FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Easter Day always brings a flood of memories. When I was young, going to Easter Sunday Mass was non-negotiable, even though at the time my family was just nominally Catholic. Coming from a Filipino background, the vast majority of us that you meet are Catholic, or at the very least, culturally so. We had to go to Mass, no matter the excuse. However, as an eight-year old kid, Easter Sunday seemed torturously long. I was one of those kids that could not keep still no matter how hard I tried. My mom would always ask me if I had "ants in my pants." She'd stealthily pinch me like a ninja, when I started to embarrass her.

Now it's all changed. I can't live without the Holy Mass. The key to living our Catholic faith with the passion of a thousand suns is to embrace the centrality of the person at the center of each celebration. It's not I, as the priest. It is the Risen Jesus Christ! Behold at each Mass, the great mysteries of the Christian faith unfold in all its splendor before our very eyes. Jesus is made substantially present. The same Jesus that died, rose again, and now sits at the right hand of our Heavenly Father, comes to us again and again. Each Easter Sunday, we renew the vows of our own baptism in order to reignite the flame of love that can sometimes grow cold over time. The Christian faith is like a fire that needs constant attention, otherwise it will slowly wither into lifeless charred coals.

A life lived in Christ, is the truest of lives. Without him, we are slaves to the whims and changes of our circumstances. Without him my value depends on the approval and affirmation of others. Without him, death itself will devour me, no matter how much vegetables I eat. Not anymore! The resurrected Jesus changes everything. If Jesus is alive as we Christians joyfully affirm, it means that Jesus is truly who he claimed to be – God in the flesh. The words he told Martha in the Gospel of John during the infamous account of the death of her brother Lazarus, can suddenly takes on new power: *"Jesus said to her, 'I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?'"* She said to Him, *'Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Christ, the Son of God, who is to come into the world.'*" (Cf. John 11:25-27).

And now I ask you, my dear Christian, the same Christian asked Martha, "Do you believe this?" Do you? Do you believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of

God? Do you believe that he has been raised from the dead? Do you believe that he has opened the gates of Heaven for us through the pouring of his precious blood upon the cross? Do you believe that we shall join him in Heaven, as long as we stay faithful to his commandments, even if the world mocks us for our love? How we answer these critical questions will change how we live Easter Sunday.

DOMINGO DE PASCUA - LA RESURRECCIÓN DEL SEÑOR

9 de abril de 2023



DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

El día de Pascua siempre trae una avalancha de recuerdos. Cuando yo era joven, ir a la Misa del Domingo de Resurrección no era negociable, aunque en ese momento mi familia era supuestamente católica. Viniendo de origen filipino, la gran mayoría de nosotros que conocen somos católicos, o al menos culturalmente. Teníamos que ir a Misa, sin ninguna excusa. Sin embargo, como un niño de apenas ocho años, el Domingo de Pascua me parecía tortuosamente largo. Yo era uno de esos niños que no podía estar quieto, sin importar cuánto yo lo intentara. Mi mamá siempre me preguntaba si tenía “hormigas en los pantalones”. Ella me pellizcaba discretamente como un ninja, cuando comenzaba a avergonzarse.

Ahora todo ha cambiado. No puedo vivir sin la Santa Misa. La clave para vivir nuestra fe católica, con la pasión de mil soles, es recibir con brazos abiertos la centralidad de la persona en el centro de cada celebración. No soy yo, como el sacerdote. ¡Es Jesucristo Resucitado! Contemplar que en cada Misa, los grandes misterios de la fe cristiana se despliegan en todo su esplendor ante nuestros propios ojos. Jesús se hace sustancialmente presente. El mismo Jesús que murió, resucitó y ahora está sentado a la derecha de nuestro Padre Celestial, viene a nosotros una y otra vez. Cada Domingo de Pascua, renovamos el compromiso de nuestro propio bautismo para volver a encender la llama del amor que a veces puede enfriarse con el tiempo. La fe cristiana es como un fuego que necesita atención constante, de lo contrario se apagará lentamente hasta convertirse en carbones chamuscados sin vida.

Una vida vivida en Cristo, es la vida más verdadera. Sin él, somos esclavos de los caprichos y cambios de nuestras circunstancias. Sin él mi valor depende de la aprobación y afirmación de los demás. Sin él, la misma muerte me devorará, no importa cuántas verduras coma. ¡Ya no! Jesús resucitado lo cambia todo. Si Jesús está vivo, como los cristianos afirmamos con alegría, significa que Jesús es realmente quien dijo ser: Dios carne. Las palabras que le dijo a Marta en el Evangelio de Juan durante el infame relato de la muerte de su hermano Lázaro, de pronto adquieren un nuevo poder: “*Le dijo Jesús: «Yo soy la resurrección*

(y la vida). El que cree en mí, aunque muera, vivirá. El que vive, el que cree en mí, no morirá para siempre. ¿Crees esto? Ella contestó: Sí, Señor; yo creo que tú eres el Cristo, el Hijo de Dios, el que tenía que venir al Mundo.» (cf. Juan 11, 25-27).

Y ahora les pregunto mis queridos cristianos, el mismo cristiano le preguntó a Marta: “¿Creen esto?” ¿Si lo creen? ¿Creen que Jesucristo es el Hijo de Dios? ¿Creen que ha resucitado de entre los muertos? ¿Creen que nos ha abierto las puertas del Cielo al derramar su preciosa sangre sobre la cruz? ¿Creen que nos uniremos a Él en el Cielo, mientras permanezcamos fieles a sus mandamientos, incluso si el mundo se burla de nosotros por nuestro amor? La forma en que respondamos estas críticas preguntas cambiará la forma en que vivimos el Domingo de Resurrección.
