FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

This Sunday, June 20th, is Father's Day when we honor our fathers living and deceased. The blessing for fathers in the "Book of Blessings" on Father's Day goes like this:

God our Father, in your wisdom and love you made all things. Bless these men, that they be strengthened as Christian fathers. Let the example of their faith and love shine forth. Grant that we, their sons and daughters, may honor them always with a spirit of profound respect. Grant this through Christ our Lord.

It is appropriate to pray for our fathers really any day of the year, whether they are deceased or alive, whether we think they are, or were, very good fathers or whether we feel they are, or were not, such good fathers. Perhaps, especially if one's father were rather imperfect, it would be all the more important to pray for him.

My father died ten years ago, at the ripe old age of 92, on June 13th, 2011. I was blessed with an amazing father. What made him amazing in my mind? A lot of things, I suppose. One thing I liked about him was that when I was little, I could ask him any question that I could think of and he would have the answer. I remember my father encouraging me to be a good boy and later a holy young man. I benefitted from watching the way that my father loved my mother. It was clear that he loved my mother with his whole heart, respected her deeply and was completely devoted to her. When I wanted counsel about a certain decision I needed to make, I could ask my father for advice. I remember when I first told my father that I was considering a call to the priesthood, he was very surprised. He may have even been a bit disappointed, because, at the time, I was working with him on the management staff of the agribusiness that he had founded in 1951. Pursuing a vocation to the priesthood meant that my father and I would not be working side by side anymore doing something that both of us loved. Still, my father encouraged me and supported me in my studies as a seminarian and over the years in my various priestly assignments.

My father worked hard to support his family of twelve children. He sacrificed hobbies and interests in order that all of us could be fed, clothed, housed and educated. He took us on wonderful vacations and somehow made it possible for all of us to go to college. Yet, while he was a hard worker and a practical man, he was also very spiritual. Even though my mother was perhaps more naturally spiritual, my father was clearly the spiritual leader of the family. My father taught me much about being a spiritual father.

The "Blessing of Fathers" notes that we sons and

daughters should honor our fathers "with a spirit of profound respect". I think I can honor my father with profound respect by living and loving the way that he did. I am grateful that my father taught me how to be a man and how to be a father. He taught me how to be a son also, especially a son of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Although He was not a biological or adoptive father in the normal way, Jesus was and is a father. To be sure, He is a Son to the Divine Father in the Holy Spirit. But He is also a father to all who come to Him. Jesus is our Spiritual Father who heals us and loves us no matter what. Some have or had a rather imperfect father. If so, know that you can entrust yourselves to the fatherhood of Jesus and the fatherhood of the heavenly Father. All of us should learn to entrust ourselves to the fatherhood of God, whether that be to the Son or to the Father, or to both. That's a good lesson for any son or daughter.

¿Quién es éste, a quien hasta el viento y el mar obedecen? (Marcos 4:35-41).



DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa Maria:

Este domingo, 20 de junio, es el Día del Padre cuando honramos a nuestros padres vivos y difuntos. La bendición para los padres en el "Libro de Bendiciones" para el Día del Padre es la siguiente:

Dios Padre nuestro, en tu sabiduría y amor hiciste todas las cosas. Bendice a estos hombres, para que sean fortalecidos como padres cristianos. Que brille el ejemplo de su fe y amor. Concede que nosotros, sus hijos e hijas, podamos honrarlos siempre con un espíritu de profundo respeto. Concédelo a través de Cristo nuestro Señor.

Es apropiado orar por nuestros padres realmente cualquier día del año, ya sea que hayan fallecido o estén vivos, aunque pensemos que son, o fueron, muy buenos padres o si sentimos que son, o no, tan buenos padres. Tal vez, especialmente si el padre de uno fuese imperfecto, sería aún más importante orar por él.

Mi padre murió hace diez años, a la edad de 92 años, el 13 de junio de 2011. Fui bendecido con un padre increíble. ¿Qué lo hizo increíble en mi mente? Muchas cosas, supongo. Algo que me gustaba de él es que cuando yo era pequeño, podía hacerle cualquier pregunta que se me ocurría y él tenía la respuesta. Recuerdo que mi padre me motivaba a que fuera un buen chico y más tarde un joven santo. Me hizo bien ver la forma en que mi padre amaba a mi madre. Era evidente que amaba a mi madre con todo su corazón, la respetaba profundamente y estaba completamente dedicado a ella. Cuando quería algún consejo sobre una determinada decisión que tenía que tomar, podía pedirle consejo a mi padre. Recuerdo que cuando le dije por primera vez a mi padre que estaba considerando el llamado al sacerdocio, se sorprendió mucho. Incluso puede ser que se haya decepcionado un poco, porque, en ese momento, yo estaba trabajando con él en la dirección del personal del negocio de agroindustria que él había fundado en el 1951. Proseguir una vocación al sacerdocio significaba que mi padre y yo ya no estaríamos trabajando uno al lado del otro haciendo algo que ambos amábamos. Aún así, mi padre me animó y me apoyó en mis estudios como seminarista y a lo largo de los años en mis diversas asignaciones sacerdotales.

Mi padre trabajó arduamente para mantener a su familia de doce hijos. Sacrificó pasatiempos e intereses para que todos tuviéramos alimento, para vestirnos, educarnos, para darnos un techo y educación. Nos llevó a vacaciones maravillosas y de alguna manera hizo posible que todos nosotros fuéramos a la universidad. Sin embargo, aunque era muy trabajador y un hombre práctico, también era muy espiritual.

A pesar de que mi madre era quizás más espiritual por naturaleza, mi padre era claramente el líder espiritual de la familia. Mi padre me enseñó mucho acerca de ser un padre espiritual.

La "Bendición de los Padres" menciona que los hijos e hijas debemos honrar a nuestros padres "con un espíritu de profundo respeto". Creo que puedo honrar a mi padre con profundo respeto, viviendo y amando la forma en que lo hizo. Estoy agra-

decido de que mi padre me enseñó cómo ser un hombre y cómo ser un padre. También me enseñó cómo ser un hijo, especialmente un hijo de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Aunque Él no era un padre biológico o adoptivo de la manera normal, Jesús era y es un padre. Sin duda, Él es un Hijo del Padre Divino en el Espíritu Santo. Pero Él también es un padre para todos aquellos que vienen a Él. Jesús es nuestro Padre Espiritual que nos sana y nos ama sin importar lo que pase. Algunos tienen o tuvieron un padre bastante imperfecto. Si así es, sepan que pueden confiar en la paternidad de Jesús y a la paternidad del Padre celestial. Todos nosotros debemos aprender a confiar en la paternidad de Dios, ya sea al Hijo o al Padre, o en ambos. Esa es una buena lección para cualquier hijo o hija.
