FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Every year, Ash Wednesday begins with a gut check: *"Repent and Believe in the Gospel."* That's the phrase the priest will say to you as he puts ashes on your head, in that ancient gesture of sorrow and contrition that goes back thousands of years. The drama of human salvation, all the way from the beginning with Adam and Eve, to Abraham, Moses, all the prophets of old, culminating in the unsuspecting sending of his son Jesus to die on the cross, is one of God's relentless pursuit of each of us. Christianity, for all its depth and richness can be summed up in that simple fact--God's mighty love. We matter more than we can ever imagine. Yet, despite this penetrating, life-changing truth, we effortlessly forget. We allow the glimmering distractions of worldly allurements to shove God from his rightful place in our lives. We're commanded, in no uncertain terms, to *"Love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength"* (cf. Deuteronomy 6:5, cf. Matthew 22:37). We all fail here, even the saintliest of saints do.

Each Lent, we begin anew. We enter into the desert with Jesus who himself fasted and prayed in solitude for forty long days. He jumps into the heart of the spiritual battle which rages in all of our hearts. The 17th century French mathematician, inventor, and brilliant Catholic writer, Blaise Pascal, famously quipped, *"All of humanity's problems stem from man's inability to sit quietly in a room alone."* The stillness of quietude reveals the war within. We see the constant tug between following God or not. Should I give into temptation or not? Should I pray or busy myself with the cacophony of distractions which beckon my gaze? Silence makes us uneasy because it leads us to deeper truths, if we are so daring to ponder them. Lent is such a time.

Know of my prayers for each of you. It is my solemn duty as your priest and pastor to offer prayers on your behalf. This Lent, my hope is a simple one -- your love will grow for Jesus. No matter how you've fallen or failed in your walk with the Lord this last year, Lent is a time for us to start anew. **"We know that all things work together for the good for those who love God"** (cf. Romans 8:28).

PRIMER DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

18 de febrero de 2024



DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Cada año, el Miércoles de Ceniza comienza con un chequeo intestinal: *"Conviértete y cree en el Evangelio"*. Esa es la frase que te dice el sacerdote mientras te pone cenizas en la cabeza, en ese gesto milenario de dolor y contrición que se remonta a miles de años atrás. El drama de la salvación humana, desde el principio con Adán y Eva, hasta Abraham, Moisés, todos los profetas de la antigüedad, culminando en el envío desprevenido de su hijo Jesús a morir en la cruz, es una de la búsqueda incesante de Dios de cada uno de nosotros. El cristianismo, a pesar de toda su profundidad y riqueza, se puede resumir en ese simple hecho-- el poderoso amor de Dios. Importamos más de lo que podemos imaginar. Sin embargo, a pesar de esta verdad penetrante y transformadora, fácilmente lo olvidamos. Permitimos que las distracciones deslumbrantes de las seducciones mundanas saquen a Dios del lugar que le corresponde en nuestras vidas. Se nos ordena, en términos inequívocos, que *"Amarás al Señor tu Dios con todo tu corazón, con toda tu alma y con todas tus fuerzas"* (cf. Deuteronomio 6:5, cf. Mateo 22:37). Todos fallamos aquí, hasta el más santo de los santos lo hace.

Cada Cuaresma, comenzamos de nuevo. Entramos en el desierto con Jesús, quien ayunó y oró en soledad durante cuarenta largos días. Él salta al corazón de la batalla espiritual que se enfurece en todos nuestros corazones. El matemático, inventor y brillante escritor católico francés del siglo XVII, Blaise Pascal, bromeó famosamente: *"Todas las desgracias del hombre se derivan del hecho de no ser capaz de estar tranquilamente sentado y solo en una habitación"*. La quietud de la quietud revela la guerra interior. Vemos el constante tirón entre seguir a Dios o no. ¿Debo ceder a la tentación o no? ¿Debo orar u ocuparme con la cacofonía de distracciones que acechan mi mirada? El silencio nos incomoda porque nos lleva a verdades más profundas, si nos atrevemos a ponderarlas. La Cuaresma es uno de esos tiempos.

Sepan de mis oraciones por cada uno de ustedes. Es mi deber solemne como su sacerdote y pastor ofrecer oraciones en su nombre. En esta Cuaresma, mi esperanza es simple: tu amor por Jesús crecerá. No importa cómo hayas caído o fracasado en tu caminar

con el Señor este último año, la Cuaresma es un tiempo para que comencemos de nuevo. **"Sabemos que a los que aman a Dios, todas las cosas les ayudan a bien"** (cf. Rm 8, 28).

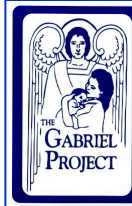
