How can I allow God to direct my actions this week?



FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

As I mentioned in last week's column, January 22nd marked the 49th anniversary of the Roe v. Wade, the Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion in our country. Last May, Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone of San Francisco, published a pastoral letter entitled: "Before I Formed You in the Womb I Knew You". For this weekend's column, I would like to include an excerpt from the Archbishop's pastoral letter for our consideration and reflection.

Archbishop Cordileone begins his letter with these words:

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I dedicated you, a prophet to the nations I appointed you." (Jer 1:5)

These words from the Book of the Prophet Jeremiah speak profoundly and movingly to the great love and purpose for which God brings each one of us into the world from the first moment of our existence. Sadly, though, in today's "throw-away culture"—as Pope Francis so vividly refers to it—the dignity of each and every human person is not accorded the value inherent to it. In a culture that values profit, power, prestige, and pleasure over all else, many people end up being victims of this throw-away culture, from struggling immigrants and working poor to the elderly and physically challenged. This throw-away mindset also fuels the serious damage inflicted on the environment, which especially adversely impacts the poor. But when it is an innocent human being's very existence—a moral absolute—that is thrown away, it is a sign that a society has truly become severely disordered. Such is the plight of the unborn and the state of our society.

In 2023 our nation will mark the fiftieth anniversary of the infamous *Roe* decision. Generations of Americans have now grown up not knowing what it is like to live in a country that values and protects the lives of the smallest, most defenseless and vulnerable members of its society. Fifty years, over 60,000,000 deaths, and many more millions of scarred lives later, it is time for a frank and honest reassessment. Abortion not only kills the child, it deeply wounds the woman. How could it not? The maternal instinct is very powerful: a mother will go to great lengths to protect her child. Indeed, how often have those of us in Church ministry heard the lament from post-abortive women, "I didn't want to go through with it, but I felt like I had no choice"? This lament exposes the lie of the "pro-choice" slogan.

This is especially a time for us Catholics, whose faith calls us to advocate for the universal good of a consistent ethic of life, in every stage and in every condition, to call our country back to respect for human life. And this is

especially so for Catholics who are prominent in all walks of public life—entertainment, media, politics, education, the corporate world, and so forth—as they have such a powerful influence on shaping the attitudes and practices of people in our nation.

Abortion is the axe laid to the roots of the tree of human rights: when our culture encourages the violation of life at its youngest and most vulnerable condition, other ethical norms cannot stand for long. In this pastoral letter, then, I would like to address four topics: the necessity for Catholics and all people of good will to understand how gravely evil abortion is; how to avoid sinful cooperation in this evil; how these principles apply to the question of Catholics and the reception of Holy Communion; and the special responsibility that Catholics prominent in public life have with regard to the common good. The letter is thus structured in four sections, corresponding to each of these four considerations. I begin with principles of law and science because abortion is not a "Christian" or "Catholic" issue: the dignity of the human person is a value that is, or should be, affirmed by us all.

May we ponder these words by Archbishop Cordileone and ask God to encourage and strengthen us so that we can be defenders of and witness to the truth, beauty and goodness human life in all its stages. May you have a blessed week!

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Como mencioné en la columna de la semana pasada, el 22 de enero marcó el 49 aniversario de Roe v. Wade, la decisión de la Corte Suprema que legalizó el aborto en nuestro país. El pasado mes de mayo, el Arzobispo Salvatore Cordileone de San Francisco, publicó una carta pastoral titulada: “Antes de Formarte en el Seno de tu Madre, Ya te Conocía”. Para la columna de este fin de semana, me gustaría incluir este resumen ejecutivo de la carta pastoral del Arzobispo para nuestra consideración y reflexión.

El Arzobispo Cordileone comienza con estas palabras:

“Antes de formarte en el seno de tu madre, ya te conocía; antes de que tú nacieras, yo te consagré, y te destiné a ser profeta de las naciones” (Jer 1:5).

El joven Jeremías oyó al Señor hablarle estas palabras hace más de 2500 años. En estos tiempos en que vivimos, la lacra del aborto ignora la realidad de que el ser humano está hecho a imagen y semejanza de Dios, conocido y amado por él. Esta carta pastoral se dirige a todos los católicos, pero especialmente a los católicos de la vida pública, llamando a una profunda reflexión sobre el mal del aborto y sobre el significado de recibir la Santa Comunión, el Pan de Vida. Esta carta contiene cuatro puntos centrales:

1. *La gravedad del mal del aborto:* La ciencia enseña que la vida humana comienza en la concepción. El fin de la vida mediante el aborto hiera profundamente a la mujer y destruye los cimientos de una sociedad justa. El aborto es la “prioridad preeminente” porque el derecho a la vida es el fundamento de todos los demás derechos. Como católicos debemos ser la voz de los sin voz y de los sin poder; no hay nadie más indefenso que un niño en el vientre materno.

2. *Cooperación en el mal moral:* ¿Quién tiene la culpa cuando se produce un aborto? El aborto nunca es únicamente el acto de la madre. Los que matan o ayudan a matar al niño están directamente implicados en la realización de un acto gravemente malo. Quien presione o anime a la madre a abortar, quien pague por ello o proporcione ayuda financiera a las organizaciones que practican abortos, o quien apoye a los candidatos porque promueven la legislación pro-aborto, también cooperan en mayor o menor medida en un grave mal moral.

3. *El significado de elegir recibir la Sagrada Eucaristía:* La Iglesia ha enseñado sistemáticamente durante 2000 años que quienes reciben la Eucaristía están profesando públicamente su fe católica y se esfuerzan seriamente por vivir según las enseñanzas morales de la Iglesia. Los que rechazan la enseñanza de la Iglesia sobre la santidad de la vida humana y aquellos que no buscan vivir de acuerdo con esa enseñanza se colocan en contradicción con la comunión de la Iglesia, y en consecuencia no deben recibir el sacramento de esa comunión, la Sagrada Eucaristía. Todos fallamos de varias maneras, pero hay una gran diferencia entre luchar para vivir de acuerdo con las enseñanzas de la Iglesia y rechazar tales enseñanzas.

4. *Las responsabilidades de los católicos en la vida pública:* De los tres puntos mencionados arriba se sigue que los católicos destacados en la vida pública tienen una responsabilidad especial de dar testimonio de la plenitud de la enseñanza de la Iglesia. Además de su propio bien espiritual, también existe el peligro del escándalo: es decir, por su falso testimonio, otros católicos pueden llegar a dudar de la enseñanza de la Iglesia sobre el aborto, la Sagrada Eucaristía, o de ambas. Esto es cada vez más difícil en nuestra época.

Todos estamos llamados a la conversión, no sólo los católicos destacados en la vida pública. Comprendamos lo que está en juego y trabajemos juntos en la construcción de una cultura de la vida. A los que necesitan escuchar este mensaje con claridad: Aléjense del mal y regresen a casa a la plenitud de su fe católica. Los esperamos con los brazos abiertos para recibirlos de vuelta con alegría.

Meditemos estas palabras del arzobispo Cordileone y pidamos a Dios que nos anime y fortalezca para que podamos ser defensores y testigos de la verdad, la belleza y la bondad de la vida humana en todas sus etapas. ¡Que tenga una bendecida semana!


