FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

As Fr. Joseph Sebastian begins his assignment at our parish, I wanted to share with you some biographical details that I found out about him. Fr. Joseph was born in 1978 in Punalur, Kerala, India the oldest of two boys. Fr. Joseph's father is a farmer, his mother is a homemaker and his brother lives in Dubai with his wife and two children where he works as a civil engineer. Fr. Joseph studied English and Kerala literature in college and also obtained a degree in education from Indira Gandhi National Open University. Later, Father earned a Masters degree in police administration. After those studies, Fr. Joseph studied for the priesthood in India and credits his strong prayer life beginning in childhood which helped him discern clearly God calling him to the priesthood. On December 27th, 2008, Fr. Joseph was ordained to the priesthood for the Congregation of the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI).

In his first assignment, Fr. Joseph served as Director of St. Xavier's Technical School in Basanti Sunderbans, West Bengal, India. From 2013 to 2014, Father served as Vice-Principal and Administrator of KE Cannel School in Sarisba, West Bengal, India. He then served for a year as Vice-Principal and Boarding Director in another school. From 2015 to 2018, Fr. Joseph served as Vice-Principal and Administrator of Christ Nagar group of institutions and Director of Christ Nagar School in Kuchipuram, Trivandrum, Kerala. Finally, from 2018 until summer 2019, Fr. Joseph served as Principal of Christ Nagar Public School in Attingal, Trivandrum, Kerala. In the summer of 2019, Fr. Joseph was assigned as a Parochial Vicar at St. John Vianney Parish in Rancho Cordova.

To be sure, Fr. Joseph brings with him much pastoral and administrative experience. We are blessed to have Father Joseph here at St. Mary's! As you can imagine, Fr. Joseph will find plenty to do as St. Mary's is a vibrant parish. Fr. Joseph told me that he looks forward to meeting everyone and getting to know you all. Welcome to St. Mary's Parish Fr. Joseph! May the good Lord bless you abundantly and work through you to bring others to Him!

2021 Missionary Cooperative Appeal (MCA)

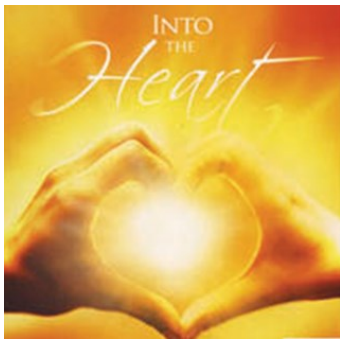
The Missionary Cooperative Appeal is an annual program in which missionaries from around the world speak at each parish. This year we will have no missionaries present in our parish due to the current situation. The goal of this appeal is to increase awareness of missionary work and to raise funds to help missionary organizations continue their evangelization efforts. In the Diocese of Sacramento, 49 different missions were selected this year. In 2019, through generous denotations, we collected \$441,000 for 49 missions.

Next weekend, our parish will be participating in the Missionary Cooperative Appeal. We will learn about a mission (virtually) who will share with us their courageous evangelization efforts on behalf of the Catholic Church and give us an opportunity to support their work in the field. A second collection will be taken up following the presentation. Special envelopes will be provided for your convenience. **Donations made by check should be made payable to the parish.** All funds collected throughout the Diocese will be equally divided among the 49 missionary organizations. 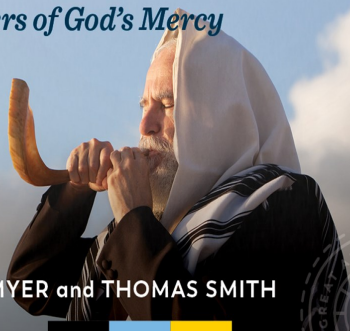

Después de esos estudios, el Padre Joseph estudió para el sacerdocio en la India y acredita su sólida vida de oración comenzando desde su infancia, lo cual le ayudó a discernir claramente al llamado de Dios al sacerdocio. El 27 de diciembre de 2008, el Padre Joseph fue ordenado como sacerdote para la Congregación de las Carmelitas de María Inmaculada (CMI).

En su primera asignación, el Padre Joseph sirvió como director de la Escuela Técnica de St. Xavier en Basanti Sunderbans, Bengala Occidental, India. del 2013 al 2014, el Padre se desempeñó como Vice-Principal y Administrador de la Escuela KE Cannel en Sarisba, Bengala Occidental, India. Después se desempeñó como Vice-Principal y director de Internado en otra escuela. Del 2015 al 2018, el Padre Joseph sirvió como Vice-Principal y Administrador del grupo de instituciones Cristo Nagar y Director de la Escuela Cristo Nagar en Kuchipuram, Trivandrum, Kerala. Finalmente, desde el 2018 hasta el verano de 2019, el Padre Joseph sirvió como director de la Escuela Pública Cristo Nagar en Attingal, Trivandrum, Kerala. En el verano de 2019, el Padre. Joseph fue asignado como Vicario Parroquial en la Parroquia St. John Vianney en Rancho Cordova.

Sin duda, el Padre Joseph trae consigo mucha experiencia pastoral y administrativa. ¡Estamos bendecidos de tener al Padre Joseph aquí en Santa María! Como se pueden imaginar, el Padre Joseph encontrará bastante que hacer, ya que Santa María es una parroquia vibrante. Ofrecer pan y vino en el altar es ofrecer nuestra propia vida a hacernos pan para que todos coman; vino para que todos tengan vida en abundancia.

Así, nadie podrá traerte malas noticias.
