# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

The next time you are in a Catholic church, pay attention to where the altar is built. No matter what church you walk into, whether you're in the jungle of Sao Paulo, Brazil, a Gothic cathedral in Paris, or a suburban parish in rural Dixon, you'll soon notice a familiar pattern. The altar is always built on a raised platform. The only way to get to it is by climbing stairs. Even if it's only one step or an entire flight, like the Basilica of St. Peter's in Vatican City, you always have to ascend upwards. Why?

The answer is found in the gospel reading this Sunday. It's the famous story of Jesus preaching what is known as the Beatitudes. The Beatitudes fulfill God's promises made to Abraham in the Book of Genesis and his descendants and describe the rewards that will be ours as loyal followers of Christ. In other words, the Beatitudes are the moral, internal, attitude that the Christian is called to live by. It's how God wants us to behave. The beginning of the reading begins nonchalantly to us as modern hearers. It says, "When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the *mountain*, and after he had sat down, his disciples came to him. He began to teach them." (Cf. Matthew 5:1). That little detail where Jesus taught the Beatitudes – on the mountain – would stun the first century Jewish audience. Mountains in the bible are always places of encounter with God. It's where humanity comes in contact with his true presence.

Think back to Moses in the Book of Exodus. Where does God give him the Ten Commandments? Chapter 19 tells us: "In the third month after the people of Israel left Egypt, they came to the Sinai Desert on the same day. They had left Rephidim and had come to the Sinai Desert. There Israel set up their tents in front of the *mountain*. And Moses went up to God." (Cf. Exodus 19:1-3) From that high vantage point, God gives humanity the moral code that would undergird Western Civilization. Not only that, on that very mountain God finally reveals his true name which biblical scholars dramatically call the Tetragrammaton. Moses asks God what is his name. He responds, "God said to Moses, 'I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I AM has sent me to you.'" (Cf. Exodus 3:14) We Christians translate this as YHWH or Yahweh.

Mountains are where we see God, or rather, it's where God comes down to meet us. As Catholics, there is no more sacred act than what happens at each Mass. The sacrifice of Jesus Christ is made present. Upon each altar, Jesus Christ comes down each time with the words of consecration through the hands of his priests, "TAKE THIS ALL OF YOU AND EAT OF IT. FOR THIS IS MY BODY, WHICH WILL BE GIVEN UP FOR YOU." Then the priest takes the chalice, "TAKE THIS ALL OF YOU AND DRINK FROM IT: THIS IS THE CUP OF MY BLOOD, THE BLOOD OF THE NEW AND EVERLASTING COVENANT. IT WILL BE SHED FOR YOU AND FOR MANY FOR THE FORGIVENESS OF

SINS. DO THIS IN MEMORY OF ME." Once those words are uttered, Christ becomes present in the Holy Eucharist. Now do you see why the altar can only be accessed with stairs? It's supposed to be a mini-mountain where God meets humanity again.

# CUARTO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

29 de enero de 2023

## DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

La siguiente vez que esté en una iglesia católica, preste atención en dónde está construido el altar. No importa a qué iglesia entre, ya sea que esté en la jungla de Sao Paulo, Brasil, una catedral gótica en París o una parroquia de suburbio como la zona rural de Dixon, pronto notarás un patrón familiar. El altar siempre está construido sobre una plataforma elevada. La única forma de llegar es subiendo escalones. Aunque solo sea un escalón o una escalera completa, como la Basílica de San Pedro en la Ciudad del Vaticano, siempre hay que ascender hacia arriba. ¿Por qué?

La respuesta se encuentra en la lectura del evangelio de este domingo. Es la famosa historia de Jesús predicando lo que se conocen como las Bienaventuranzas. Las Bienaventuranzas cumplen las promesas que Dios le hizo a Abraham en el Libro del Génesis y sus descendientes y describen las recompensas que serán nuestras como fieles seguidores de Cristo. En otras palabras, las Bienaventuranzas son la actitud moral, interna, por las que el cristiano está llamado a usar como guía en su vida. Así es como Dios quiere que nos comportemos. El comienzo de la lectura comienza con indiferencia para nosotros como oyentes modernos. Dice: *“cuando Jesús vio a la muchedumbre, subió al monte y se sentó. Entonces se le acercaron sus discípulos. Enseguida comenzó a enseñarles:”* (Cf. Mateo 5:1). Ese pequeño detalle donde Jesús enseñó las Bienaventuranzas, en el **monte**, asombraría a la audiencia judía del primer siglo. Los montes en la biblia son siempre lugares de encuentro con Dios. Es donde la humanidad entra en contacto con su verdadera presencia.

Piense en Moisés en el Libro del Éxodo. ¿Dónde le da Dios los Diez Mandamientos? El capítulo 19 nos dice: *“En el mes tercero de la salida de los hijos de Israel de la tierra de Egipto, en el mismo día llegaron al desierto de Sináí. Habían salido de Refidim, y llegaron al desierto de Sináí, y acamparon en el desierto; y acampó allí Israel delante del monte. Y Moisés subió a Dios.”* (Cf. Éxodo 19:1-3) Desde ese alto punto de vista, Dios le da a la humanidad el código moral que sustentaría la Civilización Occidental. No solo eso, en ese mismo monte Dios finalmente revela su verdadero nombre que los eruditos bíblicos llaman dramáticamente el Tetragrámaton. Moisés le pregunta a Dios cuál es su nombre. Él responde: *“Y respondió Dios a Moisés: YO SOY EL QUE SOY. Y dijo: Así dirás a los hijos de Israel: YO SOY me envió a vosotros.”* (Cf. Éxodo 3:14). Los cristianos lo traducimos como YHWH o Yahweh.

Los montes son donde vemos a Dios, o más bien, es donde Dios baja a nuestro encuentro. Como católicos, no hay acto más sagrado que lo que sucede en cada Misa.

El sacrificio de Jesucristo se hace presente. Sobre cada altar, Jesucristo desciende cada vez con las palabras de la consagración a través de las manos de sus sacerdotes: *“TOMAD Y COMED TODOS DE EL, PORQUE ESTO ES MI CUERPO, QUE SERA ENTRAGADO POR VOSOTROS.”* Entonces el sacerdote toma el cáliz, *“TOMAD Y BEBED TODOS DE EL, PORQUE ESTE ES EL CALIZ DE MI SANGRE, SANGRE DE LA ALIANZA NUEVA Y ETERNA, QUE SERA DERRAMADA POR VOSOTROS Y POR TODOS LOS HOMBRES PARA EL PERDON DE LOS PECADOS. HACED ESTO EN CONMEMORACION MIA.”* Una vez pronunciadas esas palabras, Cristo se hace presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía. ¿Ahora ves por qué solo se puede acceder al altar con escalones? Se supone que es mini monte donde Dios se encuentra nuevamente con la humanidad.
