FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

As we come to the stretch run of Easter season, we continue to give thanks to God for the gift of the Resurrection, our Lord's Ascension to heaven and the sending of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Celebrating the anniversary of the Son's Ascension to the Father this weekend, reminds us that Our Lord not only equipped the apostles to continue His work, but also He has given all of us what we need to continue His work. When I ponder the Ascension accounts, it always strikes me how joyful the apostles seemed to be that Our Lord was leaving them. It sounds strange to put it that way, doesn't it? Ponder again St. Luke's account: "Then he led them out as far as Bethany, and lifting his hands he blessed them. While he blessed them, he parted from them, and was carried up into heaven. And they worshiped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and were continually in the temple blessing God." (Lk 24:50-52) What a difference from shortly after Our Lord's Resurrection! Recall how Jesus would appear to the disciples on numerous occasions and they were often full of fear. By the time Jesus ascended to heaven, something changed. They had been strengthened, consoled and inspired to carry on. And, they knew that Jesus had given them the amazing, infinite gift of his grace, in general, and the grace of the sacraments, in particular.

"Be not afraid!" Jesus tells us. Well, we might say, that's easier said than done. Fear is a feeling based on knowing and not knowing. We might feel fear of something because we remember how that particular event unfolded in the past, and it wasn't good. We might feel fear of something because of the uncertainty of the present and the future. Many people have experienced much fear over the last 15 months of the pandemic. They have feared for themselves and for their loved ones. Yet, Jesus says: Be not afraid! As we see some light at the end of the tunnel with regard to the COVID-19 pandemic, it is important that we support those who may still be feeling fear of worshiping in our church. We can assure them that safety precautions are being taken at our parish. We can assure them of our prayers for them. In the end, however, fear of getting sick should not keep one from attending Mass.

In a letter to those under his pastoral care from last September when he re-instated the Sunday obligation, Archbishop Jerome Listecki of Milwaukee, put it this way: "Fear of getting sick, in and of itself, does not excuse someone from the obligation. However, if the fear is generated because of at-risk factors, such as preexisting conditions, age or compromised immune systems, then the fear would be sufficient to excuse from the obligation." Archbishop Listecki also reminded the faithful of the

importance of making a decision based on a well-formed conscience: "It is up to each individual to weigh their own circumstances through an examination of their conscience and determine, by use of their conscience, whether or not they are excused from the Sunday obligation. Remember, a well-formed conscience is upright and truthful."

In the Diocese of Sacramento, Bishop Soto has not yet re-instated the Sunday obligation. Nonetheless, he has reminded us to make Sunday holy in a recent pastoral letter. cf. <https://www.scd.org/call-to-holiness> If one is able to, one should attend Mass in person. If not, one can participate in a live-stream Mass and in other spiritual practices to make Sunday holy. In any case, we look forward to all of us being together in-person in St. Mary's Church where we can joyfully and fearlessly pray and worship together as a parish.



LA ASCENSION DEL SEÑOR

16 de mayo de 2021

Jesús fue llevado al cielo después de pedir a sus discípulos que fueran por todo el mundo proclamando el Evangelio (Marcos 16:15-20).



DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

Al llegar a la recta final de la Época de Pascua, seguimos dando gracias a Dios por el don de la Resurrección, la Ascensión de nuestro Señor al cielo y el envío del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés. Celebrando el aniversario de la Ascensión del Hijo al Padre este fin de semana, nos recuerda que Nuestro Señor no sólo equipó a los apóstoles para continuar Su obra, sino que también Nos ha dado a todos lo que necesitamos para continuar Su obra. Cuando reflexiono sobre los relatos de la Ascensión, siempre me impresiona lo alegres que parecían los apóstoles de que Nuestro Señor los dejaba. Suena raro decirlo de esa manera, ¿no creen? Medita de nuevo en el relato de San Lucas: "Después los condujo [fuera,] hacia Betania y, alzando las manos, los bendijo. Y, mientras los bendecía, se separó de ellos y fue llevado al cielo. Ellos se postraron ante él y se volvieron a Jerusalén muy contentos. Y pasaban el tiempo en el templo bendiciendo a Dios." (Lc 24:50-52) ¡Qué diferencia de poco después de la resurrección de Nuestro Señor! Recuerden cómo Jesús se acercaría a los discípulos en numerosas ocasiones y a menudo estaban llenos de miedo. Para cuando Jesús ascendió al cielo, algo había cambiado. Habían sido fortalecidos, consolados e inspirados para continuar. Y sabían que Jesús les había dado el asombroso e infinito don de su gracia, en general, y la gracia de los sacramentos, en particular.

"¡No tengas miedo!" Jesús nos lo dice. Bueno, podríamos decir que eso es más fácil decirlo que hacerlo. El miedo es un sentimiento basado en lo conocido y lo desconocido. Podríamos sentir miedo de algo porque recordamos cómo ese evento en particular se desarrolló en el pasado, y no fue bueno. Podríamos sentir miedo a algo debido a la incertidumbre del presente y del futuro. Muchas personas han experimentado mucho miedo en los últimos 15 meses de la pandemia. Han temido por sí mismos y por sus seres queridos. Sin embargo, Jesús dice: ¡No tengas miedo! Al ver algo de luz al final del túnel con respecto a la pandemia por el COVID-19, es importante que apoyemos a aquellos que todavía pueden estar sintiendo miedo de rendir culto en nuestra iglesia. Les podemos asegurar que se están tomando precauciones de seguridad en nuestra parroquia. Les podemos asegurar de nuestras oraciones por ellos. Al final, sin embargo, el miedo a enfermarse no debe impedir que uno asista a Misa.

En una carta a los fieles bajo su cuidado pastoral desde septiembre pasado, cuando volvió a establecer la obligación dominical, el Arzobispo Jerome Listecki, de

Milwaukee, lo dijo de esta manera: "El miedo de enfermarse, en sí mismo, no exime a alguien de la obligación. Sin embargo, si el miedo se genera debido a factores de riesgo, como condiciones preexistentes, edad o sistemas inmunológicos comprometidos, entonces el miedo sería suficiente para eximirse de la obligación." El Arzobispo Listecki también recordó a los fieles la importancia de tomar una decisión basada en una conciencia bien formada: "Corresponde a cada individuo sopesar sus propias circunstancias a través de un examen de su conciencia y determinar, mediante el uso de su conciencia, si se les exime o no de la obligación dominical. Recuerden, una conciencia bien formada es recta y verdadera."

En la Diócesis de Sacramento, el Obispo Soto aún no ha restablecido la obligación dominical. Sin embargo, nos ha recordado que hagamos santo el domingo en una reciente carta pastoral. cf. <https://www.scd.org/call-to-holiness> Si uno puede, uno debe asistir a Misa en persona. Si no, uno puede participar en una Misa transmitida en vivo y en otras prácticas espirituales para hacer el domingo Santo. En cualquier caso, esperamos pronto estar todos juntos en persona en la Iglesia de Santa María, donde podemos orar y rendir culto alegremente y sin miedo, juntos como parroquia.
