FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Have you ever wanted to read the Bible but did not know where to start? The Bible can be intimidating for many. It's filled with strange alien places and funny names that it can be difficult to grasp what's happening. It's similar to walking into a crowded theater mid-movie: you don't know the plot, the main characters, or the drama unfolding on the screen. In much the same way, picking up the Bible for yourself can be a confusing mess. This Lent we will have an opportunity to get deeper into the Bible. I want to invite you all to St. Mary's Lenten Parish Bible Study. We will have it both in Spanish and English. Starting on the eve of Ash Wednesday, we will meet one evening a week, throughout the season of Lent. We will focus on the Biblical events that we find in the ancient and well-known prayer of the Holy Rosary.

Why the rosary? Since the Middle Ages the rosary has been a powerful spiritual weapon during difficult periods of the Church's history. In 1208, St. Dominic, a Spanish priest, working in France was battling against a heretical group known as the Albigensians (the name comes from the small town Albi in southern France where this group was flourishing). This heretical group was leading many Catholics away with their confusing teachings. They taught that everything physical is bad and only the spiritual is good. Therefore, our body is evil and if we truly want to be good Christians, we must reject all things of the flesh. Fr. Dominic prayed for guidance on how to combat this group, which was threatening to divide the Church. The rosary was given. This prayer focuses the mind to meditate upon the earthly life of Jesus Christ, directly contradicting the teachings of the Albigensians.

Then in 1571, a new threat emerged. The Islamic Ottoman Turks, which conquered much of Eastern Christianity, now began to threaten Western Europe. An alliance of Catholic nations stood between them and us. The two armies stood face to face on the morning of October 7th. Pope Pius V, realizing that Western Civilization was facing an existential threat, asked all faithful Catholics to pray the Holy Rosary for victory. Against all odds, our soldiers defeated the Turks, which was the largest empire in the 16th century. We commemorate this triumph in the Church every October 7th; it's called the Feast of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary.

As a parish named after the Blessed Mother, we now turn to this same prayer that our ancestors used during their own time. We face much confusion in the world today. We face challenges that threaten to tear our world apart. In the midst of these relentless storms, we turn to the Holy Rosary this Lent. Come to the parish Bible Study, where we shall learn the Biblical roots of this powerful spiritual weapon of the saints.



DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

¿Alguna vez has querido leer la Biblia, pero no sabías por dónde empezar? La Biblia puede ser intimidante para muchos. Está llena de extraños lugares alienígenas y nombres raros que puede ser difícil comprender lo que está leyendo. Es similar a entrar en un cine lleno de gente en medio de una película: no conoces la trama, los personajes principales o el drama que se desarrolla en la pantalla. De la misma manera, leer la Biblia a ti mismo puede ser confuso. Esta Cuaresma tendremos la oportunidad de profundizar en la Biblia. Quiero invitarlos a todos al Estudio Bíblico de Cuaresma de la Parroquia de Santa María. Lo tendremos en español como en inglés. A partir de la víspera del Miércoles de Ceniza, nos reuniremos una noche a la semana, durante el tiempo de Cuaresma. Nos centraremos en los acontecimientos bíblicos que encontramos en la antigua y conocida oración del Santo Rosario.

¿Por qué el rosario? Desde la Edad Media, el rosario ha sido una poderosa arma espiritual durante los períodos difíciles de la historia de la Iglesia. En 1208, Santo Domingo, un sacerdote español, trabajando en Francia, estaba luchando contra un grupo herético conocido como los albigenses (el nombre proviene de la pequeña ciudad de Albi en el sur de Francia, donde este grupo estaba floreciendo). Este grupo herético estaba alejando a muchos católicos con sus confusas enseñanzas. Enseñaban que todo lo físico es malo y que sólo lo espiritual es bueno. Por lo tanto, nuestro cuerpo es malo y si realmente queremos ser buenos cristianos, debemos rechazar todas las cosas de la carne. El Padre Domingo rezó para recibir orientación sobre cómo combatir a este grupo, que amenazaba con dividir a la Iglesia. Se dio el rosario. Esta oración enfoca la mente para meditar en la vida terrenal de Jesucristo, contradiciendo directamente las enseñanzas de los albigenses.

Luego, en 1571, surgió una nueva amenaza. Los turcos otomanos islámicos, que conquistaron gran parte de la cristiandad oriental, comenzaron a amenazar a Europa occidental. Una alianza de naciones católicas se interponía entre ellos y nosotros. Los dos ejércitos se enfrentaron en la mañana del 7 de octubre. El Papa Pío V, dándose cuenta de que la civilización occidental se enfrentaba a una amenaza existencial, pidió a todos los fieles católicos que rezaran el Santo Rosario por la victoria.

Contra todo pronóstico, nuestros soldados derrotaron a los turcos, que era el imperio más grande del siglo XVI. Conmemoramos este triunfo en la Iglesia cada 7 de octubre; se llama la Fiesta de Nuestra Señora del Santo Rosario.

Como parroquia que lleva el nombre de la Santísima Virgen, ahora recurrimos a esta misma oración que

nuestros antepasados usaban durante su propio tiempo. Nos enfrentamos a mucha confusión en el mundo de hoy. Nos enfrentamos a desafíos que amenazan con destruir nuestro mundo. En medio de estas tormentas implacables, recurrimos al Santo Rosario en esta Cuaresma. Ven al Estudio Bíblico de la parroquia, donde aprenderemos las raíces bíblicas de esta poderosa arma espiritual de los santos.
