FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

When the renaissance artist Raphael walked into the newly painted ceiling of the Sistine Chapel in Vatican City, it took his breath away. Michelangelo had created a masterpiece of human genius through the stroke of a brush. Never before had man brought into being such astonishing beauty on a large scale. Raphael was utterly amazed, he felt embarrassed by his own painting he had just finished in what is now in the Vatican Museum. Yet, Raphael was no slouch himself. He is arguably one of the greatest painters of all time. Michelangelo was a freak of nature. What these Renaissance artists strived to do was capture the beauty of Catholic teaching through paint and sculptured stone. They sought to bring spiritual truths to the senses of our eyes, touch, smell, and ears. They wanted to follow the logic of Jesus' own Incarnation, where the invisible God took on our human flesh, in order that we may see him.

In April, 1520, Raphael was lying on his deathbed. He knew that the end of his life was near. It is here at the moment the Christian teaching about life after death, comes to the forefront of one's mind. Let's be honest, death can be terrifying. It's the great unknown. For Raphael the same fear must have struck him to his bones as he laid on that bed waiting for the final sleep. It was then that he asked for one of the paintings he made a few years prior to brought into his room. Out of all the paintings he made over his career, he specifically asked for the one entitled "The Transfiguration". It depicts the famous scene that we will hear about in this Sunday's Gospel: "**Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother**, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. And he was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light." (Cf. Matthew 17:1-2)

Here at this moment, Jesus removes the veil from their eyes and reveals his true identity. Jesus is truly God in the flesh. If Jesus is truly God, then suddenly every word that comes from his mouth must be taken seriously. We cannot simply blow them off because they are inconvenient for us to hear. If Jesus is truly God, I must faithfully follow him in all his commandments, for he tells us directly in the Gospel of John, "If you love Me, keep **My commandments** ... He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me ... If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him." (Cf. John 14:15-24). I want to be with Jesus forever. How can anything else compare to him? Why would I choose something else?

If Jesus is indeed God, then I know I am made for eternal life in Heaven. Life is short here and over in a flash of light, even if I live to be 100 years old. My heart must belong to him, not to the lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes, or the pride of life. If I take the divinity of Jesus to heart, I must be reminded of this every single day, otherwise I will easily become distracted by the world. Raphael, the great artist, knew this. That is why he wanted that painting in his room to be the last thing he saw with his earthly eyes.

SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

5 de marzo de 2023

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Cuando el artista renacentista Raphael entró y miro el techo recién pintado de la Capilla Sixtina en la Ciudad del Vaticano, se quedó sin aliento. Miguel Ángel había creado una obra maestra del genio humano a través del trazo de un pincel. Nunca antes el hombre había creado tan asombrosa belleza a tan gran escala. Raphael estaba completamente asombrado, se sentía avergonzado por su propia pintura que acababa de terminar en lo que ahora se encuentra en el Museo del Vaticano. Sin embargo, Raphael no se quedó atrás. Podría decirse que es uno de los mejores pintores de todos los tiempos. Miguel Ángel era un fenómeno de la naturaleza. Lo que estos artistas del Renacimiento se esforzaron por hacer fue captar la belleza de la enseñanza católica a través de pintura y piedra esculpida. Ellos buscaron la forma de traer verdades espirituales a los sentidos de nuestros ojos, tacto, olfato y oídos. Querían seguir la lógica de la propia Encarnación de Jesús, donde el Dios invisible tomó nuestra carne humana, para que lo pudiéramos ver.

En abril de 1520, Raphael ya en su lecho de muerte. Sabía que el final de su vida estaba cerca. Es aquí en el momento en que la enseñanza cristiana sobre la vida después de la muerte pasa a primer plano en la mente de uno. Seamos honestos, la muerte puede ser aterradora. Es lo gran desconocido. Para Raphael, el mismo miedo debe haberlo golpeado hasta los huesos mientras yacía en esa cama esperando el sueño final. Fue entonces cuando pidió uno de los cuadros que había pintado unos años antes y que lo llevaran a su habitación. De todos los cuadros que pintó a lo largo de su carrera, pidió en concreto el que lleva por título "La Transfiguración". Representa la famosa escena que escucharemos en el Evangelio de este domingo: **"Jesús tomó consigo a Pedro, a Santiago y a Juan, el hermano de éste, y los hizo subir a solas con él a un monte elevado. Ahí se transfiguró en su presencia: su rostro se puso resplandeciente como el sol y sus vestiduras se volvieron blancas como la nieve."** (Cf. Mateo 17,1-2)

Aquí, en este momento, Jesús les quita el velo de sus ojos y les revela su verdadera identidad. Jesús es verdaderamente Dios en la carne. Si Jesús es verdaderamente Dios, entonces, de repente, cada palabra que sale de su boca debe tomarse seriamente. No podemos ignorar sus palabras simplemente porque son inconvenientes para que las escuchemos. Si Jesús es verdaderamente Dios, debo seguirlo fielmente en todos sus mandamientos, pues nos dice directamente en el Evangelio de Juan: "Si ustedes me aman, guardarán **mis mandamientos**... El que guarda mis mandamientos después de recibirlos, ése es el que me ama...El que no me ama no guarda mis palabras...Si al-

guien me ama, guardará mis palabras, y mi Padre lo amará. Entonces vendremos a él para poner nuestra morada en él" (Cf. Juan 14, 15-24). Quiero estar con Jesús para siempre. ¿Cómo puede algo más compararse con él? ¿Por qué elegiría otra cosa?

Si Jesús es en verdad Dios, entonces sé que estoy hecho para la vida eterna en el Cielo. La vida es corta aquí y se acaba en un destello de luz, incluso si vivo hasta los 100 años. Mi corazón debe pertenecerle a él, no a los deseos de la carne, los deseos de los ojos o el orgullo propio en nuestra vida. Si tomo en serio la divinidad de Jesús, debo recordar esto todos los días, de lo contrario, me distraeré fácilmente con el mundo. Raphael, el gran artista, lo sabía. Por eso quería que ese cuadro en su habitación fuera lo último que vieran sus ojos terrenales.
