FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

Ten or so days ago, from October 13th to 15th, I participated in a "NFP Leaders' Summit" in Baltimore, Maryland, organized by Dr. Theresa Notare, the Assistant Director for the Natural Family Planning Program at the *Secretariat for Laity, Marriage, Family Life and Youth of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops*. That's a mouthful, I know. Basically, the Summit was an opportunity to bring together a number of different organizations throughout the country whose goal is to promote Natural Family Planning (NFP). Therefore, organizations which promote the education of the different NFP methods, such as Billings, *FertilityCare* and Sympto-Thermal, were represented as well as groups which exist to promote NFP in general, such as Natural Womanhood, TeenStar and the California Association of Natural Family Planning (CANFP). Sheila St. John, Executive Director of CANFP, and I, as President of CANFP, were invited to participate on account of CANFP's long track record of bringing NFP folks together in California.

Gathering all these groups and having them explore ways to better work together to promote the good news of NFP in the U.S. was no small task. The mission of the Summit was stated as follows: "To engage NFP leadership in order to foster community, a shared purpose, and common language in NFP ministry that evangelizes and promotes God's design for married love." I would say, by and large, we got off to a good start in fulfilling this mission, but there is still more work to do. The statistics remind us that there is still much work to do. In 2017, of all the married couples in the U.S., with women from the ages of 15 to 44, 10.7% of the couples used the contraceptive pill, 30.5% sought permanent sterilization, 12.0% engaged in relations using a prophylactic and 1.3% of the couples used periodic abstinence, that is, some form of NFP. In 2017, of all the *Catholic* married couples in the U.S., with women from the ages of 15 to 44, 9.5% of the couples used the pill, 28.4% underwent sterilization, 12.70% engaged in prophylactic relations and 1.3% of the couples used periodic abstinence to space out the births of their children. (By the way, note that these percentages do not add up to 100%. Rather, they add up to around 50%. This points to the fact that about half of the married couples from this study did not use any kind of artificial birth control or NFP.) Sadly, as you can see, when it comes to NFP and contraception, there is barely any difference in the practice of the Catholic married couples and the non-Catholic married couples. In other words, married Catholics contracept and sterilize at the same high rate as the general married couple population.

As you know, at St. Mary's Parish, Andreyra Arevalo serves as our certified *FertilityCare* practitioner. She teaches couples who are preparing for the Sacrament of Marriage

and who are already married how to know their bodies and their fertility so that they can use that information, with God's help and guidance, to procreate and to space out the births of their children. Andreyra reported to me that over the last two fiscal years (Jul 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020 and Jul 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021), she gave 32 introductory sessions to the *FertilityCare* method and conducted 88 follow-up sessions with couples or clients. (At follow-up sessions, Andreyra meets with a couple or with an individual engaged or married woman to review their/her fertility chart in order to answer questions and to ensure that they are using the method properly and have confidence using it.) Over the last two fiscal years, Andreyra met with 30 new clients who completed at least one follow-up session. Finally, 49 new couples came to a *FertilityCare* introductory session over the last two years.

Still, we have more work to do in evangelizing and proclaiming the good news of Natural Family Planning! Moreover, as you have heard me say before, we all need to be engaged in this work. If we don't get God's plan for marriage and family right when it comes to making babies, many evils follow that are not good for our Church and for our world, such as abortion, divorce, pornography, same-sex relations and gender dysphoria, to name a few. I realize that is a sweeping statement. But think about it for a moment. At the heart of NFP and fertility appreciation are chastity, self-mastery, discipline and respect. We live in a "throw-away" culture, as Pope Francis says. When it comes to marriage and the family, we cannot afford to treat God's design for marriage, family and marital fruitfulness as something that is thrown away and cast off. God calls spouses, and all of us, to something much greater. When we live according to His design, we are not only more joyfully fulfilled in this life, but also we are preparing ourselves well for the life to come. I invite you to help me spread the good news of NFP.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

Hace unos diez días, del 13 al 15 de octubre, participé en una "Cumbre de Líderes de NFP" en Baltimore, Maryland, organizada por la Dra. Theresa Notare, Subdirectora del Programa de Planificación Familiar Natural en la Secretaría de Laicos, Matrimonio, Vida Familiar y Juventud de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos. Eso es un trabalenguas, lo sé. Básicamente, la Conferencia fue una oportunidad para reunir a un número de diferentes organizaciones en todo el país cuyo objetivo es promover la Planificación Familiar Natural (PFN). Por lo tanto, estuvieron representadas las organizaciones que promueven la educación de los diferentes métodos de PFN, como Billings, FertilityCare y Sympto-Thermal, fueron representados, así como los grupos que existen para promover la PFN en general, como Feminidad Natural, TeenStar y la Asociación de Planificación Familiar Natural de California (CANFP). Sheila St. John, Directora Ejecutiva de CANFP, y yo, como Presidente de CANFP, fuimos invitados a participar debido al largo historial de CANFP de reunir a la gente de NFP en California.

Reunir a todos estos grupos y para que exploren formas de trabajar mejor unidos para promover las buenas nuevas de la PFN en los Estados Unidos no fue una tarea fácil. La misión de la Cumbre se manifestó como lo sigue: "Involucrar al liderazgo de la PFN para fomentar la comunidad, un propósito compartido y un lenguaje común en el ministerio de la PFN que evangeliza y promueve el diseño de Dios para el amor de los matrimoniales". Yo diría que, en general, tuvimos un buen comienzo en el cumplimiento de esta misión, pero todavía hay mucho trabajo por hacer. Las estadísticas nos recuerdan que todavía queda mucho trabajo por hacer. En el 2017, de todas las parejas casadas en los Estados Unidos, con mujeres de 15 a 44 años, el 10.7% de las parejas usaron la píldora anticonceptiva, el 30.5% buscó la esterilización permanente, el 12.0% participó en relaciones usando un profiláctico y el 1.3% de las parejas usaron la abstinencia periódica, es decir, alguna forma de PFN. En el 2017, de todas las parejas *católicas* casadas en los Estados Unidos, con mujeres de 15 a 44 años, el 9.5% de las parejas usaron la píldora, el 28.4% se sometieron a esterilización, el 12.70% participaron en relaciones profilácticas y el 1.3% de las parejas usaron la abstinencia periódica para espaciar los nacimientos de sus hijos. (Por cierto, tenga en cuenta que estos porcentajes no suman el 100%. Más bien, suman alrededor del 50%. Esto indica al hecho de que aproximadamente la mitad de las parejas casadas de este estudio no usaron ningún tipo de planificación familiar artificial o PFN).

Lamentablemente, como pueden ver, cuando se trata de PFN y anticoncepción, apenas hay diferencia en la práctica de las parejas casadas católicas y las parejas casadas no católicas. En otras palabras, los católicos casados usan contraceptivos y esterilización al mismo índice que la población general de parejas casadas.

Como ustedes saben, en la Parroquia de Santa María, Andrey Arévalo sirve como nuestra practicante certificada de FertilityCare. Ella enseña a las parejas que se están preparando para el Sacramento del Matrimonio y parejas que ya están casadas cómo conocer sus cuerpos y su fertilidad para que puedan usar esa información, con la ayuda y guía de Dios, para procrear y espaciar los nacimientos de sus hijos. Andrey me informó que en los últimos dos años fiscales (del 1 de julio de 2019 al 30 de junio de 2020 y del 1 de julio de 2020 al 30 de junio de 2021), dio 32 sesiones introductorias al método FertilityCare y realizó 88 sesiones de seguimiento con parejas o clientes. (En las sesiones de seguimiento, Andrey se reúne con una pareja o con una mujer comprometida o casada para revisar su tabla de fertilidad con el fin de responder preguntas y asegurarse de que están utilizando el método correctamente y tenga confianza al usarlo). En los últimos dos años fiscales, Andrey se reunió con 30 nuevos clientes que completaron al menos una sesión de seguimiento. Finalmente, 49 nuevas parejas asistieron a una sesión introductoria de FertilityCare en los últimos dos años.

Aún así, ¡tenemos más trabajo por hacer para evangelizar y proclamar las buenas nuevas de la Planificación Familiar Natural! Además, como me han escuchado decir anteriormente, todos tenemos que colaborar en este trabajo. Si no entendemos bien el plan de Dios para el matrimonio y la familia cuando se trata de hacer bebés, siguen muchos males que no son buenos para nuestra Iglesia y para nuestro mundo, como el aborto, el divorcio, la pornografía, las relaciones entre personas del mismo sexo y la disforia de género, por nombrar algunos. Estoy consciente de que es una declaración radical. Pero piénselo por un momento. En el corazón de la PFN y la apreciación de la fertilidad están la castidad, el autodominio, la disciplina y el respeto. Vivimos en una cultura de "descarte", como dice el Papa Francisco. Cuando se trata del matrimonio y la familia, no podemos darnos el lujo de tratar el diseño de Dios para el matrimonio, la familia y la fecundidad matrimonial como algo que se tira y se desecha. Dios llama a los cónyuges, y a todos nosotros, a algo mucho más grande. Cuando vivimos de acuerdo con Su diseño, no solo estamos más alegremente satisfechos en esta vida, sino que también, nos estamos preparando bien para la vida venidera. Los invito a que me ayuden a difundir las buenas nuevas de la PFN.
