FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

On July 25th, we begin *National Natural Family Planning Awareness Week*. As always, NFP Awareness Week falls around July 25th which is the date that Pope Paul VI promulgated *Humanae Vitae* ("Of Human Life"), the 1968 encyclical on the faithful transmission of human life. Among other things, *Humanae Vitae* (HV) affirmed that NFP is the only morally acceptable way, (besides relying on God's providence, which is, of course, completely acceptable), for couples to postpone or achieve pregnancy. In HV, Saint Pope Paul VI reminded spouses and all of us that God gifted couples with the privilege to be co-creators with Him in bringing forth new human life. He wrote: "...husband and wife, through that mutual gift of themselves, which is specific and exclusive to them alone, develop that union of two persons in which they perfect one another, cooperating with God in the generation and rearing of new lives." (HV, 8) If you have never read this beautiful encyclical, I encourage you to read it now. It is rather brief, probably 12 pages long.

As we mark the fifty-third anniversary of *Humanae Vitae*, it is good to review the wisdom of the Church's teaching on marriage and the precious gift given to parents to collaborate with God in bringing new life into the world. In this regard, Pope Paul VI prophetically pointed out in section 17 of *Humanae Vitae* that the widespread use of contraception would "lead to conjugal infidelity and the general lowering of morality". Moreover the Holy Father noted that "a man who grows accustomed to the use of contraceptive methods may forget the reverence due to a woman, and, disregarding her physical and emotional equilibrium, reduce her to being a mere instrument for the satisfaction of his own desires, no longer considering her as his partner whom he should surround with care and affection." Finally, Paul VI projected that the widespread acceptance of contraception would place a "dangerous weapon... in the hands of those public authorities who take no heed of moral exigencies." Clearly, as many commentators have noted, all three of these prophecies have come true over the last five decades.

The anniversary of *Humanae Vitae* reminds us to be ever more intentional about promoting and defending a morally sound and physically and spiritually healthy understanding of marriage. An understanding that expects couples preparing for marriage to remain chaste and celibate before their wedding day. An understanding that includes married couples remaining chaste after their wedding day by following Church teaching with regard to fidelity and fruitfulness, by remaining open to God's gift of children and only using natural and moral means, such as NFP, to space out the birth of their children. All of us need to be familiar with the sections in the Catechism on marriage and on the

Sixth and Ninth Commandments. No matter your state of life, if you are at least 18 years old, you should be informed about NFP, how it works, why it works and why the Catholic Church promotes it as a moral way to space the births of children on marriage. One should pass this teaching on to your children, your grandchildren, your friends and your co-workers. In this way, we may all become evangelizers of the truth, beauty and goodness of the Sacrament of Marriage and we may all be promoters of the Church's teaching on the sacred transmission of human life.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa Maria:

El 25 de julio, comenzamos la Semana Nacional de Concientización Sobre Planificación Familiar Natural. Como siempre, la Semana de Concientización de la PFN cae alrededor del 25 de julio, que es la fecha en que el Papa Pablo VI promulgó *Humanae Vitae* ("De la Vida Humana"), la encíclica de 1968 sobre la transmisión fiel de la vida humana. Entre otras cosas, *Humanae Vitae* (HV) afirmó que la PFN es la única forma moralmente aceptable, (además de confiar en la providencia de Dios, que es, por supuesto, completamente aceptable), para que las parejas pospongan o logren el embarazo. En HV, San Papa Pablo VI recordó a los cónyuges y a todos nosotros que Dios regaló a las parejas el privilegio de ser co-creadores con Él para traer una nueva vida humana. Escribió: Los esposos, mediante su recíproca donación personal, propia y exclusiva de ellos, tienden a la comunión de sus seres en orden a un mutuo perfeccionamiento personal, para colaborar con Dios en la generación y en la educación de nuevas vidas." (HV, 8) Si nunca han leído esta hermosa [encíclica](#), los animo a leerla. Es muy breve, probablemente de 12 páginas.

Al conmemorar el quincuagésimo tercer aniversario de *Humanae Vitae*, sería bueno repasar la sabiduría de la enseñanza de la Iglesia sobre el matrimonio y el precioso don dado a los padres para colaborar con Dios en traer nueva vida al mundo. Con respecto a esto, el Papa Pablo VI señaló proféticamente en la sección 17 de *Humanae Vitae* que el uso generalizado de la anticoncepción " el camino fácil y amplio que se abriría a la infidelidad conyugal y a la degradación general de la moralidad." Por otra parte, el Santo Padre señaló que " el hombre, habituándose al uso de las prácticas anticonceptivas, acabase por perder el respeto a la mujer y, sin preocuparse más de su equilibrio físico y psicológico, llegase a considerarla como simple instrumento de goce egoísta y no como a compañera, respetada y amada." Finalmente, Pablo VI proyectó que la aceptación generalizada de la anticoncepción colocaría una "arma peligrosa que de este modo se llegaría a poner en las manos de autoridades públicas despreocupadas de las exigencias morales". Claramente, como muchos comentaristas han señalado, las tres profecías se han hecho realidad en las últimas cinco décadas.

El aniversario de *Humanae Vitae* nos recuerda que seamos cada vez más intencionales promoviendo y defendiendo una comprensión moralmente sólida y física y espiritualmente saludable del matrimonio. Un entendimiento

que espera que las parejas que se preparan para el matrimonio permanezcan castas y célibes antes del día de su boda. Un entendimiento que incluye a las parejas casadas que permanecen castas después del día de su boda siguiendo las enseñanzas de la Iglesia con respecto a la fidelidad y la fecundidad, permaneciendo abiertas al don de los hijos de Dios y utilizando únicamente medios naturales y morales, como la PFN, para espaciar el nacimiento de sus hijos. Todos nosotros necesitamos estar familiarizados con las secciones del Catecismo sobre el matrimonio y sobre el Sexto y Noveno Mandamiento. No importa su estado de vida, si usted tiene por lo menos 18 años de edad, usted debe ser informado acerca de la PFN, cómo funciona, por qué funciona y por qué la Iglesia Católica lo promueve como una forma moral de espaciar el nacimiento de los hijos en el matrimonio. Uno debe compartir esta enseñanza a sus hijos, sus nietos, sus amigos y sus compañeros de trabajo. De esta manera, todos podemos convertirnos en evangelizadores de la verdad, la belleza y la bondad del Sacramento del Matrimonio y todos podemos ser promotores de la enseñanza de la Iglesia sobre la transmisión sagrada de la vida humana.
