FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

The Epiphany is a significant feast day in the Christian calendar, marking the revelation of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, represented by the visit of the Magi (the Three Wise Men or Three Kings) to the infant Jesus. The word "epiphany" means manifestation or revelation, signifying the moment when Jesus's divinity is recognized and revealed beyond the confines of Judaism. The inclusion of the Magi from the East demonstrates God's universal plan of salvation. This celebration emphasizes that Jesus's birth isn't limited to a specific group or culture but is intended for all humanity. It challenges us to embrace the dignity and worth of *every* person as part of God's plan, who desires "that all be saved" (Cf. 1 Timothy 2:3-4).

The journey of the Magi represents a quest for meaning and truth that is at the heart of being alive. We all in one way or another, look for a greater purpose in life. The Magi that came to visit Jesus embody this desire, as they came searching for the baby Jesus. The beauty of Christianity is that we no longer have to grope desperately in the darkness all alone in the quagmire of confusion that reigns all around us. "The light came into the world", as we heard in the Gospel reading on Christmas morning. This same light, represented by the star in the sky that the Magi eagerly followed to Bethlehem. It was here they encountered the living God.

As we all know and see around us if we have eyes to see, proclaiming Jesus Christ is a great challenge in our culture today, which studies show is growing more and more godless with each passing year. Some sectors of society are growing blatantly hostile to traditional Christian teaching. Spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ, takes grit to stand against the storm. Jesus knows this. In the Gospel of Luke, our Lord takes Peter aside and speaks to him from the heart. He knows he's about to send Peter out into the world on an impossible mission: "Simon, Simon (another name for Peter), behold, Satan has demanded to sift you like wheat; but I have prayed for you, that your faith will not fail; and you, when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers." (Cf. Luke 22:31-32). We need not be afraid. Like the Magi, we have the light to lead us. The star that guided the Magi symbolizes divine guidance and wisdom. It's a reminder that in our lives, Jesus provides direction and wisdom if we remain open and attentive. Reflecting on the Epiphany encourages us to seek Christ's guidance in navigating life's complexities. The Magi returned home transformed by their encounter with Jesus. Similarly, the Epiphany challenges us to carry the light of Christ into the world,

sharing the Good News and embodying Christ's love and compassion in our interactions with others. Ultimately, the Epiphany celebration invites profound introspection about our relationship with Jesus Christ. It calls for recognizing Christ's presence in our lives, surrendering ourselves to His will, and being bearers of His light and love in a world that seeks truth and meaning.

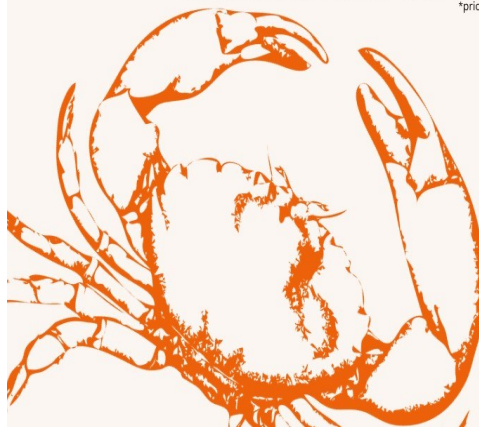

SOLEMNIDAD DE LA EPIFANÍA DEL SEÑOR

7 de enero de 2024

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

La Epifanía es una fiesta importante en el calendario cristiano, marcando la revelación de Jesucristo a los gentiles, representada por la visita de los Reyes Magos al niño Jesús. La palabra "epifanía" significa manifestación o revelación, y significa el momento en que la divinidad de Jesús es reconocida y revelada más allá de los confines del judaísmo. La inclusión de los Magos de Oriente demuestra el plan universal de Dios de la salvación. Esta celebración enfatiza que el nacimiento de Jesús no se limita a un grupo o cultura específica, sino que está destinado a toda la humanidad. Nos desafía el aceptar la dignidad y el valor de cada persona como parte del plan de Dios, que desea **"que todos los hombres se salven"** (Cf. 1 Timoteo 2,3-4).

El viaje de los Reyes Magos representa una búsqueda de significado y verdad que está en el corazón, de estar vivo. Todos, de una forma u otra, buscamos un propósito mayor en la vida. Los Reyes Magos que vinieron a visitar al niño Jesús encarnan este deseo, ya que vinieron en busca del niño Jesús. La belleza del cristianismo es que ya no tenemos que andar a tientas desesperadamente en la oscuridad, solos en el atolladero de confusión que reina a nuestro alrededor. "La luz vino al mundo", como escuchamos en la lectura del Evangelio la mañana de Navidad. Esta misma luz, representada por la estrella en el cielo que los Reyes Magos siguieron entusiasmadamente hasta Belén. Fue aquí donde encontraron al Dios vivo.

Como todos sabemos y vemos a nuestro alrededor, si tenemos ojos para ver, proclamar a Jesucristo es un gran desafío en nuestra cultura actual, que según los estudios se vuelve cada vez más pagana con cada año que pasa. Algunos sectores de la sociedad se están volviendo abiertamente hostiles a la enseñanza cristiana tradicional. Difundir las Buenas Nuevas de Jesucristo requiere valor para resistir la tormenta. Jesús lo sabe. En el evangelio de Lucas, nuestro Señor llevo a Pedro aparte y le habla desde el corazón. Sabe que está a punto de enviar a Pedro al mundo en una misión imposible: **"¡Simón, Simón! Mira que Satanás ha pedido permiso para sacudirlos a ustedes como trigo que se limpia; pero yo he rogado por ti para que tu fe no se venga abajo. Y tú, cuando hayas vuelto, ten-**

drás que fortalecer a tus hermanos." (Cf. Lucas 22:31-32). No debemos tener miedo. Al igual que los Reyes Magos, tenemos la luz que nos guía. La estrella que guio a los Reyes Magos simboliza la orientación y la sabiduría divina. Es un recordatorio de que, en nuestras vidas, Jesús brinda dirección y sabiduría si permanecemos abiertos y atentos. Reflexionar sobre la Epifanía nos anima a buscar la guía de Cristo para afrontar las complejidades de la vida. Los Reyes Magos regresaron a casa transformados por su encuentro con Jesús. De manera similar, la Epifanía nos desafía a llevar la luz de Cristo al mundo, compartiendo las Buenas Nuevas y encarnando el amor y la compasión de Cristo en nuestras interacciones con los demás. En definitiva, la celebración de la Epifanía invita a una profunda introspección sobre nuestra relación con Jesucristo. Exige reconocer la presencia de Cristo en nuestras vidas, entregarnos a su voluntad y ser portadores de su luz y amor en un mundo que busca verdad y significado.

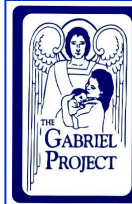
