Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Growing up Catholic has been the greatest gift my parents could have given me. Even though I would not have recognized it as a bratty, stubborn kid, they gave me a foundation without realizing it. Going to Mass each Sunday exposed me that there is something in the universe greater than myself. It rooted me to a 2,000 year-old history that spans empires, kingdoms and cultures. It subconsciously whispered into my little brain that there's more to life than what I see on the surface. Or as the old Transformer cartoon I watched religiously on Saturday mornings told me, there's "more than meets the eye".

My Catholic faith told me I am more than a beast. I am loved, willfully desired into being, whose value shines more brilliantly than a thousand swirling galaxies. My public school upbringing paid no attention to my burgeoning soul. As caring as my teachers were, God talk was an anathema, barred, and poo pood. I am a mere byproduct of random genetic mutations that somehow learned to walk upright and speak. I am a primate with less hair and an iPhone. Then on Sundays, a ray of sunlight would pierce the clouds. "You are created in God's image and likeness", I was told (Cf. Genesis 1:27). There's more to you than the endless pit of more money and things. In fact, more glorious still, I was told I was created for the worship of Him who created me. My desirous heart that was designed for Him but has been infected with a terminal ancient disease that corrupted my transcendent purpose earthward. Instead of the Heavenly banquet, I settled for stale breadcrumbs. The world lured me away from my God; I forgot who I was. I allowed strangers to tell me my worth.

In the cacophony of confusion, God set forth a rescue mission to pull me from the pit. "When the fullness of time had come, God sent his Son, born of a woman..." (Cf. Galatians 4:4). God sent his beloved Son? I say again, God sent his most prized, precious Son. He united this weak human flesh of mine to himself and walked among us. As if that was not enough, Jesus would pick up my heavy cross and yours and carry it all the way to Calvary as the crowds hissed and spat on his body.

I give thanks to my parents for this gift of gifts. Without them I would be lost and tossed about by the relentless waves of this world. But most of all, I give thanks to Jesus who gives still more. At every single Mass, the same Risen Jesus comes. The same ritualistic Mass of common gestures and prayers, the Mass of kneeling and standing, the Mass we've grown accustomed to and maybe even a tad blasé, still triumphantly proclaims in every century and creature: *"you have approached Mount Zion and the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and countless angels in festal gathering, and the assembly of the firstborn enrolled in heaven, and God the judge of all,*

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Creer católico ha sido el mejor regalo que mis padres me pudieron haber dado. A pesar de que no lo habría reconocido siendo un niño malcriado y testarudo, ellos me dieron una base sin darme cuenta. Ir a misa todos los domingos me expuso que hay algo más grande en el universo que yo mismo. Me arraigó a una historia de 2.000 años de antigüedad que abarca imperios, reinos y culturas. Inconscientemente susurró en mi pequeño cerebro que hay más a la vida de lo que veo en la superficie. O como me decía la vieja caricatura del Transformador que veía religiosamente los sábados por la mañana, hay "más de lo que parece".

Mi fe católica me dijo que soy más que una bestia. Soy amado, deseado voluntariamente a existir, cuyo valor brilla más intensamente que mil galaxias arremolinadas. Mi educación en la escuela pública no prestó atención a mi alma floreciente. A pesar de lo cariñosos que eran mis maestros, hablar de Dios era un anatema, prohibido y defecado. Soy un mero subproducto de aleatorio mutaciones genéticas que de alguna manera aprendieron a caminar vertical y hablar. Soy un primate con menos pelo y un iPhone. Luego, los domingos, un rayo de sol atravesaba las nubes. "Y creo Dios al hombre a su imagen", me dijeron (cf. Gn 1,27). Hay más para ti que el pozo interminable de querer más dinero y cosas. De hecho, más glorioso aún, se me dijo que fui creado para la adoración de Aquel que me creó. Mi corazón deseoso fue diseñado para Él, pero ha sido infectado con una antigua enfermedad terminal que corrompió mi propósito trascendente en la tierra. En lugar del banquete celestial, me conformé con migas de pan rancio. El mundo me alejó de mi Dios; Olvidé quién era. Permití que extraños me dijeran lo que yo valía.

En la cacofonía de la confusión, Dios estableció una misión de rescate para sacarme del pozo. "Cuando llegó la plenitud de los tiempos, Dios envió a su Hijo, que nació de mujer..." (Cf. co indiferente, todavía proclama triunfalmente en cada siglo y criatura: "se han acercado al cerro de Sión, a la ciudad del Dios vivo, a la Jerusalén celestial con sus innumerables ángeles, a la asamblea en fiesta de los primeros ciudadanos del cielo; a Dios, el juez universal, al que rodean los espíritus de los justos que ya alcanzaron su perfección; a Jesús, el mediador de la nueva alianza, llevando la sangre que purifica y que clama a Dios con más fuerza que la sangre de Abel" (Heb 12:22-24)

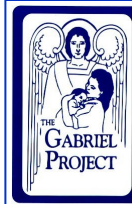
