FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

I didn't know what to expect when we planned the Parish Family Picnic. It would be our first big gathering since the pandemic shut everything down. Many questions swirled in my mind as your newly arrived pastor. How would the people respond? Would anyone show up? Would it rain? Would it be too hot? It's going to be a big dud! All these doubts crept through my imagination. When I drove up to Andrews Park, I was shocked. I could barely find any parking. Smoke from the grill heroically manned by our Knights Columbus covered the sky. The whiff of hot dogs and burgers permeated the air—it smelled like the American Dream! By the time we started the Holy Mass there were nearly a whopping 700 people in attendance. As I stood on the stage where the makeshift altar was set-up, I had a beautiful vantage point. It was a sea of people decked out in blue hats with "St. Mary's" in gold letters on front that we passed out as gifts to the parish. My heart exploded with joy. I thought to myself, "These are my brothers and sisters in Christ."

To be a faithful Christian is not easy in our day and age. The next time you're at work, look around you. How many followers of Jesus Christ are there in the room with you? Most likely than not, you are in the minority. The culture tolerates a "Christian lite" form of lived faith. If you proclaim you hold the age-old Church teachings of the dignity of human life from conception to natural death or the traditional view of sexual morality you are deemed an old fashioned, rigid religious zealot. Or worst of all, you are called a bigot. It's almost easier to go along with the culture and not fight for Christ and his Church. After all, we may win more friends that way. I get it, no one wants to be a social leper. We all desire to be loved and accepted. "Is any of this worth it?" I asked in my homily last week during the Sunday Masses. Is it worth giving our lives to Christ in the face of the turmoil that it can cause? To be a Christian will demand everything from us. Jesus asks us to change our lives to conform to his laws and teachings. The first words of Jesus ever recorded in the Bible is "metanoia", which means "repent". He tells us to utterly change the direction of our lives from sin and selfishness, if we want to be worthy of him. This my friends, this change of which Jesus speaks, will always be painful because it requires me to kill my ego.

To live the teachings of Jesus can sometimes make us feel alone. This is one of the main reasons why I wanted to do a Parish Family Picnic. I wanted everyone to see that although we may be a minority, we are not alone. We have one another, we have the saints in Heaven, and most importantly, we have God. St. Paul, the author of the Second Reading that we heard at Mass today understood this reality better than most. He writes:

Remember Jesus Christ, raised from the dead... for

which I am suffering, even to the point of chains, like a criminal. But the word of God is not chained. Therefore, I bear with everything for the sake of those who are chosen, so that they too may obtain the salvation that is in Christ Jesus, together with eternal glory. This saying is trustworthy: If we have died with him we shall also live with him; if we persevere we shall also reign with him. But if we deny him he will deny us. If we are unfaithful he remains faithful...

If we asked St. Paul, is being a faithful Christian worth it? What do you think he would say?

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

No sabía qué esperar cuando comenzamos a planear el Día de Campo de Familia Parroquial. Sería nuestra primera gran reunión desde que se cerró todo por la pandemia. Muchas preguntas daban vueltas en mi mente como su párroco recién llegado. ¿Cómo respondería la gente? ¿Si asistiría alguien? ¿llovería? ¿Estaría demasiado caliente? ¡Va a ser un gran fracaso! Todas estas dudas pasaban por mi imaginación. Cuando llegué al Parque Andrews, me sorprendí. Apenas pude encontrar estacionamiento. El humo de la parrilla atendida heroicamente por nuestros Caballeros de Colón cubría el cielo. El olor de hot dogs y hamburguesas impregnaba el aire, ¡olía como el Sueño Americano! Cuando comenzamos la Santa Misa, asistieron casi 700 personas. Mientras estaba de pie en el escenario donde se instaló el altar improvisado, tenía un hermoso punto de vista. Era un mar de personas con cachuchas azules con "St. Mary's" en letras doradas bordadas, las cuales repartimos como regalos a la parroquia. Mi corazón explotó de alegría. Pensé entre mi: "Estos son mis hermanos y hermanas en Cristo".

Ser un cristiano fiel no es fácil en nuestra época. La próxima vez que estés en el trabajo, mira a tu alrededor. ¿Cuántos seguidores de Jesucristo hay en el cuarto contigo? Lo más probable es que estés en la minoría. La cultura tolera una forma de fe vivida "cristiana ligera". Si proclamas que sostienes las antiguas enseñanzas de la Iglesia sobre la dignidad de la vida humana desde la concepción hasta la muerte natural o la visión tradicional de la moralidad sexual, se te considera un fanático religioso rígido y anticuado. O lo peor de todo, te llaman intolerante. Es casi más fácil estar de acuerdo con la cultura y no luchar por Cristo y su Iglesia. Después de todo, podemos ganar más amigos de esa manera. Lo entiendo, nadie quiere ser un leproso social. Todos deseamos ser amados y aceptados. "¿Algo de esto vale la pena?" Pregunté en mi homilía la semana pasada durante las Misas dominicales. ¿Vale la pena entregar nuestra vida a Cristo frente a la tormenta que puede causar? Ser cristiano demandará todo de nosotros. Jesús nos pide que cambiemos nuestra vida para ajustarnos a sus leyes y enseñanzas. Las primeras palabras de Jesús registradas en la Biblia son "metanoia", que significa "arrepentirse". Él nos dice que cambiemos por completo la dirección de nuestras vidas de pecado y egoísmo, si queremos ser dignos de él. Esto mis amigos, este cambio del que habla Jesús, siempre será doloroso porque requiere que yo mate mi ego.

Vivir las enseñanzas de Jesús a veces puede hacernos sentir solos. Esta es una de las principales razones por las que quería tener un evento de familia parroquial. Yo quería que todos vieran que, aunque seamos una minoría, no estamos solos. Nos tenemos unos a otros, tenemos a los santos en el cielo y, lo más importante, tenemos a Dios. San Pablo, el autor de la Segunda Lectura que escuchamos en la Misa de hoy entendió esta realidad mejor que la mayoría. El escribe:

Recuerda siempre que Jesucristo, descendiente de David, resucitó de entre los muertos... Por este Evangelio sufro hasta llevar cadenas, como un malhechor; pero la palabra de Dios no está encadenada. Por eso lo sobrellevo todo por amor a los elegidos, para que ellos también alcancen en Cristo Jesús la salvación, y con ella, la gloria eterna. Es verdad lo que decimos: "Si morimos con él, viviremos con él; si nos mantenemos firmes, reinaremos con él; si lo negamos, él también nos negará; si le somos infieles, él permanece fiel, porque no puede contradecirse a sí mismo".

Si le preguntáramos a San Pablo, ¿vale la pena ser un cristiano fiel? ¿Qué cree que el diría?
