la fe es también la santa “astucia”. Es también una virtud, la santa “astucia”. Se trata de esa sagacidad espiritual que nos permite reconocer los peligros y evitarlos. Los Magos supieron usar esta luz de “astucia” cuando, de regreso a su tierra, decidieron no pasar por el palacio tenebroso de Herodes, sino marchar por otro camino. Estos sabios venidos de Oriente nos enseñan a no caer en las asechanzas de las tinieblas y a defendernos de la oscuridad que pretende cubrir nuestra vida. Ellos, con esta santa “astucia”, han protegido la fe. Y también nosotros debemos proteger la fe. Protegerla de esa oscuridad. Esa oscuridad que a menudo se disfraza incluso de luz. Porque el demonio, dice san Pablo, muchas veces se viste de ángel de luz. Y entonces es necesaria la santa “astucia”, para proteger la fe, protegerla de los cantos de las sirenas, que te dicen: «Mira, hoy debemos hacer esto, aquello...» Pero la fe es una gracia, es un don. Y a nosotros nos corresponde protegerla con la santa “astucia”, con la oración, con el amor, con la caridad. Es necesario acoger en nuestro corazón la luz de Dios y, al mismo tiempo, practicar aquella astucia espiritual que sabe armonizar la sencillez con la sagacidad, como Jesús pide a sus discípulos: «Sean sagaces como serpientes y simples como palomas» (Mt 10,16).

En esta fiesta de la Epifanía, que nos recuerda la manifestación de Jesús a la humanidad en el rostro de un Niño, sintamos cerca a los Magos, como sabios compañeros de camino. Su ejemplo nos anima a levantar los ojos a la estrella y a seguir los grandes deseos de nuestro corazón. Nos enseñan a no contentarnos con una vida mediocre, de “poco calado”, sino a dejarnos fascinar siempre por la bondad, la verdad, la belleza... por Dios, que es todo eso en modo siempre mayor. Y nos enseñan a no dejarnos engañar por las apariencias, por aquello que para el mundo es gran-

de, sabio, poderoso. No nos podemos quedar ahí. Es necesario proteger la fe. Es muy importante en este tiempo: proteger la fe. Tenemos que ir más allá, más allá de la oscuridad, más allá de la atracción de las sirenas, más allá de la mundanidad, más allá de tantas modernidades que existen hoy, ir hacia Belén, allí donde en la sencillez de una casa de la periferia, entre una mamá y un papá llenos de amor y de fe, resplandece el Sol que nace de lo alto, el Rey del universo. A ejemplo de los Magos, con nuestras pequeñas luces busquemos la Luz y protejamos la fe. Así sea.
