## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

In this Sunday's Gospel, Our Lord says to Saint Peter: "I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." (Mt 16:19) With these words, Jesus gave Peter authority in three different ways. First, he gave Peter the authority to absolve sins. Second, as the head of the Church, Peter, as the first Pope, and every Pope after him, was given the authority to pronounce doctrinal judgements. Third, Jesus gave Peter authority to make disciplinary decisions in the Church. The Catechism of the Catholic Church puts it this way: "The power to 'bind and loose' connotes the authority to absolve sins, to pronounce doctrinal judgments, and to make disciplinary decisions in the Church. Jesus entrusted this authority to the Church through the ministry of the apostles and in particular through the ministry of Peter, the only one to whom he specifically entrusted the keys of the kingdom." (CCC, 553)

While the first authority, to absolve sins, is rather easy to understand, the other two authorities may need a bit of explanation. Regarding the authority to pronounce doctrinal judgments, we understand that this authority is God-given and guided by the Holy Spirit. This authority has been passed on from Peter to every Pope after him. Over the centuries, among other doctrinal proclamations, the Pope has defined clearly, affirmed and solemnly declared the objective truth of the divine and human natures of Christ (*Council of Nicea*, 325), the Blessed Virgin Mary's Perpetual Virginity (Pope Martin I, Lateran Synod, 649), Mary's Immaculate Conception (Pope Pius IX, 1854), the Assumption of Mary body and soul into heaven (Pope Pius XII, 1950), the goodness, beauty and truth of marriage between a man and woman (many times, but one example is: *Casti Connubii*, 1930, Pope Pius XI), the goodness of spouses' collaboration with God in the transmission of human life and the falseness of contraception (most recently: *Humanae Vitae*, Pope Paul VI, 1968) and the ordination of men to the priesthood (most recently: *Ordinatio Sacerdotalis*, Pope John Paul II, 1994).

The Pope makes a doctrinal judgement to clarify a particular belief or to emphasize an important element of our faith. And he does this for the benefit of the faithful so that we do not have any doubt about what the Church teaches. While this is an amazing gift that God gave to the Catholic Church, it is true that some faithful struggle to accept certain doctrines. When one has difficulty grasping a certain doctrine, then one is obliged to study it more, pray about it and try to see why the Church teaches it. To be sure, the teaching is not dismissed simply because one does not like it.

Finally, the third task that Jesus gave to Peter was to make disciplinary actions. Sometimes the Pope, as head of the universal Church or a bishop as head of the local church, has to make disciplinary decisions. If the Holy Father or a bishop must discipline one of his children, it is because he loves that child and he wants to protect all his other children. He does not want the faithful to be led astray or confused about the Church's teaching on a particular matter.

**SAINT MONICA (332-387)**  
**August 27**

She had smiles for the neighbors, though her husband found  
her religion and the charity it inspired annoying. She made tearful  
prayers in private for a son, outwardly self-assured but, as his mother  
knew, inwardly restless, and whose girlfriend of a dozen years had  
borne his child out of wedlock. Though not the first or last such mother  
and son, Monica and Augustine are the Church's most famous, so we  
keep their feast days back to back, with Monica's, fittingly, first. To  
Rome she followed Augustine, then to Milan, where years of prayer—  
and nagging—finally bore fruit in his conversion by Saint Ambrose.  
For six months, mother and son enjoyed the blessing of rediscovering  
each other. Just in time! On the way home to North Africa, Monica  
took sick and died near Rome. No child who has mourned a parent can  
read, unmoved, Augustine's tender account, in his *Confessions*, of  
Monica's last days. At this time of the year, when parents watch  
apprehensively as children leave for school, may Monica's  
perseverance and Augustine's long-prayed-for conversion ease anxiety  
and kindle hope.

# VIGÉSIMO PRIMER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

23 de agosto de 2020

Tú eres el Cristo, el Hijo de Dios vivo (Mateo 16:13-20).



## DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

En el Evangelio de este domingo, Nuestro Señor le dice a San Pedro: "Y a ti te daré las llaves del reino de los cielos; y todo lo que atares en la tierra será atado en los cielos; y todo lo que desatares en la tierra será desatado en los cielos..." (Mt 16:19) Con estas palabras, Jesús le dio autoridad a Pedro de tres maneras diferentes. Primero, le dio a Pedro la autoridad para absolver los pecados. En segundo lugar, como cabeza de la Iglesia, Pedro, como el primer Papa, y cada Papa después de él, se le dio la autoridad para pronunciar juicios doctrinales. Tercero, Jesús le dio a Pedro autoridad para tomar decisiones disciplinarias en la Iglesia. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica lo pone así: "El poder de "atar y desatar" significa la autoridad para absolver los pecados, pronunciar sentencias doctrinales y tomar decisiones disciplinarias en la Iglesia. Jesús confió esta autoridad a la Iglesia por el ministerio de los Apóstoles (cf. Mt 18, 18) y particularmente por el de Pedro, el único a quien Él confió explícitamente las llaves del Reino. (CCC, 553)

Si bien la primera autoridad, para absolver los pecados, es bastante fácil de entender, las otras dos autoridades pueden necesitar un poco de explicación. En cuanto a la autoridad para pronunciar juicios doctrinales, entendemos que esta autoridad es dada por Dios y guiada por el Espíritu Santo. Esta autoridad ha sido pasada de Pedro a todos los Papas después de él. A lo largo de los siglos, entre otras proclamaciones doctrinales, el Papa ha definido claramente, afirmado y declarado solemnemente la verdad objetiva de la naturaleza divina y humana de Cristo (Consejo de Nicea, 325), la Santísima Virginitad Perpetua de la Virgen María (Papa Martín I, Sínodo Laterano, 649), La Inmaculada Concepción de María (Papa Pío IX, 1854), la Asunción de María cuerpo y alma cielo, (1950), la bondad, la belleza y la verdad del matrimonio entre un hombre y una mujer (muchas veces, pero un ejemplo es: Casti Connubii, 1930, Papa Pío XI), la bondad de la colaboración de los cónyuges con Dios en la transmisión de la vida humana y la falsedad de la anticoncepción (más recientemente: Humanae Vitae, Papa Pablo VI, 1968) y la ordenación de los hombres al sacerdocio (más recientemente: Ordinatio Sacerdotalis, Papa Juan Pablo II, 1994).

El Papa hace un juicio doctrinal para aclarar una creencia particular o para enfatizar un elemento importante de nuestra fe. Y lo hace en beneficio de los fieles para que no tengamos ninguna duda sobre lo que la Iglesia enseña. Si bien este es un don increíble que Dios dio a la Iglesia Católica, es cierto que a algunos fieles se les hace difícil aceptar ciertas doctrinas. Cuando uno tiene dificultad para en-

tender cierta doctrina, entonces uno tiene la obligación de estudiarla más, orar al respecto y tratar de ver por qué la Iglesia la enseña. Sin duda, la enseñanza no se debe descartar simplemente porque a uno no le gusta.

Finalmente, la tercera tarea que Jesús le dio a Pedro fue tomar acciones disciplinarias. A veces el Papa, como cabeza de la Iglesia universal o un obispo como cabeza de la iglesia local, tiene que tomar decisiones disciplinarias. Si el Santo Padre o un obispo debe disciplinar a uno de sus hijos, es porque ama a ese hijo y quiere proteger a todos sus otros hijos. No quiere que los fieles se desvíen o se confundan acerca de la enseñanza de la Iglesia sobre un asunto en particular.

## SANTA ROSA DE LIMA (1586-1617) 23 de agosto

Isabel de Flores nació en Lima, Perú; era tan bella, que su madrina dijo que era “bella como una rosa”. Asumió ese mismo nombre al momento de su Confirmación y años después, cuando por fin su familia se convenció de que no aspiraba al matrimonio, adoptó el nombre de Rosa como Religiosa Terciaria Dominicana, viviendo en casa, dedicada a la oración, al trabajo diario y al cuidado de los pobres; tejía hasta altas horas de la noche, además de dedicarse a la jardinería para luego colaborar en la economía familiar. Su vida de oración y penitencia fue intachable y ejemplar, pues no sólo contempló a Dios en la creación, sino que construyó una cabaña en oratorio personal en su jardín. En un cuarto de su casa comenzó un hospital cuidando de los enfermos y de quienes acudían a ella. Como gran santa que fue, su vida se vio marcada por el sacrificio y la angustia espiritual. Murió a los 31 años llegando a ser la primera persona latinoamericana en ser canonizada; posteriormente fue declarada Patrona de América Latina.
