FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Two weeks ago, I began a 30 day silent retreat called the "Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius" at a retreat house in the midwestern United States. The Spiritual Exercises were created by St. Ignatius of Loyola. The retreatant spends five hours in contemplation daily, reflecting on the mysteries of the Lord's life and on one's own life in light of Jesus's life. Of course, the five hours are not prayed all at once! They are spread out throughout the day. Each day, the retreatant meets with a retreat director to discuss how things are going. In addition to meditating for the five hours, I also fulfill my daily obligations of praying the Sacrifice of the Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours. Meals and physical exercise fill out the daily schedule. I am very grateful for this time of intense prayer.

Each of the weeks during the Spiritual Exercises has a different focus. During the First Week, the retreatant reflects on one's own life in light of God's love and call to holiness. One is invited see how one's own sinfulness has been an obstacle to God's grace. The retreatant has the possibility to review his life and to make a general sacramental confession of his sins committed throughout his whole life. The idea is to open oneself up to God's forgiveness and purification in order to make room for His call. The retreatant finishes the first week meditating on the call to follow Jesus Christ.

During the Second Week, the meditations and prayers are centered on Christian discipleship. The retreatant reflects on Jesus's birth and baptism, the Sermon on the Mount, various accounts from Our Lord's ministry of healing and teaching and the account of the raising of Lazarus from the dead. God willing, one makes concrete decisions about how to follow Christ more closely and be a more faithful disciple.

During the Third Week, the retreatant meditates on the Last Supper and on Our Lord's arrest, Passion and Death. One reflects on Our Lord's love being poured out in the Eucharist. Finally, in the Fourth Week, the retreatant meditates on the Resurrection of Our Lord and the appearances of the Risen Lord to his disciples. Experiencing the joy of Easter moves the retreatant to joyfully desire to more fervently proclaim the good news.

Be assured of my prayers for all of you during my retreat. I look forward to seeing you again soon at the beginning of the new liturgical year!

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Hace dos semanas, comencé un retiro silencioso de 30 días llamado los "Ejercicios Espirituales de San Ignacio" en una casa de retiros en el medio oeste de los Estados Unidos. Los Ejercicios Espirituales fueron creados por San Ignacio de Loyola. En el retiro se pasan cinco horas en contemplación diariamente, reflexionando sobre los misterios de la vida del Señor y sobre la propia vida de uno del punto de vista de la vida de Jesús. ¡Por supuesto, las cinco horas no se rezan todas seguidas! Se extienden a lo largo del día. Cada día, el asistente al retiro se reúne con un director del retiro para hablar sobre cómo van las cosas. Además de meditar durante las cinco horas, también cumplo con mis obligaciones diarias del Sacrificio de la Misa y rezar las Liturgias de las Horas. Las comidas y el ejercicio físico completan el horario diario. Estoy muy agradecido por este tiempo de oración intensa.

Cada una de las semanas durante los Ejercicios Espirituales tiene un enfoque diferente. Durante la primera semana, el asistente en el retiro reflexiona sobre su propia vida enfocado en el amor de Dios y el llamado a la santidad. Se le invita a uno a ver cómo su propia pecaminosidad ha sido un obstáculo para la gracia de Dios. El asistente al retiro tiene la posibilidad de repasar su vida y hacer una confesión sacramental general de sus pecados cometidos a lo largo de toda su vida. La idea es abrirse al perdón y la purificación de Dios para dar cabida a Su llamado. El asistente al retiro termina la primera semana meditando sobre el llamado a seguir a Jesucristo.

Durante la Segunda Semana, las meditaciones y oraciones se centran en el discipulado cristiano. El asistente al retiro reflexiona sobre el nacimiento y el bautismo de Jesús, el Sermón del Monte, varios relatos del ministerio de sanidad y enseñanza de Nuestro Señor y el relato de la resurrección de Lázaro de entre los muertos. Si Dios quiere, uno toma decisiones concretas sobre cómo seguir a Cristo más de cerca y ser un discípulo más fiel.

Durante la Tercera Semana, el asistente medita

sobre la Última Cena y sobre el arresto de Nuestro Señor, Pasión y Muerte. Uno reflexiona sobre el amor de Nuestro Señor el cual es derramado en la Eucaristía. Finalmente, en la Cuarta Semana, el asistente al retiro medita sobre la Resurrección de Nuestro Señor y las apariciones del Señor Resucitado a sus discípulos. Experimentar la alegría de la Pascua mueve al reticente a desear con alegría proclamar más fervientemente la buena nueva.

Esten seguros de mis oraciones para todos ustedes durante mi retiro. ¡Espero verlos de nuevo pronto al comienzo del nuevo año litúrgico!
