FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

As of a couple of weeks ago, we have a new Director of Music: Dominick DiCarlo. Some of you may have noticed Dominick at the 10a Mass the last couple of Sundays. Dominick is a native of Davis, where he grew up as a parishioner of St. James and regularly participated in the liturgical music there. He attended Davis High School where he played in the band and sang in the Madrigal choir. Majoring in music at UC Davis, he decided to work in liturgical music after he experienced the amazing patrimony of the church, specifically chant and sacred polyphony, in the context of the Mass. Dominick then taught music and theology at Jesuit High School in Tampa, FL. As the choir director there he helped to create beautiful and reverent liturgies which brought young men to the faith. After seven years in Florida, Dominick is very excited to be returning to home and to parish ministry. His goal is always to enrich the Mass with beautiful music from the tradition of the Church in a way that facilitates devotion, is mindful of the music's liturgical purposes, is consistent with applicable liturgical norms, and encourages the faithful to participate fully and reverently in the mysteries being celebrated. The Director of Music is a part-time position. During the week, Dominick will keep busy serving as the new headmaster of the Chesterton Academy in Dixon. As Director of Music, Dominick will continue to draw on the gifts of those who have contributed to the enrichment of liturgical music at St. Mary's over the years. Welcome Dominick DiCarlo!

Regarding our liturgical music, one of the slight changes that you may have noticed at our Sunday morning Masses in English is that the antiphons are being chanted at the Entrance, at the Offertory and at Communion, in addition to congregational singing that we are doing. Regarding the chanting of the antiphons, the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* (GIRM) explains the following:

In the Dioceses of the United States of America, there are four options for the Entrance Chant:

- (1) the antiphon from the Missal or the antiphon with its Psalm from the *Graduale Romanum*, as set to music there or in another setting;
- (2) the antiphon and Psalm of the *Graduale Simplex* for the liturgical time;
- (3) a chant from another collection of Psalms and antiphons, approved by the Conference of Bishops or the Diocesan Bishop, including Psalms arranged in responsorial or metrical forms;
- (4) another liturgical chant that is suited to the sacred action, the day, or the time of year, similarly approved by the Conference of Bishops or the Diocesan Bishop. (GIRM, 48)

Paragraphs 74 and 87 of the *GIRM* explain that what is said about the Entrance, also applies to the Offertory and Communion chants. Most parishes, including St. Mary's, have typically used the fourth option: "another liturgical chant". However, it seems right and just to use the antiphons that are actually assigned to a particular liturgy and are held in esteem. That's why we are using the antiphons at the Sunday morning Masses.

On another note, I would like to share with you that I will be away on sabbatical from August 16th until late November. Our Diocese allows priests to go on a sabbatical of 3 or 4 months every 7 years. In 23 years of priesthood, I have never taken a sabbatical. While I look forward to this time of renewal, I know that I will miss you all dearly. But I will not be far away and, no doubt, will return from time to time for a visit. During my sabbatical, I will have a room at St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park where I will be able to stay and be close to a library that I can use for academic studies. Towards the end of my sabbatical, I plan to do a thirty-day silent retreat, the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola. For the retreat, I will be at a retreat house in South Dakota. In my absence, Fr. Joseph Sebastian will oversee things and Msgr. James Murphy, Fr. Maurice O'Brien and Fr. Vincent O'Reilly will be helping out as well.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa Maria:

Desde hace un par de semanas, tenemos un nuevo Director de Música: Dominick DiCarlo. Puede ser que algunos de ustedes vieron a Dominick en la misa 10^a los últimos dos domingos. Dominick es nativo de Davis, donde creció como feligrés de St. James y participó regularmente en la música litúrgica. Asistió a la Escuela Secundaria de Davis, donde tocó en la banda y cantó en el coro Madrigal. Especializándose en música en UC Davis, decidió trabajar en música litúrgica después de experimentar el increíble patrimonio de la iglesia, específicamente el canto y la polifonía sagrada, en el contexto de la Misa. Después Dominick enseñó música y teología en la Escuela Secundaria Jesuita en Tampa, FL. Como director del coro allí ayudó a crear liturgias hermosas y reverentes que acercaron a los hombres jóvenes a la fe. Después de siete años en Florida, Dominick está muy contento de regresar a casa y al ministerio parroquial. Su objetivo es siempre enriquecer la Misa con música hermosa de la tradición de la Iglesia de una manera que facilite la devoción, sea consciente de los propósitos litúrgicos de la música, sea consistente con las normas litúrgicas aplicables y anime a los fieles a participar plena y reverentemente en los misterios que se celebran. El puesto de Director de Música es a tiempo parcial. Durante la semana, Dominick se mantendrá ocupado sirviendo como el nuevo director de la Academia Chesterton en Dixon. Como Director de Música, Dominick continuará atrayendo los dones de aquellos que han contribuido al enriquecimiento de la música litúrgica en Santa Maria a través de los años. ¡Bienvenido Dominick DiCarlo!

Con respecto a nuestra música litúrgica, uno de los pequeños cambios que usted pudo haber notado en nuestras Misas del domingo por la mañana en inglés, es que las antífonas se están cantando durante la entrada, durante el ofertorio y durante la comunión, además del canto congregacional que estamos haciendo. En cuanto al canto de las antífonas, la Instrucción General del Misal Romano (GIRM) explica lo siguiente:

En las Diócesis de los Estados Unidos de América, hay cuatro opciones para el Canto de Entrada:

- (1) la antífona del Misal o la antífona con su Salmo del Graduale Romanum, según lo puesto a la música allí o en otro ajuste;
- (2) la antífona y el Salmo del Graduale Simplex para el tiempo litúrgico;
- (3) un canto de otra colección de Salmos y antífonas, aprobado por la Conferencia episcopal o el

obispo diocesano, incluidos los salmos dispuestos en formas responsoriales o métricas;
(4) otro canto litúrgico que sea adecuado para la acción sagrada, el día o la época del año, igualmente aprobado por la Conferencia Episcopal o el Obispo Diocesano.
(GIRM, 48)

Los párrafos 74 y 87 del GIRM explican que lo que se dice sobre la Entrada, también se aplica a los cantos ofertorios y de comunión. La mayoría de las parroquias, incluyendo Santa María, han utilizado típicamente la cuarta opción: "otro canto litúrgico". Sin embargo, parece correcto y justo usar las antífonas que en realidad están asignadas a una liturgia en particular y se tiene en gran estima. Es por eso que estamos usando las antífonas en las Misas de los domingos por la mañana.

Cambiando de tema, me gustaría compartir con ustedes que estaré ausente en tiempo sabático desde el 16 de agosto hasta finales de noviembre. Nuestra Diócesis permite a los sacerdotes estar en tiempo sabático de 3 o 4 meses cada 7 años. En mis 23 años de sacerdocio, nunca me he tomado un tiempo sabático. Aunque espero con gusto este tiempo de renovación, sé que los echaré mucho de menos a todos. Pero no estaré muy lejos y, sin duda, volveré de vez en cuando para visitar. Durante mi tiempo sabático, tendré una habitación en el Seminario de San Patricio en Menlo Park, donde podré quedarme y estar cerca de una biblioteca que puedo usar para estudios académicos. Acercándose al final de mi tiempo sabático, planeo hacer un retiro de treinta días en silencio, los Ejercicios Espirituales de San Ignacio de Loyola. Para el retiro, estaré en una casa de retiro en Dakota del Sur. Durante mi ausencia, el Padre Joseph Sebastian estará a cargo en la parroquia y el Mons. James Murphy, el Padre Maurice O'Brien y el Padre Vincent O'Reilly también estarán ayudando.
