# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

There is a phrase heard at every Mass that should be familiar to us all. We hear the priest say it shortly before we receive Holy Communion. Before he says it, the priest is instructed to kneel as a sign of reverence, he pauses in silent adoration, and then slowly stands upright. With one hand holding the golden chalice, and the other, delicately lifting up the consecrated Body of Christ, the priest holds up the most treasured, holiest, and sacred part of the Catholic faith. Many of our ancestors went to their deaths because of this teaching, in fact many still do around the world (Christianity is the most persecuted religion on earth but I will save that topic for another day). As the priest lifts the Precious Body and Blood of our Lord before the eyes of all gathered in the church, he proclaims, **"Behold, the Lamb of God!"** This phrase we hear at every Mass is dense with profundity and meaning. It's the theological version of a galactical neutron star. Luckily, the Gospel reading this Sunday allows us to scratch the surface of this phrase.

It begins immediately with John the Baptist with two of his disciples. It's important to recall here the mission of John. As the Gospel of Matthew tells us in chapter 3:1-12, John preached, *"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near.... People went out to him from Jerusalem and all Judea and the whole region of the Jordan. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River.... I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me comes one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry."* His role was to bring people to confess their sins. If they did, they would be ready to receive the one who would come after him. We all know who that would be. It is Jesus Christ himself. Even though John got the people to confess their sins, he knew he could never take away the guilt of these sins. Divine justice demands hell for our transgressions.

John understood this, as the son of a Jewish priest in the Temple in Jerusalem. He would have been familiar with the intricate religious rituals performed there, where Jews would come from all over the Roman Empire and bring animals to be killed. Around the clock, day and night, animals would be brought to the altar in front of the Temple, which represented the guilt of their sins. Then the priest would slaughter the animal as a sign of their sins being forgiven. To our modern ears, this is absolutely abhorrent and alien. In the ancient world, this was commonplace. Animals were offered up as a sacrifice in a religious act. But all of this was merely symbolic. How can sacrificing an animal truly take away the punishment that is due to me? It cannot! This is where the beauty and scandal of Christianity now shines forth. Jesus Christ is the true "Lamb of God", whose blood will be shed on the cross. Precisely because Jesus is true God and true man, only he can pay the price for our sins through his death. The centuries of animal sacrifices

have all been leading to this pivotal event. John the Baptist is the first to understand this, when he sees Jesus walking by and yells, **"Behold, the Lamb of God!"**

# SEGUNDO DOMINGO ORDINARIO

## 14 de enero de 2024

### DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Hay una frase que se escucha en cada Misa que debería ser familiar para todos nosotros. Oímos al sacerdote decirlo poco antes de que recibamos la Sagrada Comunión. Antes de decirlo, el sacerdote es instruido que se arrodille en señal de reverencia, hace una pausa en adoración silenciosa y luego se pone de pie lentamente. Con una mano sosteniendo el cáliz dorado y la otra, levantando delicadamente el Cuerpo consagrado de Cristo, el sacerdote sostiene lo máspreciado, santo y sagrado de la fe católica. Muchos de nuestros antepasados murieron a causa de esta enseñanza, de hecho, muchos todavía lo hacen alrededor del mundo (el cristianismo es la religión más perseguida en la tierra, pero dejaré ese tema para otro día). Mientras el sacerdote levanta el Precioso Cuerpo y la Sangre de nuestro Señor ante los ojos de todos los reunidos en la iglesia, proclama: "**¡He aquí el Cordero de Dios!**" Esta frase que escuchamos en cada Misa está llena de profundidad y significado. Es la versión teológica de una estrella de neutrones galáctica. Por suerte, la lectura del Evangelio de este domingo nos permite tocar la superficie de esta frase.

Comienza inmediatamente con Juan el Bautista con dos de sus discípulos. Es importante recordar aquí la misión de Juan. Como nos dice el Evangelio de Mateo en el capítulo 3:1-12, Juan predicó: "*Conviértanse, porque el reino de los cielos está cerca...la gente de Jerusalén, de toda la Judea y de toda la región del Jordán iba a su encuentro, y se hacía bautizar por él en las aguas del Jordán, confesando sus pecados...yo los bautizo con agua para que se conviertan. Pero aquel que viene de tras de mí es más poderoso que yo, y yo ni siquiera soy digno de quitarle las sandalias*". Su rol era llevar a la gente a confesar sus pecados. Si lo hacían, estarían listos para recibir al que vendría después de él. Todos sabemos quién sería. Es el mismo Jesucristo. A pesar de que Juan hizo que la gente confesara sus pecados, él sabía que nunca podría quitar la culpa de estos pecados. La justicia divina exige el infierno por nuestras transgresiones.

Juan entendió esto, como el hijo de un sacerdote judío en el Templo de Jerusalén. Habría estado familiarizado con los intrincados rituales religiosos que se realizaban allí, donde los judíos venían de todo el Imperio Romano y traían animales para ser sacrificados. Durante las veinticuatro horas del día, día y noche, los animales eran llevados al altar frente al Templo, lo que representaba la culpa de sus pecados. Entonces el sacerdote sacrificaba al animal como señal de que sus pecados habían sido perdonados. Para nuestros oídos modernos, esto es absolutamente aborrecible y ajeno. En el mundo antiguo, esto era co-

mún. Los animales eran ofrecidos como sacrificio en un acto religioso. Pero todo esto era meramente simbólico. ¿Cómo puede el sacrificio de un animal realmente quitarme el castigo que me corresponde? ¡No puede! Aquí es donde ahora brilla la belleza y el escándalo del cristianismo. Jesucristo es el verdadero "Cordero de Dios", cuya sangre será derramada en la cruz. Precisamente porque Jesús es verdadero Dios y verdadero hombre, solo él puede pagar el precio de nuestros pecados a través de su muerte. Los siglos de sacrificios de animales han conducido a este evento fundamental. Juan el Bautista es el primero en entender esto, cuando ve a Jesús caminando y grita: "**¡He aquí el Cordero de Dios!**"

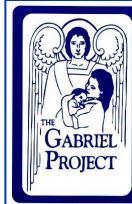
