SAMPLE DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1, Fri, Nov 03: Depart for the Holy Land

Make your way to your airport where you will board your overnight flight. Your meals are served on board.

Day 2, Sat, Nov 04: Arrive in Tel Aviv and proceed to Tiberias

Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, you will be greeted by a tour guide and/or driver. Your group will transfer to your hotel in Tiberias in time to check-in. Enjoy dinner at the hotel before retiring for the evening.

Day 3, Sun, Nov 05: Caesarea - Stella Maris (Haifa) - Nazareth - Cana - Tiberias

Theme: The Annunciation

Morning transfer to Caesarea Maritima, one of the three largest ports in the Roman world, next to Alexandria and Piraeus Athens, both built by Herod the Great between 21 B.C. and 9 B.C. It was in Caesarea where St. Peter baptized the first gentile convert Cornelius and where St. Paul gave his defense of the Church. From here, we will see the Roman Theater Herod's Palace, view the Hippodrome, and the harbor from where St. Paul sailed on his journeys. Continue north to Haifa, located on Mt. Carmel, where we will visit the Carmelite Shrine dedicated to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and pray at the cave where Elijah the prophet took refuge. Continue to Nazareth for lunch, followed by a visit to the Church of the Annunciation. Walk down to the Grotto, where the remains of the house of the Blessed Mother are visible. Here is where the Angel of the Lord announced the good news to Mary. Visit the museum and archaeological site where you can see the remains of Nazareth at the time of Christ, as well as the workshop of St. Joseph - which is now known as St. Joseph's Church. Celebrate Mass, and then continue to Cana. It was here that Jesus performed His first miracle. Changing water into wine. During your visit to the Wedding Church, married couples will have the chance to participate in the ceremony and renew their wedding vows. From there, we continue to Tiberias, located on the Sea of Galilee, for dinner and overnight.

Day 4, Mon, Nov 06: Sea of Galilee

Theme: The Ministry of Christ in the Galilee

After breakfast, enjoy a boat ride on the beautiful and scenic Sea of Galilee (Luke 5:1). Upon docking have the opportunity to view the remains of the boat dating back to the time of Jesus. Following the Sea of Galilee, continue to the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus proclaimed His great Sermon on the Mount (Luke 6:20-49). Near the Mount is Tabgha, one of Jesus' miracle sites. At Tabgha, Jesus fed the crowd of 5,000 people from five loaves of bread and two fish (Luke 9:10-17). In Tabgha is St. Peter's Primacy, where Jesus bestowed church leadership upon Peter (John 21:9). Continue to visit the birthplace of Mary Magdalene in Magdala. During the time of Jesus, this village was a prosperous fishing village that exported fish and garum (a fish sauce reduction popular in Roman cooking). Your day concludes at Capernaum, the launching place of Jesus' ministry. In Capernaum, see the Synagogue where Jesus taught (Mark 1:21-29) and gave His sermon on the Bread of Life. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 5, Tues, Nov 07: Jordan River - Mt. Tabor - Jericho - Jerusalem

Theme: The Transfiguration

After breakfast, drive to the site of the Transfiguration, Mount Tabor (Matthew 17:1-50). Here you will have some time to reflect on Christ's Humanity and Divinity. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Transfiguration. Continue south towards the Jordan Valley to Jericho, the oldest inhabited city in the world (Joshua 6:12-25). In Jericho, you get to view the exact location of the Mount of Temptation. Here is where the Devil tempted Jesus during his forty-day fast (Luke 4:1). Following the visit to this mountain, continue to Jesus' baptismal site on the River Jordan (Matthew 3:13-17). Following time for Prayer and reflection at the Jordan River, continue to Jerusalem to check-in to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 6, wed, Nov 08: Jerusalem: Temple Model - Ein Karem - Bethlehem

Theme: The Visitation and Nativity

This morning enjoy breakfast, before we start our day to the Israel Museum which houses the Temple to which Jesus was presented (Luke 2:22). Visit a model of the Second Temple, as it was in the time of Jesus, as well as viewing the Shrine of the Book (where the Dead Sea Scrolls are on display). Following this visit, take a short drive to the village of Ein Karem, birthplace of St. John the Baptist, Known for its two churches representing the two homes of Zechariah and Elizabeth. The first is in a valley where the birth of St. John the Baptist is commemorated (Luke 1:29-80) in the Church of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist. The second, the Church of the Visitation, is on a hill where Elizabeth spent five months, in seclusion (Luke 1:24). Visit both churches. You will have the opportunity to pray the Mystery of the Rosary as you walk up the hill to the Church of the Visitation. In the afternoon, visit Bethlehem, the

Jesus. Have the opportunity to view Shepherd's Fields (Luke 2:8). In the caves, you can see the soot marks of fires that shepherds lit to keep warm. The tour Concludes at the Manger Square, which stands in front of the Church of the Nativity. As you enter the Church, you will proceed down to the Grotto of the Nativity which, marks the spot of Our Savior's birth (Matthew 2:1-18). Beneath the altar, there is a silver star and a Latin inscription that states: HIC DE VIRGINE MARIA JESUS CHRISTUS NATUS (Here Jesus Christ was born to the Virgin Mary). Following Mass in this Sacred space, return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 7, Thu, Nov 09: Bethany - Qumran - Masada - Dead Sea

This morning we visit Bethany where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. Celebrate Mass here. After we will travel down the Jordan Valley to Qumran (entrance included). Qumran is made up of 2,000 year old ruins from the days of the Second Temple, and also the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were written and discovered (Ezekiel 47:8-10). These writings have helped further the understanding of Jewish background in Christianity. Next, we will head to visit Masada (ascend and descend by cable car); The fortress of King Herod and the last stronghold of the Zealots. Afterwards there may be time for a dip in the Dead Sea for those who want to before returning to the hotel. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8, Fri, Nov 10: Mt. Of Olives - Gethsemane - Mt. Zion (Upper Room) - Western Wall

Theme: Palm Sunday and the Agony in the Garden

After breakfast, you will make your way to the Mount of Olives, where you will be able to take in the beautiful, panoramic view of Jerusalem. Historically, the Mount of Olives was a mandatory transit point for Jesus during many iconic moments. Visit the Pater Noster Shrine where Jesus taught His disciples the Lord's Prayer (Pater Noster) (Luke 11:1-14). You will have the opportunity to stop at Dominus Flevit, the Church that commemorates where Jesus wept for Jerusalem (Luke 19:41). Continue to Gethsemane, a garden at the foot of the Mount of Olives. Jesus brought His disciples here to pray the night before He was crucified (Luke 22:29-53). The Garden still contains trees with roots that date back to the time of Jesus. Your next stop, the Church of All Nations, is built over the "Rock of Agony". Jesus prayed here alone on the night of His arrest. Take time to Pray and reflect on Christ's agony that He experienced. You will have the opportunity to visit the Western Wall, which is the last remnant of the Jewish Temple after it was destroyed in 70 A.D. Continue with a visit to the house of the High Priest Calaphas (Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu). This Church commemorates where Jesus was examined and eventually imprisoned before the Council in Jerusalem. It also commemorates Peter's Denial of Christ (John 18:15-18), Peter's repentance, and Jesus' forgiveness of Peter. You will also visit the Upper Room on Mt. Zion. The Upper Room is where Jesus and His disciples celebrated the Last Supper (Matthew 26:17-30) and where Jesus appeared to His disciples after His Death and Resurrection (Mark 16:14). Also, visit the nearby Benedictine Church of the Dormition. Tradition tells us that this is the Church where Mary, the Mother of Jesus, fell asleep. At the end of this prayerful day, return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 9, Sat, Nov 11: Jerusalem: Via Dolorosa - Holy Sepulchre

Theme: The Way of the Cross, The Crucifixion, The Resurrection

This morning you will have a very early wake-up to begin the Via Dolorosa (The Way of the Cross) at the Antonia Fortress, the spot where Jesus was condemned to death by Pontius Pilate (John 18:28–19:16). Following His condemnation, He was taken (on the Road to Calvary) to His place of Crucifixion. Reflect upon the Stations of the Cross, as you travel through the markets of the Old City to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher (Luke 23:26-33). This sacred destination is the site of Calvary (Jesus' crucifixion place) and His tomb (Luke 23:50-55). Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Following Mass, we will return to the hotel to enjoy breakfast. Continue your day with a visit to the Church of St. Anne's, the home of Jesus' maternal grandparents (Anne and Joachim); and the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the cripple man (John 5:1-9). This afternoon, enjoy a revisit to the Old City. Following this visit, return to the hotel to enjoy dinner and overnight at your hotel.

Day 10, Sun, Nov 12: Jerusalem - USA

After an early breakfast and heartfelt farewells, transfer to the Tel Aviv airport for return flights home.



DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

El jueves pasado tuve el gran placer de visitar a los estudiantes de la Escuela Notre Dame en la Parroquia de San Jose. La Sra. Bauer, la directora de la escuela, me invitó a pasar tiempo con los niños como parte de las actividades de la Semana de las Escuelas Católicas. Felizmente Acepté. La mayor parte de interacción con ustedes y los estudiantes ocurre el fin de semana durante la Misa dominical. Como ustedes saben, no es el momento ideal para tener conversaciones significativas. Simplemente hay demasiada gente. En la escuela, sepáramos a los 300 niños en dos grupos manejables. Compartí con ellos mi crianza en Elk Grove, cómo me di cuente del llamado de Dios al sacerdocio durante mi primer año de universidad en UC Davis, mi comida favorita (pollo frito!), etc. La parte más divertida del día fue la sesión de preguntas y respuestas. Cuando le das a un niño la libertad de preguntar cualquier cosa, revelan la curiosidad de sus pequeñas mentes y corazones. Una niña, probablemente en el tercer grado, levantó su mano. "Padre", dijo lentamente, "¿cómo sabemos que las Escrituras son verdaderas?" Me sentí anonadado. ¡Qué brillante pregunta! Me mostró su mente inquisitiva y analítica. ¿Cómo sabemos ciertamente, que lo que creemos es verdad? La gran belleza de nuestra rica y antigua fe católica es que personas más inteligentes y brillantes que ustedes y yo, han reflexionado sobre estas mismas preguntas. A lo largo de los siglos, la Iglesia ha guiado y desarrollado la lógica de las razones por las que creemos lo que enseñamos de todo corazón. Nunca, absolutamente, nunca la Iglesia se ha basado simplemente en "Porque nosotros lo decimos".

Estoy emocionado de anunciar oficialmente una oportunidad increíble para nuestra parroquia. Este noviembre, nos embarcaremos en una peregrinación a los mismos lugares donde comenzó la Iglesia: Tierra Santa. En el boletín de este domingo, verán un itinerario detallado de los increíbles sitios en los que oraremos y visitaremos. Ver y tocar los mismos lugares donde caminó Jesús cambiará la forma en que leerán la Biblia. Abrirá el mundo bíblico en formas nuevas y frescas. Cristo cobrará vida. Durante los últimos domingos hemos estado escuchando en las lecturas del Evangelio el famoso relato del Sermón de Jesús en el monte, que un erudito de las Escrituras llamó, "el gran sermón jamás predicado". (Cf. Mateo 5). Imagínese ahora leer ese mismo sermón en el monte exacto en el que lo dijo. La luz del sol reluciente que se refleja en la superficie del Mar de Galilea estará en el fondo. El mismo pasto verde y suave estará bajo sus pies. Escuchará las palabras de Jesús como nunca antes: "*No crean que he venido a suprimir la Ley o los Profetas. He venido, no para deshacer, sino para llevar a la forma perfecta.*" (Mateo 5:17)

Si alguna vez ha querido ir a Tierra Santa, le invito a considerar esta oportunidad. La empresa que contraté para dirigir la peregrinación es el estándar en la industria. Usan algunos de los mejores guías y hoteles en Israel. Por

mucho que quisieramos ir, sé que para muchos de ustedes es simplemente una carga tomar tanto tiempo y recursos de nuestro trabajo y familia. La gran belleza de nuestra fe es que no tenemos que viajar por todo el mundo para encontrar a Jesús Resucitado. Una peregrinación ayuda, pero no es una necesidad para encontrar su amor. Cristo en el Evangelio de hoy está revelando su autoridad divina en ese Sermón del Monte. Él les está diciendo, Yo soy Dios en la carne. He venido a cumplir la ley judía en la Antigua Alianza. Para nosotros los católicos, todo lo que tenemos que hacer es venir a Misa para ver a Jesús en toda su gloria eucarística.
