FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

Every year during Lent, we have two or three feasts when Father wears white vestments instead of the Lenten violet vestments for the celebration of Mass. On February 22nd, we celebrated the Feast of the Chair of Peter, when the Church gives thanks to God for the shepherding of St. Peter and of his successors. As we know, through the power of the Holy Spirit, the Holy Father is empowered and enabled to teach the truth on matters of faith and morals. He cannot err when he speaks on these matters. This is a great gift to the Church's members. We know that we can cling to the rock of truth even when other messages are being cast about in the cacophony of the society in which we live. The two other white vestment days are the solemnities are St. Joseph (March 19th) and the Annunciation of the Lord (March 25th).

It seems right and just that these three feasts are highlighted during Lent. Through Mary's yes to the Lord through the angel, Mary made it possible for Our Savior to be born among us. Mary gave herself to being Jesus's Mother, raised Jesus and accompanied Him to the cross. As he hung dying on the cross, Jesus gave Mary over to the care of the apostle John. It was made clear that she was to be not only the Mother of God, but also the Mother of the Church. For all these reasons, we honor Mary in a special way on the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. Likewise, we honor St. Joseph this coming Friday (March 19th), because he trustingly took Mary to be his wife and was a kind, generous and upright father to Jesus. St. Joseph is an excellent model of holiness to all men, and especially to husbands and fathers. In his Apostolic Letter "Patris Corde" (With a Father's Heart) Pope Francis designated this year the "Year of St. Joseph". I hope to unpack the Holy Father's letter in upcoming articles.

We give thanks to God for our patroness, the Blessed Virgin Mary, for St. Joseph and for the gift of the papacy. And we pray that through the intercession of Saints Mary, Joseph and Peter that we may grow greater holiness this Lent.

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

Cada año durante la Cuaresma, tenemos dos o tres fiestas cuando el Padre usa vestimentas blancas en lugar de las vestiduras violetas cuaresmales para la celebración de la Misa. El 22 de febrero celebramos la Fiesta de la Cátedra de Pedro, cuando la Iglesia da gracias a Dios por el pastoreo de San Pedro y de sus sucesores. Como sabemos, por medio del poder del Espíritu Santo, el Santo Padre está fortalecido y habilitado para enseñar la verdad sobre asuntos de fe y moral. No puede equivocarse cuando habla sobre estos asuntos. Este es un gran regalo para los miembros de la Iglesia. Así mismo, honramos a San José este próximo viernes (19 de marzo), porque con confianza llevó a María a ser su esposa y fue un padre bondadoso, generoso y recto para Jesús. San José es un excelente modelo de santidad para todos los hombres, y especialmente para los esposos y los padres. En su carta apostólica "Patris Corde" (Con Corazón de Padre) el Papa Francisco designó este año el "Año de San José". Espero descifrar la carta del Santo Padre en los próximos artículos.

Demos gracias a Dios por nuestra patrona, la Santísima Virgen María, por San José y por el don del papado. Y oremos para que, mediante la intercesión de los Santos María, José y Pedro, crezcamos en santidad esta Cuaresma.

La oración colecta

Esta oración se recita después que el sacerdote dice: "Oremos". Está precedida por un momento de silencio en el cual la asamblea, en silencio, presenta sus peticiones a Dios. El sacerdote que preside la celebración, las "colecta", de ahí el nombre de esta oración y, siguiendo una tradición antiquísima de la Iglesia: "Se dirige regularmente a Dios Padre por Cristo en el Espíritu Santo" (Instrucción General para el Uso del Misal Romano, 54). Esta misma oración es la que constituye a la asamblea como una comunidad orante, pues no sólo la invita a orar, sino a ser consciente de la presencia de Dios. El Amén que concluye la oración reafirma lo dicho por el sacerdote, por ello debe ser contundente. La razón de esta oración que "recoge" la intención del pueblo, explica la postura orante del sacerdote: de pie y con las manos extendidas.
