FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

As always, during Lent we like to ramp up our spiritual practices. The main pillars of our Lenten spiritual exercises are our prayer, fasting and almsgiving. As we know, if we are 14 years and older, we are to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent. Everyone ages 18 to 59 is to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Every year Bishop Jaime Soto promulgates the "Lenten Regulations" which can be found here in English and Spanish: <https://www.scd.org/news/lenten-regulations-2021> To be sure, there are many ways to pray, fast and give alms. I would like to offer a few suggestions based on Bishop Soto's Lenten Regulations.

With regard to prayer, here are a few suggestions:

- Attend daily Mass as much as possible during Lent.
- Make a good confession during Lent. The faithful are obliged to confess their sins at least once a year. (Confessions are heard on Saturdays at 3:30p and on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 5:30p)
- Pray the "Stations of the Cross" either individually or in a group. (We will have the Stations of the Cross each Friday at 6p in English and 7p in Spanish in the church.)
- Pray the Rosary often, if not daily.
- Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet.
- Make visits to the Blessed Sacrament. We have Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the church, Monday through Friday, from 3p to 6:30p.
- Read a spiritual book or two during Lent. There are many classic, spiritual books, but also books published more recently. Ignatius Press is a good resource: <https://www.ignatius.com/>
- If you are not already signed up for formed.org, please sign up and take advantage of wonderful Catholic talks, movies and e-books.

With regard to fasting and abstaining, here are some suggestions:

- Abstain from alcohol and desserts.
- Abstain from television or one's favorite television show, video games and social media.
- Turn off all computers and electronic devices at 8 pm and do not turn them on again until the morning.

Regarding almsgiving and serving the poor and needy, here are some ideas:

- Give to the poor by supporting the

diocesan Annual Catholic Appeal, Catholic Charities of Yolo-Solano and giving to St. Mary's Food Locker, St. Vincent de Paul, and Gabriel Project

- Offer to help with our apostolates of Feed My People, Soup for the Soul and From Thy Bounty.
- Visit the sick and homebound.

May all of us have a most fruitful Lent!

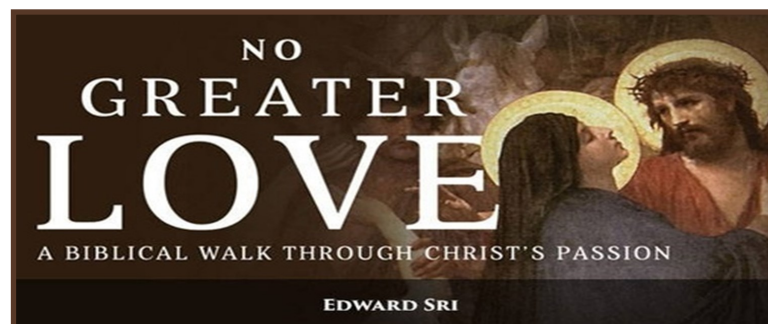

21 de febrero de 2021

Después de los cuarenta días en el desierto, Jesús viene a Galilea proclamando el Evangelio de Dios (Marcos 1:12-15).

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa Maria:

Como siempre, durante la Cuaresma nos gusta reforzar nuestras prácticas espirituales. Los pilares principales de nuestros ejercicios espirituales cuaresmales son nuestra oración, ayuno y limosna. Como sabemos, si somos mayores de 14 años, debemos abstenernos de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza y todos los viernes de Cuaresma. Todos entre las edades de 18 a 59 años deben ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. Cada año el Obispo Jaime Soto promulga el "Reglamento De Cuaresma" que se puede encontrar aquí en inglés y español: <https://www.scd.org/news/lenten-regulations-2021> Sin duda, hay muchas maneras de orar, ayunar y dar limosna. Quisiera ofrecer algunas sugerencias basadas en el Reglamento Cuaresmal del Obispo Soto.

Con respecto a la oración, aquí hay algunas sugerencias:

- Asistir a la Misa diaria tanto como le sea posible durante la Cuaresma.
- Hacer una buena confesión durante la Cuaresma. Los fieles están obligados a confesar sus pecados al menos una vez al año. (Las confesiones se escuchan los sábados a las 3:30p y los martes y jueves a las 5:30p)
- Rezar las "Estaciones de la Cruz" ya sea individualmente o en grupo. (Tendremos las Estaciones de la Cruz cada viernes a las 6p en inglés y 7p en español en la iglesia.)
- Rezar el Rosario a menudo, si no todos los días.
- Rezar la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia.
- Hacer visitas al Santísimo Sacramento. Tenemos Exposición y Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento en la iglesia, de lunes a viernes, de 3p a 6:30p.
- Leer uno o dos libros espirituales durante la Cuaresma. Hay muchos libros clásicos espirituales, pero también libros publicados más recientemente. Ignatius Press es un buen recurso: <https://www.ignatius.com/>
- Si aún no está registrado en [formed.org](https://www.ignatius.com/), regístrese y aproveche las maravillosas charlas, películas y libros electrónicos católicos.

Con respecto al ayuno y la abstinencia, estas son algunas sugerencias:

- Abstenerse del alcohol y los postres.
- Abstenerse de la televisión o de su programa de televisión favorito, videojuegos y redes sociales.
- Apague su computadora y dispositivos

electrónicos a las 8pm y no vuelva a encenderlos hasta el siguiente día por la mañana.

En cuanto a la limosna y el servicio a los pobres y necesitados, aquí hay algunas ideas:

- Dar a los pobres a través del apoyo a la Apelación Católica Anual Diocesana, Caridades Católicas de Yolo-Solano y dando a al Banco de Comida de Santa Maria, a San Vicente de Paul y Proyecto Gabriel.
- Ofrecerse a ayudar en nuestros apostolados de Alimentando a Mi Pueblo (Feed my People), Sopa para el Alma (Soup for the Soul) y De Tu Abundancia (From Thy Bounty).
