FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ changes everything. Upon this one single doctrine of our Christian religion, the entire 2,000-year-old edifice of the Catholic Church is built. If Jesus is still dead, then St. Paul is absolutely correct: *"if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain, your faith also is in vain."* (Cf. 1 Corinthians 15:14). We should all go home. However, we proclaim the tomb is empty! He lives, just as our Lord promised us he would. That means we are no longer enslaved to death and sin. This Sunday, now known as Divine Mercy Sunday, we encounter the unfathomable greatness of God. There is no sin so heinous, so foul, for God to turn his face away from us. The following story I first shared with last Divine Mercy Sunday. It's one of the most amazing stories of God's love I have ever heard in my life. It demonstrates the power of the Resurrection. I share it again to ensure that as many of St. Mary's parishioners know about it.

The little known story of Rudolf Höss proves it. He was born into a devout Catholic family in the year 1900. His father, being a former military officer, raised him with strict moral principles and discipline. At one point he was even going to become a priest until he had a falling out with his local pastor. Somehow, he felt this priest had betrayed his trust. Whatever happened, he grew bitter towards the faith he once loved. Around the same time, a sweeping political movement was gaining momentum in Germany. A fiery politician held these huge rallies, where thousands gathered to hear this man speak about the glory of the German people. He attended one of these rallies in Munich and became absolutely enthralled by this politician – his name was Adolf Hitler. After that speech, he renounced his Catholic faith and joined the Nazi Party.

Once in the military, he was recognized as someone with great potential and moved up the ranks. From 1940-1943 he was assigned to Auschwitz, the most important concentration camp in the Nazi prison system. It was his gruesome genius to implement the gas chambers in order to make the execution of the Jews more "efficient". When the war was over, he would eventually be captured and sent to Nuremberg to stand trial for his actions. It was discovered that this single man was responsible for the deaths of 3 million. After his conviction, he is sent back to Poland (where Auschwitz was located) to face capital punishment. He said in his autobiography that this terrified him. He was afraid that the Polish people would torture him upon his return as revenge for what he did. Not so. In fact, he said in the Polish prison, *"I have experienced for the first-time what human kindness is. Despite all that has happened I have*

experienced humane treatment which I could have never expected and which has deeply shamed me." He acknowledges what he has done and his heart begins to soften.

As he is sitting in his jail cell awaiting his execution, he hears in the distance the ringing of a church bell. He recognizes the sound from his happy memories as a child. Immediately asks his guards to send for a priest to hear his confession. But sadly, there is no priest nearby that can speak German. However, he remembers the one German speaking priest he met years before in Auschwitz, who was one of the few lives he spared – a priest by the name of Fr. Vladislav Lon. Amazingly, he happens to be just a short drive away. Fr. Vladislav comes and hears his confession; he renews again his baptismal promises that he had rejected when he joined the Nazi Party. The next day the priest returns and brings him Holy Communion. According to the testimony of the prison guards, after Höss receives Communion, he falls to the ground in tears. This, my brothers and sisters, is the Divine Mercy we have before us. The Resurrection of Jesus Christ changes everything.

Segundo Domingo de Pascua / Domingo de la Divina Misericordia 7 de abril de 2024

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

La Resurrección de Jesucristo lo cambia todo. Sobre esta sola doctrina de nuestra religión cristiana, se construye toda la estructura de 2000 años de antigüedad de la Iglesia Católica. Si Jesús todavía está muerto, entonces San Pablo tiene toda la razón: “*Si Cristo no ha resucitado, vana es nuestra predicación, y vana también vuestra fe.*”. (Cf. 1 Corintios 15:14). Todos deberíamos irnos a casa. Sin embargo, ¡proclamamos que la tumba está vacía! Él vive, tal como nuestro Señor nos prometió que lo haría. Eso significa que ya no estamos esclavizados a la muerte y al pecado. Este domingo, ahora conocido como Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, nos encontramos con la inmensa grandeza de Dios. No hay pecado tan atroz, tan repugnante, para que Dios no nos quiera voltear a ver. La siguiente historia la compartí por primera vez el año pasado en el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Es una de las historias más asombrosas del amor de Dios que he escuchado en mi vida. Demuestra el poder de la Resurrección. La comparto de nuevo para asegurarme de que la mayoría de feligreses de Santa María la conozcan.

La historia poco conocida de Rudolf Höss lo demuestra. Nació en el seno de una devota familia católica en el año 1900. Su padre, ex militar, lo creó con estrictos principios morales y disciplina. En un momento incluso iba a convertirse en sacerdote hasta que tuvo una pelea con su párroco local. De alguna manera sintió que este sacerdote había traicionado su confianza. Lo que haya pasado, estaba resentido contra la fe que una vez amó. Casi al mismo tiempo, un movimiento político arrollador estaba cobrando impulso en Alemania. Un político feroz realizaba estos mítines enormes, donde miles se reunían para escuchar a este hombre hablar sobre la gloria del pueblo alemán. Rudolf asistió a uno de estos mítines en Munich y quedó absolutamente cautivado por este político-su nombre era Adolf Hitler. Después de ese discurso, renunció a su fe católica y se unió al Partido Nazi.

Una vez en el ejército, fue reconocido como alguien con un gran potencial y subió de rango. De 1940 a 1943 estuvo asignado en Auschwitz, el campo de concentración más importante del sistema penitenciario nazi. Fue por su espantosa genialidad que se implementaron las cámaras de gas para hacer más “eficiente” la ejecución de los judíos. Cuando termino

la guerra, eventualmente fue capturado y enviado a Nuremberg para ser juzgado por sus acciones. Se descubrió que este solo hombre fue responsable de la muerte de 3 millones. Después de su condena, es enviado de regreso a Polonia (donde se localizaba Auschwitz) para enfrentar la pena capital. Dijo en su autobiografía que esto lo aterrorizaba. Tenía miedo de que el pueblo polaco lo torturara a su regreso como venganza por lo que había hecho. No fue así. De hecho, dijo de la prisión polaca: “*He experimentado por primera vez lo que es la bondad humana. A pesar de todo lo que ha pasado, he experimentado un trato humano que nunca podría haber esperado y que me ha avergonzado profundamente.*”. Reconoce lo que ha hecho y su corazón comienza a ablandarse.

Mientras está sentado en su celda esperando su ejecución, escucha a lo lejos el sonido de la campana de una iglesia. Reconoce el sonido de sus recuerdos felices cuando era niño. Inmediatamente pide a sus guardias que manden llamar a un sacerdote para que escuche su confesión. Pero, lamentablemente, no había ningún sacerdote cerca que hablara alemán. Sin embargo, recuerda al único sacerdote de habla alemana que conoció años antes en Auschwitz, quien fue una de las pocas vidas que perdonó-un sacerdote llamado Padre Vladislav Lon. Sorprendentemente, se encuentra a poca distancia en auto. Padre Vladislav viene y escucha su confesión; renueva nuevamente sus promesas bautismales que había rechazado cuando se unió al Partido Nazi. Al día siguiente el sacerdote regresa y le trae la Sagrada Comunión. Según el testimonio de los guardias de la prisión, después de recibir la Comunión, Höss cae al suelo llorando. Esta, mis hermanos y hermanas, es la Divina Misericordia que tenemos ante nosotros. La Resurrección de Jesucristo lo cambia todo.

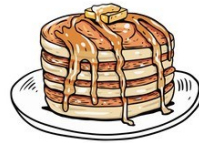


En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús se encuentra en medio de nosotros y nos dice: “¡La Paz este con ustedes!”

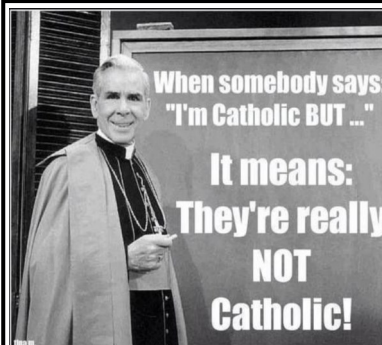
