FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Whenever two different civilizations clash, history has shown time and time again the result is never pretty. Brutal war often follows. When Europeans landed in the Americas in the 15th and 16th centuries, the same bloodshed seemed to be playing out across the continent. However, something unexpected happened that no one could ever imagine. In what is now called Mexico, a miraculous image would appear on a tilma (a cloth made out of cactus fiber) on December 12th, 1531. This image, known as *Our Lady of Guadalupe*, would unite two warring worlds into one family.

After Hernán Cortéz conquered the Aztec Empire a decade before, the native people and the colonial Spanish were at odds. However, Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared as a woman of mixed race. She was neither Aztec nor Spanish. She was both. The colors and symbols that are explained on the bulletin cover, spoke directly to the hearts of the native people who stared at the image. Her eyes cast down and arms clasped in prayer shows she's a woman of humility. A belt tied high above her waist shows she is a woman pregnant with a child. She stands in front of the rays of the sun, telling the Aztec observer that the one in her womb is greater than Huitzilopochtli, the pagan god of the sun and war, whom they had offered human sacrifices for centuries.

Our Lady of Guadalupe created a new people, united in Jesus Christ. Within a few years of this apparition, nearly ten million Aztecs would become Catholic. The Catholic priests wrote at that time that so many people came to be baptized, their arms become sore after pouring water over their heads thousands of times a day. What happened in Mexico should not surprise us, especially in light of today's Scripture readings. The First Reading from the Prophet Isaiah proclaims, "*Comfort, give comfort to my people, says your God.... Here comes with Power, the LORD God.*" The God of ours is coming, as St. John the Baptist tells in the Gospel passage, "*One mightier than I is coming after me. I am not worthy to stoop and loosen the thong of his sandals. I have baptized you with water; he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.*" Jesus comes to bring scattered, warring humanity, into the peace of His new Kingdom. Jesus comes to bring us home to Heaven.

SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE ADVIENTO

10 de diciembre de 2023

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Siempre que dos civilizaciones diferentes chocan, la historia ha demostrado una y otra vez que el resultado nunca es bonito. A menudo sigue una guerra brutal. Cuando los europeos desembarcaron en América en los siglos XV y XVI, el mismo derramamiento de sangre parecía estar ocurriendo en todo el continente. Sin embargo, sucedió algo inesperado que nadie jamás podría imaginar. En lo que ahora se llama México, una imagen milagrosa aparecería en una tilma (una tela hecha de fibra de maguey) el 12 de diciembre de 1531. Esta imagen, conocida como Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, uniría dos mundos en guerra en una sola familia.

Después de que Hernán Cortés conquistara el Imperio azteca una década antes, los nativos y los españoles coloniales estaban en desacuerdo. Sin embargo, Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe se apareció como una mujer mestiza. Ella no era ni azteca ni española. Ella era de ambas razas. Los colores y símbolos los cuales se explican en la portada del boletín, hablaron directamente a los corazones de los nativos que miraban fijamente la imagen. Sus ojos bajos y sus brazos entrelazados en oración muestran que es una mujer humilde. Un cinturón muy por encima de su cintura muestra que es una mujer embarazada de un niño. Ella está parada frente a los rayos del sol, diciéndole al observador azteca que el que está en su vientre es más grande que Huitzilopochtli, el dios pagano del sol y de la guerra, a quien habían ofrecido sacrificios humanos durante siglos.

Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe creó un pueblo nuevo, unido en Jesucristo. A los pocos años de esta aparición, casi diez millones de aztecas se convirtieron a católicos. Los sacerdotes católicos escribieron que en aquella época mucha gente llegaba para ser bautizada, que hasta les dolían los brazos después de echar agua sobre la cabeza miles de veces al día. Lo que sucedió en México no debería sorprendernos, especialmente a la luz de las lecturas de las Escrituras de hoy. La Primera Lectura del Profeta Isaías proclama: *“Consuelen, consuelen a mi pueblo, dice nuestro Dios. “Aquí está su Dios. Aquí llega el Señor, lleno de poder”*. El Dios nuestro viene, como dice San Juan Bautista en el pasaje del Evangelio: *“Ya viene*

de atrás de mí uno que es más poderoso que yo, uno ante quien no merezco ni siquiera inclinarme para desatarle la correa de sus sandalias. Yo los he bautizado a ustedes con agua, pero él los bautizará con el Espíritu Santo”. Jesús viene para traer a la humanidad dispersa y en guerra, a la paz de Su nuevo Reino. Jesús viene a llevarnos al cielo.

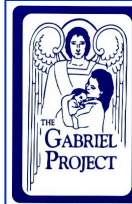
