FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Last weekend, our hardworking Faith Formation team, family volunteers, the amazing sisters of Pro Ecclesia Sancta, Fr. Reji and myself had the great pleasure of serving the Confirmation retreat for over sixty of our teenagers who will be confirmed this June. When asked why they wanted to receive this Sacrament, a consistent theme emerged from the kids: "I want to get closer to God." That's the perfect answer! In that seemingly simple response, lies the throbbing, passionate heart of Catholic spirituality. I dare say, it's the answer that unlocks the mystery of what it means to be a human being. The desire to get "closer" to God points all the way back to the beginning of creation itself. As God constructs the universe, the stars, the earth, the land, the oceans, the sky, animals and finally you and I, the Bible tells us that each human being is made in God's "image and likeness" (Cf. Genesis 1:27). In other words, we are made for communion; we're made for relationships. Never forget this deepest reality of our identity. Love is the reason why we exist. God himself is love, as Jesus Christ reveals. He is a Holy Trinity of eternal relationship of Father loving the Son, the Son loving the Father, and this love between them is the Holy Spirit (Cf. 1 John 4:7).

Stamped within each of us is the mystery of this Trinitarian love. We're designed to be "closer to God." Our hearts will always remain restless if we fail to live according to this reality. At the retreat, I wanted to bring this point to the kids. I asked them a basic question: "If you want to achieve happiness, what are we, as the adults in your life, telling you? What messages are you hearing through social media, movies, music, school etc.?" As the kids raised their hands I would write the answers on a whiteboard. The responses were fairly typical: "Get good grades!". "Big house." "Good job". One of the boys yelled, "Get a girlfriend!" They started to giggle. After I wrote their answers on the board, I took a step back looking at all they said. Then I asked them, "Are we missing anything else?" They nodded their heads no. "Now", I said, pausing briefly for dramatic effect. "Raise your hands if you hear from all the different messages you get on a daily basis from the culture, that you need God to be happy?" No one raised their hands. It was complete silence.

Compare that to the words of Jesus in the Gospel this Sunday. Our savior tells us: "Amen, amen, I say to you, I am the gate for the sheep... I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture." (Cf. John 10:9-10). Jesus is resolute here; he leaves no wiggle room. He holds himself as the absolute path to the "pasture". If we are searching for the answers to life's most daunting questions, what is the purpose of existence? What is my deepest identity? What must I do to find happiness? Jesus tells us he is the most perfect answer.

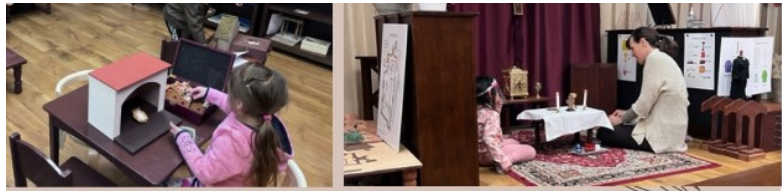

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

El fin de semana pasado, nuestro equipo trabajador de formación en la fe, familiares voluntarios, las increíbles hermanas de Pro Ecclesia Sancta, el Padre Reji y yo tuvimos el gran placer de servir en el retiro de Confirmación de más de sesenta de nuestros adolescentes que serán confirmados este junio. Cuando se les preguntó a los jóvenes por qué querían recibir este Sacramento, surgió un patrón consistente entre los jóvenes: **“Quiero acercarme más a Dios”**. ¡Esa es la respuesta perfecta! En esa respuesta aparentemente simple, se encuentra el corazón palpitante y apasionado de la espiritualidad católica. Me atrevo a decir que esta es la respuesta la que abre el misterio de lo que significa ser un ser humano. El deseo de estar "más cerca" de Dios apunta al camino de regreso al comienzo de la creación misma. Así como Dios construye el universo, las estrellas, el mundo, la tierra, los océanos, el cielo, los animales y finalmente a ti y a mí, la Biblia nos dice que cada ser humano está hecho “a imagen y semejanza” de Dios (cf. Génesis 1 :27). En otras palabras, estamos hechos para la comunión; estamos hechos para las relaciones. Nunca olvides esta realidad más profunda de nuestra identidad. El amor es la razón por la que existimos. Dios mismo es amor, como lo revela Jesucristo. Él es una Santísima Trinidad de relación eterna del Padre que ama al Hijo, el Hijo que ama al Padre, y este amor entre ambos es el Espíritu Santo (cf. 1 Juan 4, 7).

Grabado dentro de cada uno de nosotros está el misterio de este amor trinitario. Estamos diseñados para estar “más cerca de Dios”. Nuestros corazones siempre permanecerán inquietos si no somos capaces de vivir de acuerdo con esta realidad. En el retiro, quería llevar este punto a los jóvenes. Les hice una pregunta básica: “Si quieren alcanzar la felicidad, ¿qué les estamos diciendo, como los adultos en su vida? ¿Qué mensajes están escuchando a través de las redes sociales, películas, música, escuela, etc.?” Mientras que los jóvenes levantaban la mano para compartir, yo escribía las respuestas en un pizarrón. Las respuestas fueron bastante típicas: “¡Conseguir buenas notas!”. “Una casa Grande.” “Buen trabajo”. Uno de los chicos gritó: “¡Conseguir una novia!” Empezaron a reírse. Después de escribir sus respuestas en el pizarrón, di un paso hacia atrás mirando todo lo que dijeron. Entonces les pregunté: “¿Nos falta algo más?” Ellos asintieron con la cabeza que no. “Ahora”, dije, haciendo una breve pausa para lograr un efecto dramático. “Levanta la mano si escuchas de todos los diferentes mensajes que recibes a diario de la cultura, que necesitas a Dios para ser feliz”. Nadie levantó la mano. Era un completo silencio.

Compare eso con las palabras de Jesús en el Evangelio de este domingo. Nuestro salvador nos dice: **“Yo soy la puerta: el que entre por mí estará a salvo; entrará y saldrá y encontrará alimento. El ladrón sólo viene a robar, matar y destruir, mientras que yo he venido para que tengan vida y la tengan en plenitud.”** (Cf. Juan 10, 9-10). Jesús está decidido aquí; no deja margen de flexibilidad. Se sostiene como el camino absoluto hacia la “pastura”. Si buscamos las respuestas a las preguntas más abrumadoras de la vida, ¿cuál es el propósito de la existencia? ¿Cuál es mi identidad más profunda? ¿Qué debo hacer para encontrar la felicidad? Jesús nos dice que él es la respuesta más perfecta.

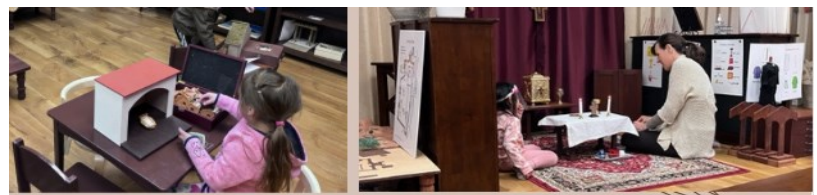
