FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

During this "Year of St. Joseph," I would like to share with an excerpt from St. Pope John Paul II's Apostolic Exhortation of 1989, "Guardian of the Redeemer" (*Redemptoris Custos*). May you have a blessed week.

In Paragraph 8, Pope John Paul II writes:

St. Joseph was called by God to serve the person and mission of Jesus directly through the exercise of his fatherhood. It is precisely in this way that, as the Church's Liturgy teaches, he "cooperated in the fullness of time in the great mystery of salvation" and is truly a "minister of salvation." (Cf. St. John Chrysostom, In Matth. Hom. V, 3: PG 57, 57f.) His fatherhood is expressed concretely "in his having made his life a service, a sacrifice to the mystery of the Incarnation and to the redemptive mission connected with it; in having used the legal authority which was his over the Holy Family in order to make a total gift of self, of his life and work; in having turned his human vocation to domestic love into a superhuman oblation of self, an oblation of his heart and all his abilities into love placed at the service of the Messiah growing up in his house." (Paul VI, Discourse (March 19, 1966): *Insegnamenti*, IV (1966), p. 110.)

In recalling that "the beginnings of our redemption" were entrusted "to the faithful care of Joseph," (Cf. Roman Missal, Collect for the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary.) The Liturgy specifies that "God placed him at the head of his family, as a faithful and prudent servant, so that with fatherly care he might watch over his only begotten Son." (Cf. ibid., Preface for the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary.) Leo XIII emphasized the sublime nature of this mission: "He among all stands out in his august dignity, since by divine disposition he was guardian, and according to human opinion, father of God's Son. Whence it followed that the Word of God was subjected to Joseph, he obeyed him and rendered to him that honor and reverence that children owe to their father." (Leo XIII, Encyclical Epistle *Quamquam pluries* (August 15, 1889): loc. cit., p. 178.)

Since it is inconceivable that such a sublime task would not be matched by the necessary qualities to adequately fulfill it, we must recognize that Joseph

showed Jesus "by a special gift from heaven, all the natural love, all the affectionate solicitude that a father's heart can know." (Pius XII, Radio Message to Catholic School Students in the United States of America (February 19, 1958): AAS 50 (1958), p.174.)

Besides fatherly authority over Jesus, God also gave Joseph a share in the corresponding love, the love that has its origin in the Father "from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named" (Eph 3:15).

The Gospels clearly describe the fatherly responsibility of Joseph toward Jesus. For salvation -which comes through the humanity of Jesus-is realized in actions which are an everyday part of family life, in keeping with that "condescension" which is inherent in the economy of the Incarnation. The gospel writers carefully show how in the life of Jesus nothing was left to chance, but how everything took place according to God's predetermined plan. The oft-repeated formula, "This happened, so that there might be fulfilled...", in reference to a particular event in the Old Testament serves to emphasize the unity and continuity of the plan which is fulfilled in Christ. With the Incarnation, the "promises" and "figures" of the Old Testament become "reality": places, persons, events and rites interrelate according to precise divine commands communicated by angels and received by creatures who are particularly sensitive to the voice of God. Mary is the Lord's humble servant, prepared from eternity for the task of being the Mother of God. Joseph is the one whom God chose to be the "overseer of the Lord's birth," (Origen, Hom. XIII in Lucam, 7: S. Ch. 87, pp 214f.) the one who has the responsibility to look after the Son of God's "ordained" entry into the world, in accordance with divine dispositions and human laws. All of the so-called "private" or "hidden" life of Jesus is entrusted to Joseph's guardianship.



DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Durante este "Año de San José", me gustaría compartir con un extracto de la [Exhortación Apostólica de San Juan Pablo II de 1989, "Guardián del Redentor"](#) (Redemptoris Custos). Que tengan una semana bendita.

En el Parrafo 8, el Papa Juan Pablo II escribe:

San José ha sido llamado por Dios para servir directamente a la persona y a la misión de Jesús mediante el ejercicio de su paternidad; de este modo él coopera en la plenitud de los tiempos en el gran misterio de la redención y es verdaderamente «ministro de la salvación»[21]. Su paternidad se ha expresado concretamente «al haber hecho de su vida un servicio, un sacrificio, al misterio de la encarnación y a la misión redentora que está unida a él; al haber hecho uso de la autoridad legal, que le correspondía sobre la Sagrada Familia, para hacerle don total de sí, de su vida y de su trabajo; al haber convertido su vocación humana al amor doméstico con la oblación sobrehumana de sí, de su corazón y de toda capacidad, en el amor puesto al servicio del Mesías, que crece en su casa». Pablo VI, *Alocución* (19 de marzo de 966): *Insegnamenti*, IV (1966), p. 110.

La liturgia, al recordar que han sido confiados «a la fiel custodia de san José los primeros misterios de la salvación de los hombres», (Cf. *Missale Romanum, Collecta*: in «Sollemnitate S. Ioseph Sponsi B. M. V.») precisa también que «Dios le ha puesto al cuidado de su familia, como siervo fiel y prudente, para que custodiara como padre a su Hijo unigénito» (Cf. *Ibid., Praefatio* in «Sollemnitate S. Ioseph Sponsi B. M. V.» . León XIII) subraya la sublimidad de esta misión: «El se impone entre todos por su augusta dignidad, dado que por disposición divina fue custodio y, en la creencia de los hombres, padre del Hijo de Dios. De donde se seguía que el Verbo de Dios se sometiera a José, le obedeciera y le diera aquel honor y aquella reverencia que los hijos deben a su propio padre» (Carta Encíclica *Quamquam pluries* (15 de agosto de 1889): *l.c.*, p. 178.)

Al no ser conceible que a una misión tan sublime no correspondan las cualidades exigidas para llevarla a cabo de forma adecuada, es necesario reconocer que José tuvo hacia Jesús «por don especial del cielo, todo aquel amor natural, toda aquella afectuosa solicitud que el corazón de un padre pueda conocer» (Pío XII, *Radiomensaje* a los alumnos de las escuelas católicas de los Estados Unidos de América (19 de febrero de 1958): *AAS* 50 (1958), P. 174.) Con la potestad paterna sobre Jesús, Dios ha otorgado también a José el amor correspondiente, aquel amor que tiene su fuente en el Padre, «de quien toma nombre toda familia en el cielo y en la tierra» (*Ef* 3, 15).

En los Evangelios se expone claramente la tarea paterna de José respecto a Jesús. De hecho, la salvación, que pasa a través de la humanidad de Jesús, se realiza en los gestos que forman parte diariamente de la vida familiar, respetando aquella «condescendencia» inherente a la economía de la encarnación. Los Evangelistas están muy atentos en mostrar cómo en la vida de Jesús nada se deja a la casualidad y todo se desarrolla según un plan divinamente preestablecido. La fórmula repetida a menudo: «Así sucedió, para que se cumplieran....» y la referencia del acontecimiento descrito a un texto del Antiguo Testamento, tienden a subrayar la unidad y la continuidad del proyecto, que alcanza en Cristo su cumplimiento.

Con la encarnación las «promesas» y las «figuras» del Antiguo Testamento se hacen «realidad»: lugares, personas, hechos y ritos se entremezclan según precisas órdenes divinas, transmitidas mediante el ministerio angélico y recibidos por criaturas particularmente sensibles a la voz de Dios. María es la humilde sierva del Señor, preparada desde la eternidad para la misión de ser Madre de Dios; José es aquel que Dios ha elegido para ser «el coordinador del nacimiento del Señor» (Orígenes, *Hom. XIII in Lucam*, 7: S. Ch. 87, pp. 214 s) aquél que tiene el encargo de proveer a la inserción «ordenada» del Hijo de Dios en el mundo, en el respeto de las disposiciones divinas y de las leyes humanas. Toda la vida, tanto «privada» como «escondida» de Jesús ha sido confiada a su custodia.


