FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

Perhaps a number of you noticed that three St. Mary's parishioners were featured in the most recent issue of the *Catholic Herald* from the Diocese of Sacramento. In an article highlighting what a couple of parishes are doing during the nationwide yearlong effort called "Walking with Moms in Need: A Year of Service," Debra Thomas, Respect Life Coordinator for St. Mary's spoke about the importance of being a voice for those without an audible voice. Debra noted: "We have to be a voice for voiceless, speaking out for the unborn especially, who have no voice from the womb. We speak out on behalf of people who are suffering. We trust that God gives us people who will listen, and we speak freely as opportunities arise. We also pray that God shows us where he wants to invest our time, talent and resources." (CH, p. 22) As the article notes, our Parish Respect Life Committee is guided by the Pastoral Plan for Pro-life put forth by the U.S. bishops, as well as Bishop Jaime Soto's four point diocesan plan which includes pastoral care, prayer and worship, advocacy and education and formation. In another article featuring "Project Gabriel," Yolanda Garcia-Martinez and Aleyda Salvatore described our parish's effort to reach out to pregnant women in need. Yolanda noted that participants in Project Gabriel strive to "walk the journey with the moms. Maybe it's getting groceries, or finding items for their apartment or a comforter for a child's bedroom." I encourage you to read this month's issue of *Catholic Herald*. If you do not receive the magazine in the mail, it can also be found on-line on the diocesan website at: www.scd.org. During this "Respect Life Month," let us continue to pray and work so that a culture of life may reign in our community, country and world. Please remember that one very concrete way to pray for life and to witness to life is to pray the Planned Parenthood in Fairfield. Please find more information about this effort elsewhere in the bulletin. May you have a most blessed week!

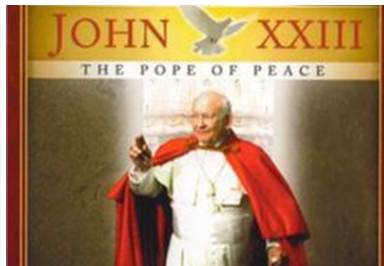

Tal vez algunos de ustedes se dieron cuenta de que tres feligreses de Santa María fueron presentados en la publicación más reciente del Heraldo Católico de la Diócesis de Sacramento. En un artículo que destaca lo que un par de parroquias están haciendo durante este año por un esfuerzo nacional llamado "Caminando con Madres necesitadas: un Año de Servicio", Debra Thomas, Coordinadora de Respeto por la vida de la Parroquia de San María, habló sobre la importancia de ser una voz para aquellos sin una voz audible. Debra señaló: "Tenemos que ser una voz para los que no tienen voz, hablando especialmente por los aun no nacidos, que no tienen voz desde el vientre. Hablamos en nombre de las personas que están sufriendo. Confiamos en que Dios nos de personas que escuchen, y hablemos libremente a medida que surgen oportunidades. También oremos para que Dios nos muestre dónde quiere invertir nuestro tiempo, talento y recursos". (CH, p. 22) Como señala el artículo, nuestro Comité de Respeto por la Vida de la Parroquia se guía por el Plan Pastoral Pro-Vida presentado por los obispos de los Estados Unidos, así como el plan diocesano de cuatro puntos del Obispo Jaime Soto que incluye el cuidado pastoral, la oración y culto, apoyo, y la educación y formación. En otro artículo presentan al "Proyecto Gabriel", en el cual Yolanda García-Martínez y Aleyda Salvatore describieron el esfuerzo de nuestra parroquia para ayudar a las mujeres embarazadas en necesidad. Yolanda señaló que los participantes en el Proyecto Gabriel se esfuerzan por "caminar la jornada junto con las madres. Tal vez es conseguir comestibles, o encontrar cosas para su apartamento o un edredón para el dormitorio de un niño". (CH, p. 27)

SANTA TERESA DE ÁVILA (1515-1582) 15 de octubre

Teresa nació en Ávila, España, en una familia rica y de fe profunda. A los siete años quería ser mártir por amor a Dios. No obstante, a los 12 soñaba con el amor y el romance para su vida, pero unos años después, la muerte de su madre y una enfermedad le hicieron cambiar. A los 20 años se hizo carmelita



y 18 años después, debido a la comodidad de la vida de monasterio, apoyada en una visión mística, consideró necesaria una reforma. Bajo la llamada de Dios y la ayuda de su director espiritual, san Juan de la Cruz, junto con otras dieciséis hermanas emprendió la reforma de la Orden Carmelita formando una comunidad más estricta en la que se vivía en absoluta pobreza, se comía del trabajo fruto de la costura, se

vivía en oración y se dormía en petates. Siendo superiora fue inigualable en el amor y el servicio a la comunidad. Sus escritos, así como su experiencia mística, fueron profundos. Para ella, "sólo Dios basta", nada más. Fue la primera mujer en ser declarada Doctora de la Iglesia.

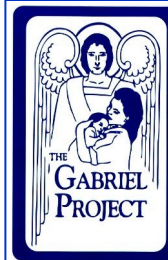
