Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Thank you to the members of the Parish Council and to others who helped to make the reception for Fr. Joseph last Saturday evening such a pleasant event. The setting was beautiful, under the trees in front of the church and the weather cooperated as it was not too hot. Thank you to everyone who attended the event. As always, it is nice to go from "the altar to the table". As Catholics, our souls are nourished by the Eucharist, but our bodies need refreshment and our friendships need to be renewed and strengthened. Speaking of nourishment from the sacraments, please continue to pray for our First Communicants who are preparing to receive Our Lord in the Eucharist on Sunday, June 5<sup>th</sup> and please also pray for our youth who will be confirmed on Thursday, June 9<sup>th</sup>. We are also cranking up for the wedding season. Please keep our engaged couples in your prayers.

On another note, we are in the process of renewing the "cry room". I express my gratitude to Manuel Belo who donated the materials for a new floor as well as his time and labor and the labor of his assistant to installing the floor. Esteban Vargas and David Hernandez, our maintenance crew, gave the walls and the ceiling a new coat of paint. We will be furnishing the room in the coming weeks. Memorial Day gives us the chance to be more intentional in our prayer of thanksgiving for our fallen heroes, to pray for the repose of their souls and to pray that someday soon all war will be extinct. ### Rosary For First Saturday Devotion

After the appearances of Our Lady to the three shepherd children (Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco) in Fatima, Portugal in 1917, the Blessed Mother appeared separately to Sister Lucia in her convent in Pontevedra, Portugal (in 1925).

Our Lady asked for Lucia to make known a Devotion to Her Immaculate Heart, known as the First Saturdays Devotion.

Our Lady promised that she would assist at the hour of death, with all the graces necessary for salvation, all those, who, on the First Saturday of 5 consecutive months, 1) *confess*, 2) *receive Holy Communion*, 3) *pray the Holy Rosary* and 4) *meditate on the mysteries of the Rosary* with the intention of making reparation to Her for the blasphemies and offenses committed against Her Immaculate Heart.

**After the 8am Mass on Saturday, June 4th**, please join us inside St. Mary's Parish, as Father leads us in the opening prayer and Rosary of Reparation, followed by 15 minutes of meditation on the mysteries of the Holy Rosary.
