FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

The front photo on the bulletin this Sunday was taken in the summer of 2008 during a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. I had just finished my third year in the seminary when the school offered to take a group of us to see the very places where Jesus walked and lived. Oftentimes, when we read the stories in the bible the places they name can seem utterly foreign and mysterious to us, especially with names like "Zubulan and Naphtali." They don't seem real. The moment we landed everything changed. The Bible came alive! As we hear in the Gospel today, it said that Jesus left his small little town of Nazareth in the hill country to live by the Sea of Galilee. What does it look like, we can wonder? Surprisingly, the Sea of Galilee reminded me a lot of Lake Tahoe, without all the trees, million-dollar mansions, and tourists. It seemed to stretch as far as the eye could see. What hit me the most was how quiet and still it was. As I stood there with the other seminarians, we must have all thought the same thing – this is the place where Jesus called the first priests. The Gospel tells us how it happened: **"Simon who is called Peter, and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea...He walked along from there and saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee and his brother John."** (Cf. Matthew 4:8-12). As future priests, 2,000 years later, the power of the moment was not lost on us. This was where it all began. We are continuing the same mission of Fr. Peter, Fr. Andrew, Fr. James, and Fr. John.

It's not by accident that Jesus begins here by the sea. For the first century Jewish person hearing that Jesus began to call his disciples in that land of "Zebulun and Naphtali", their hearts would have been pierced. Zebulun and Naphtali were the first two tribes of the northern Kingdom of Israel that were destroyed by the Assyrian Empire, 700 hundred years before. They were lost and never heard from again. Imagine if you had a family member that was kidnapped or killed, that's the emotion Jesus is invoking by beginning here. Yet despite this, there is joy and happiness here. That same first century hearer of Jesus would have also recognized the prophecy in the Book of Ezekiel is finally coming to fulfillment: **"Behold, I, I myself will search for my sheep, and will seek them out. As a shepherd seeks out his flock when some of his sheep have been scattered abroad, so will I seek out my sheep; and I will rescue them from all places where they have been scattered on a day of clouds and thick darkness. And I will bring them out from the peoples, and gather them from the countries"** (Cf. Ezekiel 34:11-13).

God never forgets us! Hear that again, God never forgot about the lost tribes of Israel, even though they were unfaithful to him. God never forgets us, even when we do horrible things and fall into sin over and over again. He is always waiting to forgive us. God never forgets us even in our darkest moments. Jesus begins his mission precisely here by the sea to announce to the world that God has come

in the flesh to bring his family back home. Peter, Andrew, James and John will now join his mission and become "fishers of men."

TERCER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

La foto de portada del boletín de este domingo fue tomada en el verano de 2008 durante una peregrinación a Tierra Santa. Acababa de terminar mi tercer año en el seminario cuando la escuela se ofreció a llevarnos a un grupo a ver los lugares precisos donde Jesús caminó y vivió. A menudo, cuando leemos las historias de la Biblia, los lugares que se mencionan pueden parecernos completamente extraños y misteriosos, especialmente con nombres como “Zubulan y Nephtali”. No parecen reales. En el momento en que aterrizamos todo cambió. ¡La Biblia cobró vida! Como escuchamos en el Evangelio de hoy, dice que Jesús dejó su pequeño pueblo de Nazaret en la región montañosa para vivir junto al Mar de Galilea. ¿Cómo se mira, podemos preguntarnos? Sorprendentemente, el mar de Galilea me recordó mucho a Lake Tahoe, sin todos los árboles, las mansiones de millones de dólares y los turistas. Parecía extenderse hasta donde alcanzaba la vista. Lo que más me impactó fue lo tranquilo y silencioso que era. Mientras estaba allí parado con los otros seminaristas, todos debimos estar pensando lo mismo - este es el lugar donde Jesús llamó a los primeros sacerdotes. El Evangelio nos cuenta cómo sucedió: *“Simón, llamado Pedro, y su hermano Andrés. Estaban lanzando la red para pescar en el lago, pues eran pescadores. ... Yendo más adelante, vio a otros dos hermanos: Santiago y Juan, hijos de Zebedeo.”* (Cf. Mateo 4,18-22). Como futuros sacerdotes, 2000 años después, el poder de ese momento no se nos escapó. Aquí fue donde todo comenzó. Continuamos la misma misión del Padre Pedro, Padre Andrés, Padre Santiago, y el Padre Juan.

No es casualidad que Jesús comience aquí junto al mar. Para el judío del primer siglo al escuchar que Jesús comenzó a llamar a sus discípulos en aquella tierra de “Zabulón y Neftalí”, su corazón habría sido traspasado. Zabulón y Neftalí fueron las dos primeras tribus del norte del Reino de Israel que fueron destruidas por el Imperio Asirio, 700 años antes. Se perdieron y nunca más se supo de ellos. Imagínese si tuviera un familiar que haiga sido secuestrado o asesinado, esa es la emoción que Jesús está invocando al comenzar aquí. Sin embargo, a pesar de esto, hay alegría y felicidad aquí. Ese mismo oyente de Jesús del primer siglo también habría reconocido que la profecía en el Libro de Ezequiel finalmente se está cumpliendo: *“He aquí yo, yo mismo iré a buscar mis ovejas, y las reconoceré. Como reconoce su rebaño el pastor el día que está en medio de sus ovejas esparcidas, así reconoceré mis ovejas, y las libraré de todos los lugares en que fueron esparcidas el día del nublado y de la oscuridad”* (Cf. Ezequiel 34,11-13).

¡Dios nunca nos olvida! Escuche eso nuevamente, Dios nunca se olvidó de las tribus perdidas de Israel, a pesar de que le fueron infieles. Dios nunca nos olvida, a pesar de que hacemos cosas horribles y caemos en pecado una y otra vez. Él siempre está esperando para perdonarnos. Dios nunca nos olvida ni en nuestros momentos más oscuros. Jesús comienza su misión precisamente aquí, junto al mar, para anunciar al mundo que Dios se ha hecho carne para traer de vuelta a casa a su familia. Pedro, Andrés, Santiago y Juan ahora se unirán a su misión y se convertirán en “pescadores de hombres”.
