FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Last Sunday we pondered the question during my Sunday homily, "What type of Christian does the world need?" I was trying to zero in on the answer of what type of Christian attracts more souls to Jesus Christ and his Church? This question forces us to reflect whether or not I am living the Christian life well. As we hear this Sunday, every single baptized Christian is sent out into the world to share the great Good News of Jesus Christ. Our Lord instructs us resolutely: **Go into the world and proclaim the gospel to every creature. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned.** It's a tremendous responsibility that we have been given. Souls are literally hanging in the balance. It behooves me to live my faith like a saint, with all the tenacity and passion it requires to be a disciple of Jesus Christ. Soft, compromising Christianity adds nothing of value to the world. In fact, I dare say, it only makes things worse.

Imagine what was going through the minds of those Twelve Apostles as our Lord gave them his last instructions before he ascended back into Heaven. "Why don't you stay!" I would have yelled. We need you to be with us. This mission is too hard to accomplish. I am too weak to finish the race. If any of us have these similar doubts arising in your hearts, we are absolutely correct. It is humanly impossible. The great, comforting truth is that we are never alone. Jesus told us directly, **"I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I am leaving; for if I do not leave, the Helper will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you"** (Cf. John 16:7).

He will send us the Holy Spirit; the same spirit that unites the Most Holy Trinity itself in eternal love, will now empower every single one of us. He will guide and lead. We need only bow and submit. We fear nothing as Christians, for we are now in the hands of this Holy Spirit. If you still doubt, look at our 2,000-year-old history. The fact that the Catholic Church still stands, despite the weakness of her members and the overwhelming power of our enemies, is an undeniable testament to

Jesus' own promise, **"... the gates of Hell will not overpower it"** (Cf. Matthew 16:18). And most consoling of all, **"Behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age"** (Cf. Matthew 28:20). Jesus sends each and every one of us on a mission to draw more souls to Him. To do that well, we must live this Christian faith with "fire" (Cf. Luke 12:49).

Solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor

12 de mayo de 2024

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

El domingo pasado reflexionamos sobre la pregunta durante mi homilía dominical: "¿Qué tipo de cristiano necesita el mundo?" Estaba tratando de concentrarme en la respuesta de ¿qué tipo de cristiano atrae más almas a Jesucristo y su Iglesia? Esta pregunta nos obliga a reflexionar si estoy viviendo bien o no la vida cristiana. Como escuchamos este domingo, cada cristiano bautizado es enviado al mundo para compartir la Buena Nueva de Jesucristo. Nuestro Señor nos instruye con determinación: **"Vayan por todo el mundo y prediquen el Evangelio a toda creatura. El que crea y se bautice, se salvará; el que se resista a creer, será condenado."** Es una tremenda responsabilidad la que se nos ha dado. Las almas están literalmente colgando de un hilo. Me corresponde vivir mi fe como un santo, con toda la tenacidad y pasión que requiere ser discípulo de Jesucristo. El cristianismo suave y transigente no añade nada de valor al mundo. De hecho, me atrevo a decir, sólo empeora las cosas.

Imagínese lo que pasaba por la mente de esos Doce Apóstoles cuando nuestro Señor les dio sus últimas instrucciones antes de ascender de regreso al Cielo. "¿Por qué no te quedas?" Yo hubiera gritado. Necesitamos que estés con nosotros. Esta misión es demasiado difícil de cumplir. Soy demasiado débil para terminar la carrera. Si alguno de nosotros tiene dudas similares surgiendo en sus corazones, estamos absolutamente en lo correcto. Es humanamente imposible. La gran y reconfortante verdad es que nunca estamos solos. Jesús nos dijo directamente: **"pero es verdad lo que les digo: les conviene que yo me vaya, porque mientras yo no me vaya, el Protector no vendrá a ustedes. Yo me voy, y es para enviárselo."** (Cf. Juan 16,7).

Él nos enviará el Espíritu Santo; el mismo espíritu que une a la Santísima Trinidad en el amor eterno, ahora nos empoderará a cada uno de nosotros. Él guiará y conducirá. Sólo necesitamos inclinarnos y someternos. No tememos nada como cristianos, porque ahora estamos en manos de este Espíritu Santo. Si aún dudas, mira nuestra historia de 2,000 años. El hecho de que la Iglesia Católica siga en pie, a pesar de la debilidad de sus miembros y el poder abrumador de nuestros enemigos, es un testimonio innegable de la

propia promesa de Jesús: **"... y sobre esta piedra edificaré mi Iglesia; los poderes de la muerte jamás la podrán vencer."** (Cf. Mateo 16:18). Y lo más consolador de todo: **"Yo estoy con ustedes todos los días hasta el fin de la historia."** (Cf. Mateo 28,20). Jesús nos envía a todos y cada uno de nosotros en una misión para atraer más almas hacia Él. Para hacerlo bien, debemos vivir esta fe cristiana con **"fuego"** (Cf. Lucas 12,49).

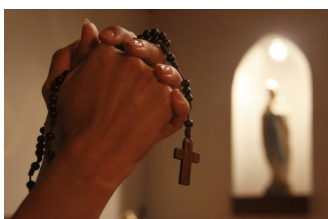

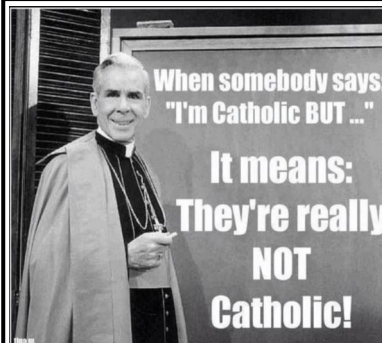
