THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

The office staff were stunned when the totals of last weekend's Missionary Appeal were tallied. Our parish raised an astonishing \$13,000. No one could remember the last time they saw such a high number. On behalf of Fr. Denis "The Menace" Hatungimana and myself, I want to thank you for your generosity. Tanzania is a far off, exotic place for most of us. Its mere name conjures up scenes from National Geographic or our 8th grade Social Studies class. I say to my shame, most people are probably like me, finding it difficult to point to this African country on a map. And yet despite this, many of you still gave out of your hard-earned money during these uncertain economic times. However, I should not be that surprised; giving is in our Christian blood.

Generosity has been a hallmark of the followers of Jesus Christ since the beginning of the Church over 2,000 years ago. In the first few centuries, pagans were awed at our charitable lifestyle. In a famous document written in the year 130AD, titled "[Letter to Diognetus](#)" a Christian is writing to a non-Christian who is baffled by this new religion emerging in the Roman Empire (Christianity was only about one hundred years old at the time. The total worldwide number of adherents was probably in the tens of thousands, compared to the 2 Billion it is today). The author writes:

There is something extraordinary about their lives. They live in their own countries as though they were only passing through... Any country can be their homeland, but for them their homeland, wherever it may be, is a foreign country. Like others, they marry and have children, but they do not expose them. They share their meals, but not their wives.

They live in the flesh, but they are not governed by the desires of the flesh. They pass their days upon earth, but they are citizens of heaven. Obedient to the laws, they yet live on a level that transcends the law. Christians love all men, but all men persecute them. Condemned because they are not understood, they are put to death, but raised to life again. They live in poverty, but enrich many; they are totally destitute, but possess an abundance of everything.

As Christians we are called to give wildly of our wealth back to God. Why? Is God broke? Does he need to pay rent? Maybe God is like the mafia, whom we need to pay off? Absolutely not! God has no need of our wealth. Yet God does desire something exponentially more important. He wants our hearts. Ever since Original Sin, all the way in the beginning of the Book of Genesis with Adam and Eve, humanity separated themselves from God. We replaced Him with the love of money, possessions and our towering ego. God knows that we love these worldly things too much. In order to slowly turn our hearts, He calls each of us to give a percentage of income back to Him. Even though the Church has never given us an exact amount to give each Sunday, she does ask us to be a "cheerful giver" (Cf. 2 Cor 9:7). Whatever we give, just make sure it stings. That's a sign of our pride wailing in pain as it's being replaced by the divine love for which we were originally created for.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María, El personal de la oficina quedó atónito cuando se contaron los totales de la Campaña Misionera del fin de semana pasado. Nuestra parroquia recaudó la cantidad de \$13,000. Nadie podía recordar la última vez que se vio un número tan alto. En nombre del Padre Denis "The Menace" Hatungimana y de mi parte, quiero agradecerles por su generosidad. Tanzania es un lugar lejano y exótico para la mayoría de nosotros. Su mero nombre evoca escenas de "Geografía Nacional" (National Geographic) o a nuestra clase de estudios sociales del octavo grado. Digo, para mi vergüenza, que la mayoría de la gente probablemente sea como yo, y les resulte difícil señalar este país africano en un mapa. Y, sin embargo, a pesar de esto, muchos de ustedes aun así dieron de su dinero ganado con el sudor de su frente, durante estos tiempos económicos inciertos. Sin embargo, no debería sorprenderme tanto; dar está en nuestra sangre Cristiana.

La generosidad ha sido un sello distintivo de los seguidores de Jesucristo desde el comienzo de la Iglesia hace más de 2000 años. En los primeros siglos, los paganos estaban asombrados por nuestro estilo de vida caritativo. En un famoso documento escrito en el año 130 d.C., titulado "[Carta a Diogneto](#)", un cristiano le escribe a un no cristiano que está desconcertado por esta nueva religión que surge en el Imperio Romano (el cristianismo tenía solo unos cien años en ese momento. El número total mundial de adherentes probablemente eran decenas de miles, en comparación con los 2 mil millones que son hoy). El autor escribe:

Habitan en su propia patria, pero como forasteros; toman parte en todo como ciudadanos, pero lo soportan todo como extranjeros; toda tierra extraña es patria para ellos, pero están en toda patria como en tierra extraña. Igual que todos, se casan y engendran hijos, pero no se deshacen de los hijos que conciben. Tienen la mesa en común, pero no el lecho.

Viven en la carne, pero no según la carne. Viven en la tierra, pero su ciudadanía está en el Cielo. Obedecen las leyes establecidas, y con su modo de vivir superan estas leyes. Aman a todos, y todos los persiguen. Se los condena sin conocerlos. Se les da muerte, y con ello reciben la vida. Son pobres, y enriquecen a muchos; carecen de todo, y abundan en todo.

Como cristianos, estamos llamados a dar extremadamente de nuestra riqueza a Dios. ¿Por qué? ¿Dios está pobre? ¿Tiene que pagar el alquiler? ¿Quizás Dios es como la mafia, a quien debemos pagar? ¡Absolutamente no! Dios no tiene necesidad de nuestras riquezas. Sin embargo, Dios desea algo exponencialmente más importante. Él quiere nuestros corazones. Desde el Pecado Original, hasta el principio del Libro del Génesis con Adán y Eva, la humanidad se separó de Dios. Lo reemplazamos con el amor al dinero, las posesiones y nuestro imponente ego. Dios sabe que amamos demasiado estas cosas mundanas. Para volver lentamente nuestros corazones, Él nos llama a cada uno de nosotros a devolverle un porcentaje de los ingresos. Aunque la Iglesia nunca nos ha dado una cantidad exacta para dar cada domingo, sí nos pide que seamos "dadores alegres" (cf. 2 Cor 9:7). Lo que sea que demos, solo asegúrate de que lastime. Esa es una señal de que nuestro orgullo llora de dolor al ser reemplazado por el amor divino para el que fuimos creados originalmente.

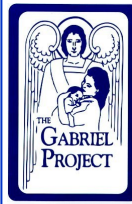
