When do I resist conforming my will to God's?



FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Our relationship with God requires tremendous energy and effort. As finite, fallen creatures, we have a limited amount of strength required to strive for God. In one dramatic moment, the great 16th century Spanish mystic cried out, "Oh, how painful it is for a soul who finds itself in this stage to have to return to dealing with everything, to behold and see this face of this so poorly harmonized life, to waste time in taking care of bodily needs, sleeping and eating! Everything wearies it; it doesn't know how to flee; it sees itself captures and in chains." Our attachments to the world can consume vital spiritual vigor, that otherwise could be spent more worthwhile on things that lead us to deepen our desire for him. She experienced firsthand as Teresa advanced in her prayer life. She noticed as her "prayer was increasing" that a ferocious battle was underfoot which she described as "some great good or some terrible evil." Attempting to strengthen her resolve she attempted to purge all evil thoughts and the near occasion of sin. She understood her attachments to the world would be a cause for consternation: "Resolved to strive for this purity of conscience and beseeching the Lord to help me, I saw, after trying it for some days, that my soul didn't have the strength to reach such perfection alone on account of some attachments that, though in themselves were not bad, were enough to spoil everything."

Once a person severs all disordered ties to the created things of this world, the soul is now primed to grow in his desire for God and "(become) ablaze with burning love for God". God now has free reign in their soul and is able draw him more intimately into communion with him, free from all other finite distractions "because there is no impediment from outside, the soul is alone with its God; it is well prepared for this enkindling." God, so to speak, has the soul's undivided attention. Once this point is reached, a soul abhors any separation from the beloved and shuns sin, which can sever communion with God. In this state of grace, all that the person does in their life, "When practiced with a pure conscience, such detachment must be what most joins the soul to God. There is no need to point this out because if the detachment is true it seems to me impossible that one offends the Lord."

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Nuestra relación con Dios requiere energía y un tremendo esfuerzo. Como criaturas caídas y finitas, tenemos una cantidad limitada de fortaleza requerida para esforzarnos por Dios. En un momento dramático, la gran mística española del siglo XVI exclamó: “¡Ay, ¡qué doloroso es para un alma que se encuentra en esta etapa tener que volver a ocuparse de todo, contemplar y ver este rostro de esta tan mal armonizada vida, perder el tiempo en atender las necesidades del cuerpo, dormir y comer! Todo lo cansa; no sabe huir; se ve apresado y encadenado.” Nuestro apego al mundo puede consumir el vigor espiritual vital, que de otro modo podría usarse más en cosas que nos lleven a profundizar nuestro deseo por Él. Experimentó de primera mano cómo Teresa avanzaba en su vida de oración. Notó que a medida que su “oración aumentaba” se estaba gestando una feroz batalla que describió como “un gran bien o un terrible mal”. Tratando de fortalecer su resolución, trató de purgar todos los malos pensamientos y la ocasión cercana del pecado. Comprendido que sus apegos al mundo serían motivo de consternación: “Resuelta a luchar por esta pureza de conciencia y suplicando al Señor que me ayudara, vi, después de intentarlo algunos días, que mi alma no tenía fuerzas para llegar a tal perfección solo por algunos apegos que, aunque en sí mismos no eran malos, bastaban para estropearlo todo.”

Una vez que una persona corta todos los lazos con las cosas desordenadas de este mundo, el alma ahora está preparada para crecer en su deseo por Dios y “(estar) ardiendo con un amor ardiente por Dios”. Dios ahora tiene rienda libre en su alma y puede atraerlo más íntimamente a la comunión con Él, libre de todas las demás distracciones finitas “porque no hay impedimento externo, el alma está sola con su Dios; está bien preparada para el alumbramiento.” Dios, por así decirlo, tiene toda la atención del alma. Una vez que se alcanza este punto, el alma aborrece cualquier separación del amado y evita el pecado, el cual puede romper la comunión con Dios. En este estado de gracia, todo lo que la persona hace en su vida, “cuando se practica con conciencia pura, tal desprendimiento debe ser lo que más une el alma a Dios. No hace falta señalar esto porque si el desapego es verdadero me parece imposible que se ofenda al Señor.”
