FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

In 1999, Cardinal Joseph Ratzinger (who would become Pope Benedict XVI in 2005) wrote one of his most important works entitled "The Spirit of the Liturgy" (Ignatius Press, 1999) At the beginning of book, Cardinal Ratzinger brings up a theory which understands liturgy in terms of "play". It was a theory that was first proposed in the 1920's and Ratzinger noted that there is some validity to comparing liturgy to play or to a game. Like a liturgy, a game has its own rules, establishes its own world and the game is played out for a certain period of time, but then it is concluded and the playing of the game is suspended. Also, the Cardinal noted that "play, though it has a meaning, does not have a purpose and for this very reason there is something healing, even liberating, about it". (p. 13) He goes on to explain how when we engage in games or sports, we are taken out of our day to day life. We need these times of retreat. With all this, Cardinal Ratzinger notes that while there is some truth to comparing the liturgy to games or to sports, the analogy is not enough. It depends on what kind of game we are playing, he writes. Some games can get very serious very quickly and then it just becomes a burden. "Whether we look at modern sport or at chess championships or, indeed, at any game, we find that play, when it does not degenerate into mere fooling about, quickly turns from being another world, a counter world or non-world, to being a bit of the normal world with its own laws." (p. 14)

In contrast to the kinds of games that adults engage in, children's play can be considered a closer match to the essence of liturgy. When children play, it is a kind of anticipation of life. Whether they realize it or not, they are rehearsing for life later on, without having to experience its burdens and gravity (like we adults tend to do). Comparing the liturgy to child's play reminds us that we are all children, or should be children, when it comes to the true life that we all yearn for, which is eternal union with God in heaven. In other words, liturgy is a rehearsal for heaven. In this way, liturgy helps us rediscover our true childhood. When we enter into the liturgy, whether it be our participation in Mass, praying the Liturgy of the Hours or some other liturgical prayer, we open ourselves to something greater that it is to come. We live in the hope that someday the yearning in our hearts will be fulfilled. As I often say at funeral Masses, we are "homesick for heaven". God made us to have this yearning in our hearts to be eternally united with him.

As many of you know, since I do mention it from time to time in my homilies, I enjoy sports. I enjoy playing them and following them as a fan. Still, I can be critical of what sports has become in our country. In many ways, sports have become a religion. Many people follow their sports teams with more ardor, energy and faithfulness than

they would ever follow their Lord and God. Some families get so caught up in the sports of their children, that they miss Mass on Sunday to go to soccer practice, a basketball game or something else. In a week, the Super Bowl will be played. Think of all the money spent to play the game, broadcast the game, attend the game, and watch the game on television. Ponder the amount of money spent on advertising. Still, in the end it is just a game. And, while the Super Bowl may be fun and entertaining for us fans of football, it is always a letdown when the team you want to win, loses.

God will never let us down. When we come to Mass or participate in some other kind of liturgical prayer or even take some time for personal prayer, it is always a win-win. We are allowing God to speak to us and He listens to us. Yes, certain kinds of prayer require rules, such as the instructions for properly celebrating and participating in the Mass. But, the "playing" of these rules is a preparation for life in heaven. God wants to fulfill our heart's greatest desire, which is to be with Him eternally in heaven. And that is a very good thing and a beautiful truth. May you have a blessed week!

QUINTO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

En 1999, el Cardenal Joseph Ratzinger (quien se convertiría en el Papa Benedicto XVI en 2005) escribió una de sus obras más importantes titulada “El Espíritu de la Liturgia”. (Ignatius Press, 1999) Al comienzo del libro, el Cardenal Ratzinger plantea una teoría que entiende la liturgia en términos de “juego”. Fue una teoría que se propuso por primera vez en la década de 1920 y Ratzinger señaló que tiene cierta validez comparar la liturgia con un juego. Como una liturgia, un juego tiene sus propias reglas, establece su propio mundo y el juego se juega durante un cierto período de tiempo, pero luego concluye y se suspende el juego. Además, el Cardenal señaló que “el juego, aunque tiene un significado, no tiene un propósito y por eso mismo tiene algo de curativo, incluso liberador”. (p. 13) Continúa explicando cómo cuando participamos en juegos o deportes, salimos de nuestra vida cotidiana. Necesitamos estos tiempos de retiro. Con todo esto, el Cardenal Ratzinger señala que hay algo de verdad en comparar la liturgia con juegos o deportes, la analogía no es suficiente. El escribe, depende de qué tipo de juego estamos jugando. Algunos juegos pueden volverse muy serios rápidamente y luego se convierten en una carga. “Ya sea que miremos el deporte moderno o los campeonatos de ajedrez o, de hecho, cualquier juego, encontramos que el juego, cuando no degenera en meras tonterías, rápidamente pasa de ser otro mundo, a un contra mundo o no-mundo, a ser un poco del mundo normal con sus propias leyes”. (pág. 14)

En contrario a los tipos de juegos en los que participan los adultos, el juego de los niños puede considerarse más cercano a la esencia de la liturgia. Cuando los niños juegan, es una especie de anticipación de la vida. Ya sea que se den cuenta o no, están ensayando para la vida más adelante, sin tener que experimentar sus cargas y gravedad (como tendemos a hacer los adultos). Comparar la liturgia con el juego de niños, nos recuerda que todos somos niños, o deberíamos ser niños, cuando se trata de la verdadera vida que todos anhelamos, que es la unión eterna con Dios en el cielo. En otras palabras, la liturgia es un ensayo para el cielo. De este modo, la liturgia nos ayuda a redescubrir nuestra verdadera infancia. Cuando entramos en la liturgia, ya sea nuestra participación en la Misa, rezando la Liturgia de las Horas o alguna otra oración litúrgica, nos abrimos a algo más grande que está por llegar. Vivimos con la esperanza de que algún día se cumpla el anhelo de nuestro corazón. Como a menudo lo digo en las Misas de funeral, tenemos “nostalgia por cielo”. Dios

nos hizo para tener este anhelo en nuestro corazón de estar eternamente unidos a él.

Como muchos de ustedes saben, ya que lo menciono de vez en cuando en mis homilias, disfruto de los deportes. Disfruto jugarlos y seguirlos como fanático. Aún así, puedo criticar en lo que se ha convertido el deporte en nuestro país. En muchos sentidos, los deportes se han convertido en una religión. Muchas personas siguen a sus equipos deportivos con más ardor, energía y fidelidad de lo que nunca seguirían a su Dios y Señor. Algunas familias se involucran tanto en los deportes de sus hijos, que se pierden la Misa dominical para ir a la práctica de fútbol, un partido de baloncesto o cualquier otra cosa. En una semana se jugará el Super Bowl (Super Tazón). Pienso en todo el dinero gastado para jugar, transmitir el juego, asistir al juego y verlo por televisión. Reflexione sobre la cantidad de dinero gastado en publicidad. Aún así, al final es solo un juego. Y, si bien el Super Bowl puede ser divertido y entretenido para los fanáticos del fútbol americano, siempre es una decepción cuando el equipo que quieres que gane, pierde.

Dios nunca nos fallará. Cuando venimos a Misa o participamos en algún otro tipo de oración litúrgica o incluso tomamos un tiempo para la oración personal, siempre es beneficioso para todos. Estamos permitiendo que Dios nos hable y Él nos escucha. Sí, ciertos tipos de oración requieren reglas, como las instrucciones para celebrar y participar correctamente en la Misa. Pero, el "juego" de estas reglas es una preparación para la vida en el cielo. Dios quiere cumplir el mayor deseo de nuestro corazón, el cual es estar con Él eternamente en el cielo. Y eso es algo muy bueno y una hermosa verdad. ¡Que tengan una bendecida semana!
