FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

To be sure, this Advent feels rather different from previous ones. Of course, most of 2020 has felt different from previous years. With the spike in COVID-19 infections that we are experiencing in our state and in our country right now and the subsequent recommendation to limit gatherings, perhaps this Advent season will actually be marked by an Advent spirit. What do I mean by that? At the risk of sounding like a broken record, because I feel like I make the same rant every year, too often we jump the gun and celebrate Christmas before we give Advent its due. Waiting is hard for us. And, a lot of stuff that is part of our world, stuff like technology, material goods, food, sex, drink, drugs, is being sold or promoted to us in such a way that we are made to feel like we need to have right now. Why wait when we don't have to? If I just punch the right key on the keyboard, it will be delivered to my doorstep immediately or at the latest the next day. Yet, when it comes to spiritual matters, waiting is good. It teaches us to be patient. It teaches us to be prepared. Advent is a time of waiting and preparation for Christmas.

Indeed, Advent reminds us that we have not yet arrived at Christmas. And, to truly experience the joy of Christmas, we should pay attention to the words of John the Baptist. The Forerunner reminds us to make room for the Lord, by removing from our lives what is not of the Lord. Perhaps with fewer distractions this year, we can do this well. Take some time to get rid of some of those clothes you don't wear anymore. Give them to the poor. With the help of God's grace, may we take some time to get rid of some of those sins that we "wear" all too comfortably on our souls. May we make a good confession this Advent.

"Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight His paths!" cries John the Baptist. To experience the joy of Christmas and the gift of the Incarnation, we are invited to first, smooth out the rough patches of our souls. We pray that we may prepare ourselves bodily and spiritually well so that we can celebrate the joy that awaits us at Christmas.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

Sin duda, este Adviento se siente bastante diferente a los anteriores. Por supuesto, la mayor parte del 2020 se ha sentido diferente a los años anteriores. Con el aumento de los contagios de COVID-19 que estamos viviendo en nuestro estado y en nuestro país en este momento y la recomendación de limitar las reuniones, tal vez esta temporada de Adviento esté marcada por un espíritu de Adviento. ¿Qué quiero decir con eso? A riesgo de sonar como un disco rayado, porque siento que doy el mismo discurso cada año, con frecuencia nos aceleramos y celebramos la Navidad antes de dar al Adviento lo que se debe. Esperar es difícil para nosotros. De hecho, el Adviento nos recuerda que aún no hemos llegado a la Navidad. Y, para vivir verdaderamente la alegría de la Navidad, debemos prestar atención a las palabras de Juan Bautista. El Predicador, Juan Bautista, nos recuerda que debemos hacer espacio para el Señor, quitando de nuestra vida lo que no es del Señor. Tal vez con menos distracciones este año, pudiéramos hacerlo mejor. Tómese un tiempo para deshacerse de esa ropa que ya no usa. Désela a los pobres. Con la ayuda de la gracia de Dios, que nos tomemos un tiempo para deshacernos de algunos de esos pecados que "vestimos" muy cómodamente en nuestras almas. Que hagamos una buena confesión este Adviento.

"¡Preparen el camino del Señor, allanen sus senderos!", grita Juan Bautista. Para vivir la alegría de la Navidad y el don de la Encarnación, se nos invita, en primer lugar, a suavizar las partes ásperas de nuestras almas. Oremos para que estemos bien preparados en cuerpo y espiritualmente para celebrar el gozo que nos espera en Navidad.

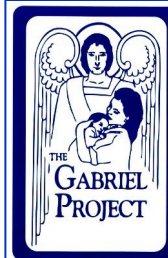
