## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

During these dog days of summer, things continue to move along in the parish. While it is true that our schoolchildren and their families are still enjoying a few more weeks of summer vacation before commencing a new school year and while a number of parishioners are getting away for vacation, there is still plenty going on in the life of the parish. For example, after not meeting for a while, our parish council will convene this coming week. In the spring, all the parish councils of the diocese took part in an on-line convocation. The four-hour event helped us to review the purpose of the parish council and how meetings should be conducted. As a follow-up to the convocation, Bishop Soto has given each parish the task of discussing certain topics at each meeting. I look forward to meeting again with the parish council and setting our goals and expectations for the coming year.

On another topic, while our religious classes are on hiatus during the summer, we are actively preparing for the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation on August 28<sup>th</sup> when Bishop Soto will confirm about 60 youth. In preparation for the Confirmation Mass, our confirmation students will participate in a retreat on the weekend of August 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>. This last year, students in our religious education program were taught at home by their parents. Our catechists provided support and counsel. Monthly gatherings at the parish brought together the parents and the catechists during which course material for the month was covered and talks were given by Fr. Steven, Sr. Eileen, Sr. Adriana, Sr. Laura, a couple of other catechists and me. To be sure, in many cases, parents felt challenged to teach their children about the faith. Yet, I think it was an opportunity for the parents to learn, along with their children, even more about the Catholic faith. The Church has always taught that the parents, by their very nature, are the primary educators of their children. It took a pandemic for us to really give the parents the experience of catechizing their children at home.

Regarding other parish initiatives, we are actively getting information to proceed with the installation of sound panels on the upper walls of the church nave. As you know, it is not always easy to hear what is being proclaimed and preached in the church on account of the amplified sound bouncing off the hard surfaces. It can be especially difficult to hear clearly when there are fewer people in the church. I am confident that the sound panels will provide a noted positive difference, while at the same time, not take away from the physical beauty of the church. Hopefully, this project will be completed within the next few months.

Finally, as I mentioned last week, July 25<sup>th</sup> marks the beginning of "National Natural Family Planning Awareness Week" when we recall and promote the truth, beauty and goodness of the Church's teaching on chaste marital and

familial love. On Saturday, July 31<sup>st</sup>, we will be hosting the diocesan annual NFP event in our hall which will bring together NFP promoters and marriage preparation coordinators from many of the parishes in the Diocese of Sacramento. Bishop Jaime Soto will celebrate a Mass in our church on Saturday, July 31<sup>st</sup>, at 11 am. All are invited to attend the Mass. Andreya Arevalo, our parish Youth Minister and certified *FertilityCare* Practitioner, who also wears the hat of "Coordinator of Marriage and Family Life" for the Diocese, has been organizing the gathering. I anticipate that it will be a most wonderful and fruitful day!



### DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

Durante estos días calurosos de verano, las cosas siguen moviéndose a través de la parroquia. Aunque es cierto que nuestros niños de edad escolar y sus familias todavía están disfrutando de unas semanas más de vacaciones de verano antes de que comiencen un nuevo año escolar y mientras que varios feligreses se están tomando unas vacaciones, todavía hay mucho que hacer en la vida parroquial. Por ejemplo, después de no reunirse durante un tiempo, nuestro consejo parroquial se reunirá esta próxima semana. Durante la primavera, todos los consejos parroquiales de la diócesis participaron en una convocatoria por línea. El evento de cuatro horas nos ayudó a repasar el propósito del consejo parroquial y cómo se deben llevar a cabo las reuniones. Como seguimiento a la convocatoria, el obispo Soto ha dado a cada parroquia la tarea de discutir ciertos temas en cada reunión. Espero reunirme nuevamente con el consejo parroquial y establecer nuestras metas y expectativas para el próximo año.

En otro tema, mientras que nuestras clases religiosas están en pausa durante el verano, nos estamos preparando activamente para la celebración del Sacramento de la Confirmación el 28 de agosto, cuando el obispo Soto confirmará a unos 60 jóvenes. En preparación para la Misa de Confirmación, nuestros estudiantes de confirmación participarán en un retiro el fin de semana del 14 y 15 de agosto. Este último año, los estudiantes de nuestro programa de educación religiosa fueron instruidos en casa por sus padres. Nuestros catequistas proporcionaron apoyo y asesoramiento. Las reuniones mensuales en la parroquia reunieron a los padres y a los catequistas durante las cuales se cubrió el material del curso para el mes y se dieron charlas por parte del Padre Steven, Hrna. Eileen, Hrna. Adriana, Hrna. Laura, un par de otros catequistas y un servidor. Sin duda, en muchos casos, los padres enfrentaron desafíos al enseñar a sus hijos acerca de la fe. Sin embargo, creo que fue una oportunidad para que los padres aprendieran, junto con sus hijos, aún más sobre la fe católica. La Iglesia siempre ha enseñado que los padres, por su propia naturaleza, son los principales educadores de sus hijos. Nos tomó una pandemia para darles realmente a los padres la experiencia de catequizar a sus hijos en casa.

En cuanto a otras iniciativas parroquiales, estamos recibiendo activamente información para proceder a la instalación de paneles de sonido en las paredes superiores de la nave de la iglesia. Como ustedes saben, no siempre es fácil escuchar lo que se está proclamando y predicando en

en la iglesia a causa del sonido amplificado que rebota en las superficies duras. Puede ser especialmente difícil escuchar claramente cuando hay menos personas en la iglesia. Estoy seguro de que los paneles de sonido proporcionarán una diferencia notable positiva, mientras que, al mismo tiempo, no afectan la belleza física de la iglesia. Esperamos completar este proyecto en los próximos meses.

Finalmente, como mencioné la semana pasada, el 25 de julio marca el comienzo de la "Semana Nacional de Concientización sobre la Planificación Familiar Natural" cuando recordamos y promovemos la verdad, la belleza y la bondad de la enseñanza de la Iglesia sobre el amor casto conyugal y familiar. El sábado, 31 de julio, organizaremos el evento anual diocesano de PFN en nuestro salón parroquial en el cual se reunirá a promotores de PFN y coordinadores de preparación para el matrimonio de muchas de las parroquias de la Diócesis de Sacramento. El obispo Jaime Soto celebrará una Misa en nuestra iglesia el sábado 31 de julio a las 11 de la mañana. Todos están invitados a asistir a esta Misa. Andreya Arévalo, nuestro ministro del Grupo Juvenil parroquial y practicante certificada de FertilityCare, quien también lleva el sombrero de "Coordinadora de Matrimonio y Vida Familiar" para la Diócesis, ha estado organizando la reunión. Anticipo que será un día maravilloso y fructífero.


