FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Permit to begin with a provocative question: Is life better with God or without? What would you say? Is a relationship with Him worth it or not? Let's imagine for a moment that God is not important. The meaning of my life will be entirely of my own choosing. Without God as the source of my self-worth, I will quickly begin to compare myself with those around me. Who has the better job? Who has the most money? Who has the bigger truck? Who has the better looking body? Better clothes? Who has the better family? Better kids? Better husband? Better wife? It will feel like an endless game that never ends, with no real winner, no matter how much I achieve. There will always be someone with more. Without God, I must base my value in other external factors. No matter how hard I try, all of those things will eventually fade away. Hence, the preoccupation with always acquiring the newest and latest thing will become an obsession.

Without God, I must determine the purpose of my existence. I will forever search for the meaning of why I get up in the morning. I will travel the face of the earth, jumping from one experience to the next, hoping that if I keep moving, the hollow feeling in my soul might go away. Without God, I can fall into addiction more easily. Whatever that addiction may be, the result is always the same – for the pain to go away – at least for a brief moment. But the feeling always returns, doesn't it? Even after years of doing the same thing over and over.

Without God, I become the king of what is right and what is wrong. I choose what is good and what is bad. No outside force can tell me how to live my life. At first, this way of living can be entertaining for a while, like eating ice cream for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. The sugar rush eventually crashes and my body longs for true food. Without God, I only have my personal experience and feelings to lead me. As we all know, the human heart is fickle.

In other words, I dare say a life without God is like a dry, barren desert. I don't know about you, but I don't want to live in a desert. I want my life to be like the first reading we heard at Mass today. From the Book of Isaiah, we heard the great prophet say, "The desert and the parched land will exult; the steppe will rejoice and bloom. They will bloom with abundant flowers, and rejoice with joyful song." He is telling us that one day, God will send someone into the barren deserts of our lives. This mysterious person will give our lives a decisive new meaning and restore what was lost. This person of whom he speaks is none other than JESUS CHRIST! Jesus Christ is God in the flesh, the one whom God promised to send to save us centuries ago. It is he whom we seek when life becomes tired and hopeless. It is he, who reveals to us our true glory. Our value is not based on things or money, but rather on the fact that you and I are created in his image and likeness. That is why we are all here today. We rejoice with joyful song at the coming of the

Messiah. It is he whom Our Lady of Guadalupe carries in her womb in that famous image. Look at her eyes; she looks down at the floor. Why? She recognizes she is not worthy to carry Him who will save us. My brothers and sisters, search no longer for the meaning of life. You have found him.

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Permítanme comenzar con una pregunta provocadora: ¿Es mejor la vida con Dios o sin Dios? ¿Qué dirían ustedes? ¿Vale la pena o no una relación con Él? Vamos a imaginarnos por un momento que Dios no es importante. El significado de mi vida será completamente de mi propia elección. Sin Dios como la fuente de mi autoestima, rápidamente comenzaré a compararme con los que me rodean. ¿Quién tiene el mejor trabajo? ¿Quién tiene más dinero? ¿Quién tiene la camioneta más grande? ¿Quién tiene el mejor cuerpo? ¿Mejor ropa? ¿Quién tiene mejor familia? ¿Mejores hijos? ¿Mejor esposo? ¿Mejor esposa? Se sentirá como un juego interminable que nunca tendrá fin, sin un verdadero ganador, sin importar mis logros. Siempre habrá alguien con más. Sin Dios, debo basar mi valor en factores externos. No importa cuánto esfuerzo le ponga, todas esas cosas eventualmente se desvanecerán. Por eso es que la preocupación por adquirir siempre lo más novedoso y actual se convierte en una obsesión.

Sin Dios, debo determinar el propósito de mi existencia. Siempre buscaré el significado de por qué me levanto por la mañana. Viajaré por la faz de la tierra, saltando de una experiencia a la siguiente, con la esperanza de que, si sigo moviéndome, el sentimiento de vacío en mi alma podría desaparecer. Sin Dios, puedo caer más fácilmente en la adicción. Cualquiera que sea esa adicción, el resultado es siempre el mismo, buscando que el dolor desaparezca, al menos por un breve momento. Pero el sentimiento siempre regresa, ¿no es así? Incluso después de años de hacer lo mismo una y otra vez.

Sin Dios, me convierto en el rey de lo que está bien y lo que está mal. Yo elijo lo que es bueno y lo que es malo. Ninguna fuerza externa puede decirme cómo vivir mi vida. Al principio, esta forma de vida puede ser divertida por un tiempo, tal como desayunar, almorzar y cenar helado. Eventualmente la ráfaga por la azúcar finalmente se desploma y mi cuerpo anhela comida de verdad. Sin Dios, solo tengo mi experiencia personal y mis sentimientos para guiarme. Como todos sabemos, el corazón humano es voluble.

En otras palabras, me atrevo a decir que una vida sin Dios es como un desierto seco e infértil. No sé ustedes, pero yo no quiero vivir en un desierto. Quiero que mi vida sea como la primera lectura que escuchamos en la Misa de hoy. Florecerán con abundantes flores y se regocijarán con cantos de alegría”. Él nos está diciendo que un día, Dios enviará a alguien a los áridos desiertos de nuestras vidas. ¡Esta persona de quien habla no es otra que JESUCRISTO! Jesucristo es Dios hecho carne, aquel a quien Dios prometió enviar para salvarnos hace siglos. Es a Él a quien buscamos cuando la vida se siente agotada y sin esperanza. Es Él quien nos revela nuestra verdadera gloria. Nuestro valor no se basa en lo material o el dinero, sino en el hecho de que tú y yo somos creados a su imagen y semejanza. Por eso estamos todos hoy aquí. Nos regocijamos con cantos de alegría por la venida del Mesías. Es El a quien Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe lleva en su vientre en la famosa imagen. Mírele los ojos; ella mira hacia el suelo. ¿Por qué?
