FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners:

Last Sunday, I had a sick call in Winters, so I decided to take the "back way" to Winters on Pleasants Valley Road. As you know, the recent wildfires that have ravaged our state did not spare Vacaville and the homes of St. Mary's parishioners. The boundaries for St. Mary's Parish extend north from Interstate 80 to the Yolo County line and west towards Fairfield. Therefore, the area to the north that burned between Vacaville and Winters and the area that burned to the west is part of St. Mary's Parish. Several of our parishioners lost their homes and belongings in the fire. A number of other parishioners' homes were spared. It was heartbreaking to see the destruction of the fire along Pleasants Valley Road as I drove to Winters last Sunday. I know Pleasants Valley Road know well, as I often ride my bicycle on that road. Since I had planned to bring Holy Communion to the infirm person that I was visiting, I had the Blessed Sacrament with me in my car. It came to my mind that I was participating in a simple kind of Eucharistic Procession as I drove through the burned parts of St. Mary's Parish. As I drove with Our Lord with me, I asked Him to bless all those who were affected by the fire and to help them to heal and to get back on their feet.

To be sure, not only those who lost homes were affected by the fire. Also, those who work in those homes have been affected. Perhaps, they clean the homes, work construction or carry out maintenance and landscaping. We want to pray for them as well and continue to support them. I express my gratitude to our local St. Vincent de Paul Council for all the outreach they have been doing. Likewise, I give thanks to all of you who give your time, energy and resources to St. Mary's Food Locker. Both of these outreaches have been so important during these difficult times of the pandemic and the wildfires.

Regarding outreach and assistance, I am glad to pass on the news that the Solano County Board has approved a Coronavirus related Rental Assistance Program (RAP) to provide cash-assistance to qualifying low-income households impacted by COVID-19. This program will begin on September 21st and is funded by the CARES Act (*Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act*). The RAP will also provide participants with additional resources such as employment assistance, access to mental and behavioral health services and food and nutritional services through the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano and CalFresh. The Solano County Board of Supervisors approved \$4 million in CARES Act funding for the COVID-19 RAP. To qualify for the COVID-19 RAP, applicants must have a head of household over 18 years old, be a Solano County resident as of January 1, 2020, have no income at or below 100 percent of Federal Poverty

Guidelines and can demonstrate financial hardship and/or loss of income due to COVID-19, including a letter from their most recent employer, bank statements and verification of income. Eligible participants may receive up to \$4,000 in one-time rental assistance per household. Catholic Charities of Yolo-Solano will be receiving the applications and facilitating the assistance. Applicants may apply online at www.ccyoso.org or in person at Catholic Charities' offices located at 125 Corporate Place, Suite A, Vallejo beginning on September 21st. All materials will be available in the English, Spanish and Tagalog. The application period will remain open until October 12, 2020 at 5p. To be sure, the RAP is some good news amidst the challenges of the last few months!

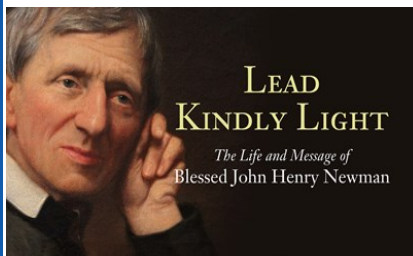

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María:

El domingo pasado, tuve una llamada de un enfermo en Winters, así que decidí irme por caminos alternativos hacia Winters, por Pleasants Valley Road. Como ya saben, los recientes incendios forestales han devastado nuestro estado y Vacaville y las casas de algunos feligreses de Santa María no se salvaron. Los límites de la parroquia de Santa María se extienden hacia el norte desde la Interestatal 80 hasta la línea del Condado de Yolo y hacia el oeste hacia Fairfield. Por lo tanto, la zona al norte que se quemó entre Vacaville y Winters y la zona que ardió al oeste es parte de la Parroquia de Santa María. Varios de nuestros feligreses perdieron sus casas y pertenencias en los incendios. Varias de las casas de otros feligreses se salvaron. Fue doloroso ver la destrucción por el fuego a lo largo de Pleasants Valley Road mientras conducía a Winters el domingo pasado. Conozco bien Pleasants Valley Road, ya que a menudo ando en bicicleta por esa carretera. Como había planeado llevar la Santa Comunión a la persona enferma a quien iba a visitar, llevaba el Santísimo Sacramento conmigo en mi auto. Me vino a la mente que estaba participando en una sencilla procesión eucarística mientras conducía a través de las áreas de la Parroquia de Santa María que fueron quemadas. Mientras conducía y con nuestro Señor conmigo, le pedía que bendijera a todos los que se vieron afectados por los incendios y que los ayudara a sanar y volver a ponerse de pie.

Sin duda, no sólo los que perdieron sus casas se vieron afectados por los incendios. Además, los que trabajan en esos hogares se han visto afectados. Tal vez, limpian esas casas, trabajan en la construcción o llevan a cabo tareas de mantenimiento y jardinería. Queremos orar por ellos también y seguir apoyándolos. Expreso mi gratitud a nuestro Sociedad de San Vicente de Paúl local por toda su ayuda a los afectados. De la misma manera, le doy las gracias a todos ustedes por su tiempo, energía y recursos al Banco de Alimentos de Santa María. Ambos recursos han sido tan importantes durante estos tiempos difíciles de la pandemia y los incendios forestales.

En cuanto a el apoyo y asistencia, me complace pasarles la noticia de que el Consejo del Condado de Solano ha aprobado un Programa de Asistencia de Alquiler (RAP, por sus siglas en inglés) para proveer asistencia en efectivo a los hogares que califican de bajos ingresos, los cuales han sido afectados por COVID-19. Este programa comenzará el 21 de septiembre y está financiado por la Acción CARES (Ayuda por Coronavirus, Asistencia y Seguridad Económica). RAP también proporcionará a los participantes con re-

cursos adicionales como asistencia de empleo, acceso a servicios de salud mental y comportamiento y servicios de alimentación y nutrición a través del Banco de Alimentos de Contra Costa y Solano y CalFresh. El Consejo de Supervisores del Condado de Solano aprobó \$4 millones en fondos de la Acción CARES para el COVID-19 RAP. Para calificar para el COVID-19 RAP, los solicitantes deben tener un jefe de familia mayor de 18 años, ser residente del Condado de Solano a partir del 1 de enero de 2020, no tener ingresos al 100 por ciento o por debajo de las Directrices Federales de Pobreza y que puedan demostrar dificultades financieras y/o pérdida de ingresos debido a COVID-19, incluyendo una carta de su empleador más reciente, estados de cuenta bancarios y verificación de ingresos. Los participantes elegibles pueden recibir hasta \$4,000, una vez solamente, por hogar en asistencia de alquiler. Caridades Católicas de Yolo-Solano recibirá las solicitudes y facilitará la asistencia. Los solicitantes pueden presentar su solicitud por internet en www.ccyoso.org o en persona en las oficinas de Caridades Católicas ubicadas en 125 Corporate Place, Suite A, Vallejo a partir del 21 de septiembre. Todo el material estará disponible en inglés, español y tagalo. El periodo de solicitud permanecerá abierto hasta el 12 de octubre de 2020 a las 5p. ¡Sin duda, RAP es una buena noticia en medio de los desafíos de los últimos meses!
