# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Last Saturday, our parish had the great honor of hosting the Confirmation of nearly 80 adults and their families from different parishes throughout the Diocese of Sacramento. St. Mary's was packed; standing room only. We probably had close to 700 people in attendance. Our very own Bishop of Sacramento, Most Reverend Jaime Soto, presiding over the Holy Mass. In the middle of Mass, he extended his hands over these 80 adults, he prayed:

*"All powerful God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, by water and the Holy Spirit you freed your sons and daughters from sin and gave them new life. Send your Holy Spirit upon them to be their helper and guide. Give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of right judgment and courage, the spirit of knowledge and reverence. Fill them with the spirit of wonder and awe in your presence. We ask this through Christ our Lord."*

He called forth the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit they will soon all receive. Out of these gifts, there is one in particular that is especially important in our modern day and age. It is the gift of **courage**. In some translations, we also call this gift "fortitude." A person with fortitude, is given the supernatural ability to stand up for God, even if it means enduring rejection, physical and emotional harm, and yes, even sometimes death, all in the name of Jesus Christ. Fortitude is the strength to be Catholic when our faith is challenged. This can mean standing against our culture with its confusing and loose morals.

Fortitude is the gift at the heart of the Gospel passage in this Sunday's readings. Fortitude is what separates the five wise virgins from the five foolish ones. We must ask ourselves, which ones are we? These ten virgins represent the Christian people. The foolish ones are the Christians who become distracted with the world and all its superficial allurements. They have stopped praying, stopped coming to Sunday Mass, and no longer practice Christian charity. They no longer live the life of a disciple. In other words, they have become bored with Jesus. To be wise, on the other hand, is to live the fire of the Christian life, fully alive. To do this well, we need all of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. That is why it is extremely important that we receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. If you haven't been confirmed yet, especially as an adult, contact the parish office and we'll get you on the right path to receive these awesome gifts of God.

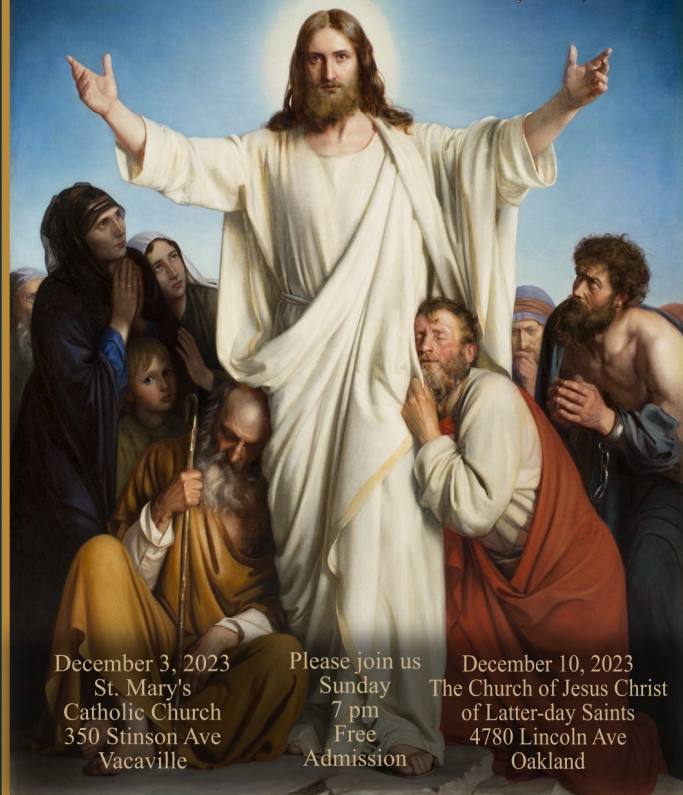

# TRIGESIMO SEGUNDO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

## 12 de noviembre de 2023



### DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

El sábado pasado, nuestra parroquia tuvo el gran honor de ser los anfitriones para la Confirmación de casi 80 adultos y sus familias de diferentes parroquias de la Diócesis de Sacramento. Santa María estaba abarrotada; el espacio estaba para que la gente estuviera de pie únicamente. Probablemente asistieron cerca de 700 personas. Nuestro propio Obispo de Sacramento, el Reverendo Jaime Soto, presidiendo la Santa Misa. En medio de la Misa, extendió sus manos sobre estos 80 adultos, oró:

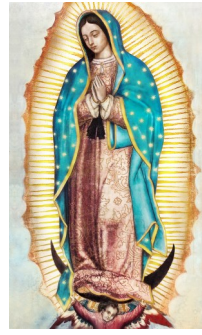
*“Dios todopoderoso, Padre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, por el agua y el Espíritu Santo liberaste del pecado a tus hijos e hijas y les diste vida nueva. Envía tu Espíritu Santo sobre ellos para que sea su ayuda y guía. Dale el espíritu de sabiduría e inteligencia, el espíritu de consejo, el espíritu de fortaleza. Llénalos con el espíritu de ciencia, piedad y temor de Dios. Te lo pedimos por Cristo nuestro Señor”.*

Invocó los Siete Dones del Espíritu Santo que pronto todos recibirán. De estos dones, hay uno en particular que es especialmente importante en nuestra época moderna. Es el don de fortaleza. Una persona con fortaleza se le da la habilidad sobrenatural de defender a Dios, incluso si eso significa soportar el rechazo, el daño físico y emocional y sí, a veces incluso la muerte, todo en el nombre de Jesucristo. La fortaleza es la fuerza para ser católico cuando nuestra fe es desafiada. Esto puede significar oponerse a nuestra cultura con su moral confusa y liberal.

La fortaleza es el don que está en el centro del pasaje del Evangelio en las lecturas de este domingo. La fortaleza es lo que separa a las cinco vírgenes prudentes de las cinco insensatas. Debemos preguntarnos ¿cuáles somos nosotros? Estas diez vírgenes representan al pueblo cristiano. Las insensatas son los cristianos que se distraen con el mundo y todas sus distracciones superficiales. Han dejado de orar, han dejado de asistir a la Misa dominical y ya no practican la caridad cristiana. Ya no viven la vida de un discípulo. En otras palabras, se han aburrido de Jesús. Ser sabio, en cambio, es vivir plenamente el fuego vivo de la vida cristiana, completamente vivo. Para hacer esto bien, necesitamos todos los dones del Espíritu Santo. Por eso es sumamente importante que recibamos el Sacramento de la Confirmación. Si aún no ha sido confirmado, especialmente como adulto, comuníquese con la oficina parroquial y lo guiaremos por el camino correcto para recibir estos maravillosos dones de Dios.
