*delight in evil but rejoices with the truth.*" (Cf. 1 Corinthians 13:4-6). This type of friendship is the hardest of them all to build. It requires blood, sweat, and tears. It forces me to die to myself every single day. Even though it's the most challenging, I say we do it anyway.

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

What is a Christian community?

It's a question that I've continually pondered. What makes a Christian community different from all the other groups that my life is composed of? When you think about it, our lives are made up of various groups, some that are intertwined with others, some completely separate. The most obvious community that first comes to mind is our family. We are all born into families; in fact this is our first community. We do not choose our family members, as much as we may want to at times, especially when they get on our nerves. This first "community" is founded by blood and sustained by love.

The next most common community is similar. They are our friends. The network of people we willingly choose to spend time with. The great ancient Greek philosopher Aristotle delineated three categories of friendships: **(1) Friendship of Utility (2) Friendship of Pleasure and (3) Friendship of Virtue.** The first relationship is derived from mutual benefit, a means to an end. They use one another for something they could not otherwise receive. It's the shallowest of friendships because it exists insofar as the advantage persists.

The second type of friendship, as the name suggests, brings enjoyment to our lives. Built on similar values, they help define who we are and make us feel at home. They give us a powerful sense of identity. Aristotle sometimes calls this "friendships for the young" because they can easily fall away when our values and tastes change, as they often do when we mature.

Final category is the noblest of them all. They are rooted in the inherent value of the other as a person to be loved, apart from any personal benefit they may receive. These friendships strive for a higher good above themselves. They challenge one another to seek this goodness apart from any selfish need. They seek to grow in virtue together. Which of these categories matches the heart of the Christian community? It's the Friendship of Virtue. However, the highest good here is not something, but rather "someone". It is Christ himself. Christian relationship is founded upon Jesus and strives to be more in union with him. It's far above any personal tastes or whims. Rather, the Christian seeks Christ first and then invites others to do so. All other behavior and actions flow from this lofty goal. As St. Paul beautifully reminds us in the most famous Scripture reading for weddings tells us: *"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not*

## Rosary For First Saturday Devotion

After the appearances of Our Lady to the three shepherd children (Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco) in Fatima, Portugal in 1917, the Blessed Mother appeared separately to Sister Lucia in her convent in Pontevedra, Portugal (in 1925). Our Lady asked for Lucia to make known a Devotion to Her Immaculate Heart, known as the First Saturdays Devotion.

Our Lady promised that she would assist at the hour of death, with all the graces necessary for salvation, all those, who, on the First Saturday of 5 consecutive months, 1) *confess*, 2) *receive Holy Communion*, 3) *pray the Holy Rosary* and 4) *meditate on the mysteries of the Rosary* with the intention of making reparation to Her for the blasphemies and offenses committed against Her Immaculate Heart.

# DECIMOCTAVO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

## DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

¿Qué es una comunidad Cristiana?

Es una pregunta que continuamente me hago. ¿Qué hace diferente a una comunidad cristiana de todos los demás grupos que componen mi vida? Cuando lo piensas, nuestras vidas se componen de varios grupos, algunos que están entrelazados con otros, algunos completamente separados. La comunidad más obvia que primero viene a la mente es nuestra familia. Todos nacemos en familias; de hecho, esta es nuestra primera comunidad. No elegimos a los miembros de nuestra familia, por mucho que a veces así lo queramos, especialmente cuando nos ponen de nervios. Esta primera "comunidad" está fundada por la sangre y la sostiene el amor.

La siguiente comunidad más común es similar. Ellos son nuestros amigos. La red de personas con las que voluntariamente elegimos pasar tiempo. El gran antiguo filósofo griego, Aristóteles, delineó tres categorías de amistades: **(1) Amistad de utilidad (2) Amistad de placer y (3) Amistad de virtud.** La primera relación se deriva del beneficio mutuo, un medio para un fin. Se usan unos a otros para algo que de otra forma no podrían recibir. Es la más superficial de las amistades porque existe en la medida en que persiste la ventaja.

El segundo tipo de amistad, como su nombre lo indica, trae alegría a nuestras vidas. Construidos sobre valores similares, ayudan a definir quiénes somos y nos hacen sentir como en casa. Nos dan un poderoso sentido de identidad. Aristóteles a veces llama a esto "amistad para los jóvenes" porque pueden desaparecer fácilmente cuando nuestros valores y gustos cambian, como sucede a menudo cuando maduramos.

La categoría final es la más noble de todas. Están enraizados en el valor inherente del otro como una persona a ser amada, independientemente de cualquier beneficio personal que pueda recibir. Estas amistades luchan por un bien, aún sobre el de ellos mismos. Se retan unos a otros a buscar esta bondad independientemente de cualquier necesidad egoísta. Buscan crecer juntos en virtud.

¿Cuál de estas categorías coincide con el corazón de la comunidad cristiana? Es la amistad de virtud. Sin embargo, el bien mayor aquí no es algo, sino "alguien". Es Cristo mismo. La relación cristiana se basa en Jesús y se esfuerza por estar más en unión con él. Está muy por encima de cualquier gusto o capricho personal. Más bien, el cristiano busca primero a Cristo y luego invita a otros a hacerlo. Todos los demás comportamientos y acciones flu-

yen de este elevado objetivo. Como San Pablo nos recuerda hermosamente en la lectura bíblica más famosa para las bodas: **"El amor es paciente y muestra comprensión. El amor no tiene celos, no aparenta ni se infla. No actúa con bajeza ni busca su propio interés, no se deja llevar por la ira y olvida lo malo. No se alegra de lo injusto, sino que se goza en la verdad."** (Cf. 1 Corintios 13: 4-6). Este tipo de amistad es la más difícil de construir de todas. Requiere sangre, sudor y lágrimas. Me obliga a morir a mí mismo todos los días. Aunque es el más desafiante, digo que lo hagamos de todos modos.
