FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

A few days ago, I went to Elk Grove, the town I grew up in. When my family moved there in 1990, it was considered a small rural, farming community, much how Vacaville used to be. The population was a mere 17,000. Today, it's 180,000. I wish I went there for a happier occasion, but sadly, I returned to preside over a funeral of an old friend I had known since the 6th grade. We lost touch after we graduated high school, as relationships tend to do when we move into adulthood. His sister told me that he succumbed to drug addiction. It was a battle he waged with himself for over twenty years. Unfortunately, his heart could only endure so much. When I asked why he chose this destructive path, his sister simply said, "He wanted to escape." He wanted to stop feeling.

I simply nodded my head in agreement, understanding the need to "escape." The 17th century, famous French philosopher and mathematician, Blaise Pascal, poignantly said, "All of humanity's problems stem from man's inability to sit quietly in a room alone." When we sit in solitude and silence, you'll begin to notice the deep uncomfortable restlessness that rages within each and every one of us. Silence forces us to confront our inner demons and the pain of our lives. We all develop different ways of coping, whether that's eating, buying more stuff, or like my old friend, he dealt with his suffering with an indulgence of drugs.

There is a better way. In today's Gospel, Jesus says, "**Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him, may have eternal life.**" (John 3:14-15). The lifting of the serpent is a direct reference to Moses in the Book of Numbers 21:9. In that incident, the Israelites are complaining to God. To punish them, God sends them venomous serpents to "bite them" and "many died." They begged God to forgive their mistrust. God then instructed Moses to make a bronze statue of the same serpents and raise it upon a pole. Only those who looked upon it were saved. Jesus, refers back to this moment in describing what will eventually happen to him on the cross. We must ask ourselves, what did the serpent represent for the Israelite people in order to more profoundly understand Jesus on the Cross. Jesus links the two events. The serpent represents their deepest shame and pain. Therefore, the cross as well represents our darkness. If we want to be healed, we must stop running; we must stop trying to

escape. No amount of eating, drug abuse, or buying things will ever truly bring us the peace we so desperately desire. Only when we confront this shame and pain that we all have, with Jesus Christ upon the cross, will we finally be set free.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Hace unos días, fui a Elk Grove, la ciudad en la que crecí. Cuando mi familia se mudó allí en 1990, se consideraba una pequeña comunidad rural y agrícola, muy parecida a como solía ser Vacaville. La población era de apenas 17.000 habitantes. Hoy son 180.000. Desearía haber ido para una ocasión más feliz, pero lamentablemente, regresé para presidir el funeral de un viejo amigo que conocía desde el sexto grado. Perdimos el contacto después de graduarnos de la escuela secundaria, como tienden a suceder las relaciones cuando pasamos a la edad adulta. Su hermana me dijo que sucumbió a la adicción a las drogas. Fue una batalla que llevaba consigo mismo durante más de veinte años. Desafortunadamente, su corazón no podía soportar mucho. Cuando le pregunté por qué había elegido este camino destructivo, su hermana simplemente dijo: "Quería escapar". Quería dejar de sentir.

Simplemente asentí con la cabeza, entendiendo la necesidad de "escapar". En el siglo XVII, el famoso filósofo y matemático francés, Blaise Pascal, dijo conmovedoramente: "Todos los problemas de la humanidad provienen de la incapacidad del hombre para sentarse solo y en silencio en una habitación". Cuando nos sentamos en soledad y silencio, comenzará a notar la profunda inquietud incómoda que se desata dentro de todos y cada uno de nosotros. El silencio nos obliga a enfrentarnos a nuestros demonios internos y al dolor de nuestras vidas. Todos desarrollamos diferentes formas de afrontamiento, ya sea comiendo, comprando más cosas o, como mi viejo amigo, él lidiaba con su sufrimiento con una indulgencia de drogas.

Hay una mejor manera. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús dice: **"Así como Moisés levantó la serpiente en el desierto, así tiene que ser levantado el Hijo del hombre, para que todo el que crea en él tenga vida eterna"**. (Juan 3:14-15). El levantamiento de la serpiente es una referencia directa a Moisés en el Libro de Números 21:9. En ese incidente, los israelitas se quejan a Dios. Para castigarlos, Dios les envía serpientes venenosas para "morderlos" y "muchos murieron". Rogaron a Dios que perdonara su desconfianza. Entonces Dios instruyó a Moisés para que hiciera una

estatua de bronce de las mismas serpientes y la levantara sobre una asta. Solo aquellos que lo miraron se salvaron. Jesús, se refiere a este momento al describir lo que eventualmente le sucederá en la cruz. Debemos preguntarnos, ¿qué representaba la serpiente para el pueblo israelita para comprender más profundamente a Jesús en la Cruz? Jesús vincula los dos acontecimientos. La serpiente representa su vergüenza y dolor más profundo. Por lo tanto, la cruz también representa nuestra oscuridad. Si queremos ser sanados, debemos dejar de correr; debemos dejar de intentar escapar. Ninguna cantidad de comida, abuso de drogas o de compra cosas nos traerá realmente la paz que tan desesperadamente deseamos. Solo cuando nos enfrentemos a esta vergüenza y dolor que todos tenemos, con Jesucristo en la cruz, finalmente seremos liberados.
