FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

This week, I follow up on last week's article when I spoke of the gift bestowed on spouses to collaborate with God in begetting children. As you recall, I noted the moral problems with ART (*Artificial Reproductive Technologies*) and mentioned that there is a moral and more healthy alternative to ART. That alternative has traditionally been called "Natural Family Planning" or "NFP" for short. NFP is a moral, scientific and natural means of either avoiding or achieving pregnancy. NFP is based on sound scientific knowledge, promotes the love of the couple, helps the couple to integrate their mutual fertility and does not harm the environment. Moreover, NFP is especially valuable to couples struggling with infertility; it can serve as a tool in the diagnosis and treatment of reproductive issues.

NFP (also called "Fertility Awareness Based Method" or "FABM") encompasses a number of methods which help couples to accurately identify fertile and infertile days in the woman's reproductive cycle. Thus, there is the *Billings Ovulation Method* and there is the sympto-thermal method promoted by the *Couple to Couple League*. Also, there is the *Family of Americas* method and there is the Creighton Model *FertilityCare* System. At St. Mary's, we are blessed to have Andreyra Arevalo who, in addition to her other tasks, is a certified *FertilityCare* Practitioner. Our couples who are preparing to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage are required to take a *FertilityCare* introduction class and to complete 5 follow-up sessions. Andreyra gives our *FertilityCare* classes, facilitates the follow-up sessions and is also available for consultation. *FertilityCare* is especially equipped to help couples dealing with infertility because it employs NaProTechnology, a reproductive health science that works cooperatively with the natural procreative cycle and is a result of forty years of research and medical practice.

NFP is 96.8 percent effective when used properly to avoid pregnancy. It is based on the fact that, normally, a woman is fertile for an average of a week to ten days every cycle. Her body produces signs that identify those days. NFP teaches the woman to learn and interpret those signs. When a couple, after prayer and mutual discernment, intend to wait before trying to have a baby, they simply refrain from marital relations on the "fertile" days. When, with God's help, spouses want to try to make a baby, they can benefit from their knowledge about their fertility to bring new life into the world.

NFP couples experience first-hand how NFP safeguards the most sacred, awesome act of the husband and wife. On the one hand, the use of contraception tends to disregard one's bodily fruitfulness and, thus, can disregard the person. On the other hand, NFP calls the husband to be

attentive to the bodily fruitfulness of his wife, and, therefore, attentive to her person. (Cf. *Humanae Vitae*, 17) NFP promotes shared responsibility and invites spouses to develop new paths of communication, to name just a couple its benefits. Above all, NFP enables couples to open themselves to their physical, emotional, psychological and spiritual fruitfulness. It is a way for spouses to say to each other over and over again: "I take you and give myself totally to you for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health, without reservation, until death do us part."

SAINTS SIMON AND JUDE, APOSTLES **October 28**

Saint Jude, apostle and . . . Hollywood success story? Indeed! Beyond Simon's being a "Zealot" for



Israel's liberation and Jude's question about Jesus revealing himself (John 14:22), no historic facts are known about either saint. But Saint Jude's well-known patronage of lost causes and hopeless cases is

largely due to a desperate vow made just before World War II by a struggling entertainer, the son of Arab-American immigrants, Danny Thomas. Unemployed, his wife about to give birth, Danny, attending Mass, impulsively donated his last seven dollars to the collection, promising: "Saint Jude, if you help me find my way in life, I will build a shrine in your honor!" DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

Esta semana, hago seguimiento al artículo de la semana pasada en el cual hablé sobre el don otorgado a los cónyuges para que en colaboración con Dios engendren hijos. Como ustedes recuerdan, hablé sobre los problemas morales con el TAR (Tecnologías Artificiales Reproductivas) y mencioné que hay una alternativa moral y más saludable que el TAR. Esa alternativa se ha llamado tradicionalmente "Planificación Familiar Natural" o "PFN" por abreviación. PFN es un medio moral, científico y natural para evitar o lograr el embarazo. NFP se basa en un conocimiento científico sólido, promueve el amor de la pareja, ayuda a la pareja a integrar su fertilidad mutua y no daña el medio ambiente. Además, PFN es especialmente valioso para las parejas que batallan con la infertilidad; puede servir como herramienta en el diagnóstico y tratamiento de problemas reproductivos.

PFN (también llamado "Método Basado en Conciencia de la Fertilidad") abarca una serie de métodos que ayudan a las parejas a identificar con precisión los días fértiles e infértiles en el ciclo reproductivo de la mujer. Por lo tanto, está el *Método de Ovulación Billings* y está el método simpto-térmico promovido por la *Liga Pareja a Pareja*. Además, está el método de la *Familia de las Américas* y está el *Sistema de Modelo Creighton FertilityCare*. En Santa María, tenemos la bendición de tener a Andreya Arévalo que, además de sus otras obligaciones, es profesional certificada de FertilityCare. A nuestras parejas que se están preparando para celebrar el Sacramento del Matrimonio se les requiere tomar una clase introductoria de FertilityCare y completar 5 sesiones de seguimiento. Andreya da nuestras clases de *FertilityCare*, facilita las sesiones de seguimiento y también está disponible para consultas. FertilityCare está especialmente equipado para ayudar a las parejas que tienen problemas con la infertilidad porque emplea la Tecnología NaPro, una ciencia de la salud reproductiva que trabaja en cooperación con el ciclo reproductivo natural y es el resultado de cuarenta años de investigación y práctica médica.

PFN es 96.8 por ciento eficaz cuando se utiliza correctamente para evitar el embarazo. Se basa en el hecho de que, normalmente, una mujer es fértil durante un promedio de una semana a diez días cada ciclo. Su cuerpo produce señales que identifican esos días. PFN enseña a la mujer a aprender e interpretar esas señales. Cuando una pareja, después de la oración y discernimiento mutuo, tienen la intención de esperar antes de intentar tener un bebé, simplemente se abstienen de tener relaciones durante los días "fértiles".

Cuando, con la ayuda de Dios, los cónyuges quieren tratar de concebir un bebé, pueden beneficiarse del conocimiento de su fertilidad para traer nueva vida al mundo.

Las parejas de PFN viven a primera mano cómo PFN protege el acto más sagrado e impresionante entre esposo y esposa. Por un lado, el uso de métodos anticonceptivos tiende a ignorar la fecundidad corporal y, por lo tanto, puede ignorar a la persona. Por otro lado, PFN ayuda al esposo a estar atento a la fecundidad corporal de su esposa y, por lo tanto, estar atento a su persona. (Cf. *Humanae Vitae*, 17) PFN promueve la responsabilidad compartida e invita a los cónyuges a desarrollar nuevas formas de comunicación, por nombrar sólo un par de sus beneficios. Sobre todo, la PFN permite a las parejas a abrirse a su fecundidad física, emocional, psicológica y espiritual. Es una manera para que los cónyuges se digan una y otra vez: " Yo, te recibo a ti, y me entrego a ti y prometo serte fiel en lo próspero y en lo adverso, en la salud y en la enfermedad, y así amarte y respetarte todos los días de mi vida ".

SANTOS SIMÓN Y JUDAS (Siglo I) 28 de octubre

Simón fue uno de los Doce y para distinguirlo de Simón Pedro, le llamaban el “zelote”, porque pertenecía a un



grupo de judíos que esperaban la venida del Mesías como una liberación de Roma y sus impuestos. Además de los Doce nombres, Judas es mencionado en el Evangelio de san Juan al preguntarle a Jesús la razón por la cual sólo se manifiesta a ellos y

no al mundo entero. Judas Tadeo, para distinguirlo del Iscariote, también fue de los Doce Apóstoles. Se cree que Judas se fue a predicar a Mesopotamia (actual Iraq), mientras que Simón se fue a predicar a Egipto. De alguna manera se unieron para evangelizar Persia (actual Irán) y ahí fueron martirizados. A Judas se le considera el autor de la carta de Judas que aparece en el Nuevo Testamento. En sólo 25 versos, el apóstol distingue a los líderes de los falsos maestros. Aunque ocupa el último lugar en la lista de los Doce, Judas Tadeo es el santo patrono de las causas difíciles y desesperadas. Goza de un gran afecto entre los cristianos.

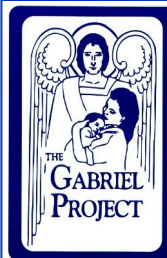
