FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

There is no ignoring Jesus. Wherever he goes, he compels a reaction. In the Gospel passage from this Sunday's reading, we see Jesus enter the synagogue in Capernaum. This city along the shores of the Sea of Galilee, is the scene of some of Jesus' most powerful encounters: He heals the mother-in-law of St. Peter, chooses the first men who will become the Twelve Apostles, and most strikingly, it's in Capernaum that Jesus teaches his most controversial doctrine – the True Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Notice what immediately happens when Jesus walks through the doors of that packed synagogue. As soon as he begins to teach, **“a man with an unclean spirit”, cries out, “What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are – the Holy One of God!”** (Cf. Mark 1: 21-24). He recognizes precisely the divinity of Jesus Christ. He is not simply a wise teacher or someone who said nice, interesting things. No. Rather, this man sees God in the flesh. He is in the mighty presence of the Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity.

Jesus, seeing the man, Our Lord commands the evil spirit to **“come out of him!”** (Cf. Mark 1: 25). This dramatic scene shocked the entire crowd. But we must ask ourselves, how did this man get an evil spirit within him in the first place? Here, Jesus touches upon an important subject in the spiritual life, namely, demonic possession. How does a person get possessed? Does it happen randomly? Is it contagious like the flu? Can I catch it in church if I am sitting next to someone with a demon in the pew next to me? The answer is no. Full blown, demonic possession is actually quite rare. It's a decision we make when we open ourselves to the occult. For example, common dark practices such as consulting with so-called psychics, tarot cards readings, crystals and the ouija board are popular ways people get entangled with the demonic world. This is a direct violation of the First Commandment, to have no other gods besides the True God. Oftentimes, these psychics will use Catholic imagery of Our Blessed Mother and saints in their shops, in order to mislead Catholics.

If you have ever participated in these practices, you have opened a window, like this man did in the Gospel reading. To shut it closed, go to confession immediately.

CUARTO DOMINGO ORDINARIO

28 de enero de 2024



DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

No se puede ignorar a Jesús. Dondequiera que va, obliga a una reacción. En el pasaje evangélico de la lectura de este domingo, vemos a Jesús entrar en la sinagoga de Cafarnaúm. Esta ciudad a orillas del Mar de Galilea, es el escenario de algunos de los encuentros más poderosos de Jesús: Él sana a la suegra de San Pedro, elige a los primeros hombres que se convertirán en los Doce Apóstoles y, lo que es más sorprendente, es en Cafarnaúm donde Jesús enseña su doctrina más controvertida: la Verdadera Presencia de Jesucristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Fíjate en lo que sucede inmediatamente cuando Jesús entra por las puertas de esa sinagoga llena de gente. Tan pronto como comienza a enseñar, **"un hombre poseído por un espíritu inmundo"**, exclama: **"¿Qué quieres tú con nosotros, Jesús de Nazaret? ¿Has venido a acabar con nosotros? ¿Ya sé quién eres, el Santo de Dios!"** (Cf. Mc 1, 21-24). Reconoce precisamente la divinidad de Jesucristo. No es simplemente un maestro sabio o alguien que dijo cosas agradables e interesantes. No. Más bien, este hombre ve a Dios en carne. Está en la poderosa presencia de la Segunda Persona de la Santísima Trinidad.

Jesús, al ver al hombre, Nuestro Señor ordena al espíritu maligno diciendo, **"Cállate y sal de él"**. (cf. Mc 1, 25). Esta dramática escena conmocionó a toda la multitud. Pero debemos preguntarnos, en primer lugar, ¿cómo este hombre consiguió un espíritu maligno dentro de él? Aquí, Jesús toca un tema importante en la vida espiritual, a saber, la posesión demoníaca. ¿Cómo se posee una persona? ¿Sucede al azar? ¿Es contagiosa como la gripe? ¿Puedo contagiarme en la iglesia si estoy sentado en la banca al lado de alguien con un demonio? La respuesta es no. La posesión demoníaca total es en realidad bastante rara. Es una decisión que tomamos cuando nos abrimos a lo oculto. Por ejemplo, las prácticas oscuras comunes, como consultar con los llamados psíquicos, las lecturas de cartas del tarot, los cristales y la tabla ouija, son formas populares en que las personas se enredan con el mundo demoníaco. Esto es

una violación directa del Primer Mandamiento, no tener otros dioses además del Dios Verdadero. A menudo, estos psíquicos usarán imágenes católicas de Nuestra Santísima Madre y santos en sus tiendas, con el fin de engañar a los católicos.

Si alguna vez has participado en estas prácticas, has abierto una ventana, como lo hizo este hombre en la lectura del Evangelio. Para cerrarlo, inmediatamente ve a confesión.


