FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Do you believe in Jesus Christ? This simple, yet powerful question is at the heart of who we are as Christians. To say yes is a statement of life, a proclamation of one's deepest identity. From the outside, when all of you look at me, you see your pastor, your priest, for indeed that is who I am. I am a man, born to loving parents, Chris and Faye. I am the younger brother of Michelle, raised in Elk Grove, in a loud Filipino-American household. I grew up watching the Sacramento Kings play, or should I say, lose, to the Los Angeles Lakers in that pivotal playoff series to Kobe and Shaq in the early 2000s. All of these things, while true, fail to answer the more fundamental reality, "But who am I?"

Jesus reveals the greatest answer. It's almost too good to be true. St. Melito, in an Easter Sunday homily in the 2nd century, put it his way: *"For the sake of suffering humanity he came down from heaven to earth, clothed himself in that humanity in the Virgin's womb, and was born a man. Having then a body capable of suffering, he took the pain of fallen man upon himself; he triumphed over the diseases of soul and body that were its cause, and by his Spirit, which was incapable of dying, he dealt man's destroyer, death, a fatal blow."*

Jesus comes down from Heaven to restore the relationship with our Heavenly Father that we lost through Original Sin. Who am I? I am a Son of God. I am infinitely more than what the world can offer, with all its glittery fame and fortune. For all its shine, we all know the sad reality that everything we've worked so hard to achieve will pass into the dustbin of history. No one on earth will remember me. Even if I achieved such a lofty status as to have marble statues made of me or great monuments built in honor of my achievements, like Alexander the Great or the pharaohs of Egypt, I am not any of those things. Christianity offers still more. Jesus Christ restores me to my heavenly identity. Nothing on earth can even come close to competing with what our Catholic faith offers each and every one of us. I believe in Jesus Christ, the Risen one.

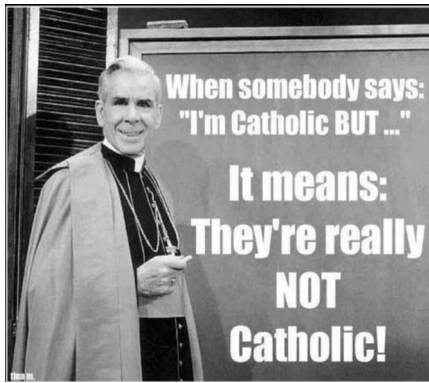

DOMINGO DE PASCUA—LA RESURRECCIÓN DEL SEÑOR

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,
 ¿Crees en Jesucristo? Esta pregunta simple pero poderosa está en el corazón de quienes somos como cristianos. Decir sí, es una declaración de vida, una proclamación de la propia identidad profunda. Desde afuera, cuando todos ustedes me miran, ven a su párroco, a su sacerdote, porque efectivamente eso soy yo. Soy un hombre, nacido de padres amorosos, Chris y Faye. Soy el hermano menor de Michelle, y crecí en Elk Grove, en un ruidoso hogar filipino-estadounidense. Crecí viendo a los Sacramento Kings jugar, o debería decir perder ante Los Lakers de Los Angeles, en esa serie fundamental de playoffs contra Kobe y Shaq a principios de la década de 2000. Todas estas cosas, si bien son ciertas, no responden a la realidad más fundamental: "Pero ¿quién soy yo?"

Jesús revela la mayor respuesta. Es casi demasiado bueno para ser verdad. San Melitón, en una homilía del Domingo de Pascua en el siglo II, lo expresó a su manera: "Por amor a la humanidad sufriente descendió del cielo a la tierra, se vistió de esa humanidad en el vientre de la Virgen y nació hombre. Teniendo entonces un cuerpo capaz de sufrir, tomó sobre sí el dolor del hombre caído; triunfó sobre las enfermedades del alma y del cuerpo que eran su causa, y por su Espíritu, el cual era incapaz de morir, asestó al destructor del hombre, la muerte, un golpe fatal".

Jesús desciende del Cielo para restaurar la relación con nuestro Padre Celestial, la cual perdimos por el Pecado Original. ¿Quién soy? Soy un Hijo de Dios. Soy infinitamente más de lo que el mundo puede ofrecer, con toda su brillante fama y fortuna. A pesar de todo su brillo, todos conocemos la triste realidad de que todo lo que hemos trabajado arduamente para lo-

gros, pasará al basurero de la historia. Nadie en la tierra se acordará de mí. Incluso si lograra un estatus tan elevado como para que me hicieran estatuas de mármol o se construyeran grandes monumentos en honor a mis logros, como Alejandro Magno o los faraones de Egipto, no soy ninguna de esas cosas. El cristianismo ofrece aún más. Jesucristo me restaura a mi identidad celestial. Nada en la tierra puede siquiera acercarse a competir con lo que nuestra fe católica nos ofrece a todos y cada uno de nosotros. Creo en Jesucristo, el Resucitado.
