FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

One of the towering figures of the Christian mystical and contemplative tradition is the extraordinary 16th century Spanish nun from Avila, Spain -- *St. Teresa of Jesus*. Highly gifted "both naturally and supernaturally", her extensive writings covers the remarkable struggle of the Christian endeavor toward union with God. "Her writings", says author Julienne McLean, "reveal a powerful and penetrating honesty and intimacy, a complete integrity, an essential pragmatism and compassion, but above all, a deep humanity that has hardly been surpassed in the whole corpus of Christian mystical literature."

Yet, her walk with Jesus began like it does for many of us. Her attachment to her sins and the allurements of the world acted like anchors chained to her legs, keeping her from advancing in her spiritual life. She struggled to serve "two masters", in the language of this Sunday's Gospel reading. St. Teresa writes:

I was living an extremely burdensome life, because in prayer I understood more clearly my faults. On the one hand God was calling; on the other hand, I was following the world. All the things of God made me happy; those of the world held me bound. It seems I desired to harmonize these two contraries—so inimical to one another.... In prayer I was having great trouble, for my spirit was not proceeding as lord but as slave. And so, I was not able to shut myself within myself (which was my whole manner of procedure in prayer); instead, I shut within myself a thousand vanities.

For nearly twenty years, she struggled in her quagmire of vanity. She was careless with regards to sin, especially indulging in useless gossip with people who visited her in the convent. Her attachment to her venial sins and other worldly pleasures kept Teresa from increasing her desire for God. In many ways she was like the rich man who asked Jesus, "*Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?*" (Luke 18:18) The answer shook the honest and earnest man to the core. He strove to follow God's will by keeping the commandments but failed where it mattered most, namely in his heart. He simply could not give himself completely over to the Lord. "*How hard it is,*" Jesus said, "*for those who have wealth to enter the Kingdom of God!*" The rich man, like St. Teresa, simply could not let go of the world.

In an act of pure gift from God, the future saint was given the grace to detach itself from worldly affairs. If she continued to give Jesus half her heart, she'd be adrift in the abyss of spiritual mediocrity. For that reason, she exhorted her fellow nuns in the convent to uproot all worldly distractions in her book *The Way to Perfection*:

The whole point is that we should give ourselves to Him with complete determination, and we should empty the soul in such a way that He can store things there or take them away as though it were His own property. And since His Majesty has the rights of ownership, let us not oppose Him. And since He doesn't force our will, He takes what we give Him; but He doesn't give Himself completely until we give ourselves completely.

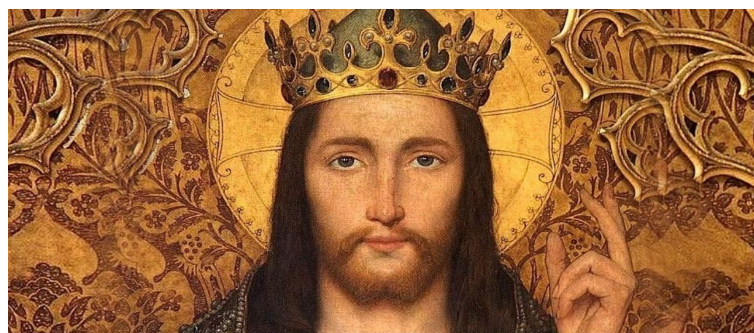

TRIGÉSIMO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

23 de octubre de 2022

El publicano se quedaba atrás, diciendo, “Dios mío, ten piedad de mí que soy un pecador” (Lucas 18:9-14).



DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Una de las figuras destacadas de la tradición mística y contemplativa cristiana es la extraordinaria monja española del siglo XVI de Ávila, España: **Santa Teresa de Jesús**. Altamente dotada “tanto natural como sobrenaturalmente”, sus extensos escritos cubren la notable lucha del esfuerzo cristiano hacia la unión con Dios. “Sus escritos”, dice la autora Julienne McLean, “revelan una honestidad e intimidad poderosa y penetrante, una integridad completa, un pragmatismo y una compasión esenciales, pero, sobre todo, una humanidad profunda que apenas ha sido superada en todo el corpus de la literatura mística cristiana.”

Sin embargo, su caminar con Jesús comenzó como lo hace para muchos de nosotros. Su apego a sus pecados y a las tentaciones del mundo actuaron como anclas encadenadas a sus piernas, impidiéndole avanzar en su vida espiritual. Luchó para servir a “dos amos”, como lo dice el lenguaje del Evangelio de este domingo. Santa Teresa escribe:

Llevaba una vida sumamente pesada, porque en la oración comprendía más claramente mis faltas. Por un lado, Dios estaba llamando; por otro lado, yo estaba siguiendo el mundo. Todas las cosas de Dios me hacían feliz; las cosas del mundo me tenían atada. Parece que deseaba armonizar estos dos contrarios, tan enemigos entre sí... En la oración tenía grandes problemas, porque mi espíritu no proseguía como amo, sino como esclavo. Y así no podía enfocarme en mí misma (que era toda forma de proceder en la oración); en cambio, me enfocaba en mi interior, mil vanidades.

Durante casi veinte años, luchó en su atolladero de vanidad. Era descuidada con respecto al pecado, especialmente se entregaba a chismes con las personas que la visitaban en el convento. Su apego a sus pecados veniales y otros placeres mundanos impedían que para Teresa aumentara su deseo de Dios. En muchos sentidos, ella era como el hombre rico que le preguntó a Jesús: “Maestro bueno, ¿qué haré para heredar la vida eterna?” (Lucas 18:18). La respuesta sacudió hasta la médula al hombre honesto y sincero. Se esforzó por seguir la voluntad de Dios guardando los mandamientos, pero fracasó donde más importaba, es decir, en su corazón. Simplemente no podía entregarse completamente al Señor. “¡Qué difícil es”, dijo Jesús, “para los que tienen riquezas entrar en el Reino de Dios!” El hombre rico, como Santa Teresa, simplemente no podía dejar el mundo.

En un acto puro del don de Dios, a la futura santa se le concedió la gracia de desligarse de los asuntos mundanos. Si continuaba dándole a Jesús la mitad de su corazón, estaría a deriva del abismo de la mediocridad espiritual. Por esa razón, exhortó a sus compañeras monjas en el convento a desarraigar todas las distracciones mundanas en su libro *El Camino a la Perfección*:

El punto es que debemos entregarnos a Él con toda determinación, y debemos vaciar el alma de tal manera que Él pueda almacenar cosas allí o quitarlas como si fueran de Su propiedad. Y como Su Majestad tiene los derechos de propiedad, no nos opongamos. Y como no fuerza nuestra voluntad, toma lo que le damos; pero Él no se da completamente hasta que nosotros nos damos completamente.

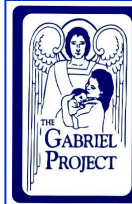
