FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Behold! All four candles of the Advent Wreath are ablazed. The four weeks of Advent are nearly complete. We now bridge from Advent to Christmas. Soon our church will be adorned with emboldened lights, fresh trees will fill the sanctuary and red flowers will overflow like a lovely army of petals. Our five senses will tell us that something great is about to happen – God is about to be “born”! Yes, God is coming. St. Paul in the Second Reading reminds us of the drama about to unfold. The long-promised messiah, “which he promised previously through the prophets in the holy Scriptures, the gospel about his Son, descended from David according to the flesh, but established as Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness... you also, who are called to belong to Jesus Christ.” (Cf. Romans 1:1-7).

The question now before us: “How will you respond to the birth of Jesus?” The answer is simple but challenging. The answer is sweet but also bitter. We must be obedient. Yes, the horrible “o” word. Obedience. We don't like that word in the modern world, which champions freedom as the ultimate goal. I see this all the time when I try to share the Catholic faith with others. The resistance is always the same. Recently on social media, where I post events and news of the parish, an old friend from 6th grade made a comment below a picture of the people gathering by millions at the shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City. The picture of the faithful was massive and awe inspiring. He mockingly wrote: “They are obedient! Good followers. No arguments/ no questions. What you want is a servant. Perfect!” After I read his comment, my first guttural reaction was to respond in kind, overwhelm with mockery of my own and belittle him with my towering intellect.

Luckily, I remembered the words of St. Peter, “have sincere love for each other, love one another deeply, from the heart.” (Cf. 1 Peter 1:22). That verse always stops me from my idiotic behavior. Instead, I simply pointed out the beauty of the Christian way of life. For us obedience is a virtue. Look at the amazing witness of St. Joseph in today's gospel. When he hears about Mary being pregnant with the Baby Jesus, he tries to quietly separate himself from her, so as not “to expose her to shame.” Then suddenly in a dream, an angel of the Lord appears to him and says, “do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home.” How did St. Joseph respond? He responded with the “o” word. Obedience. You and I are called to do the same with our lives. Beloved, if we want to be saints, if we want to be disciples after the heart of our Lord, if we want to be on fire with the same transforming “Spirit of holiness”, we must first be obedient to God's will. I know this is not a popular way to live in our modern culture but who cares. I don't want to go with the flow of the crowd. I want to be a rebel.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

¡Miren! Las cuatro velas de la Corona de Adviento están encendidas. Ya casi se completan las cuatro semanas de Adviento. Ahora comenzamos el puente entre el Adviento y la Navidad. Pronto nuestra iglesia estará adornada con llamativas luces, frescos árboles navideños adornarán el santuario y flores rojas se desbordarán como un hermoso ejército de pétalos. Nuestros cinco sentidos nos dirán que algo grandioso está por suceder: ¡Dios está por “nacer”! Sí, Dios viene. San Pablo en la Segunda Lectura nos recuerda el drama que está a punto de suceder. El Mesías largamente prometido, “que él había prometido antes por sus profetas en las santas Escrituras, acerca de su Hijo, nuestro Señor Jesucristo, que era del linaje de David según la carne, que fue declarado Hijo de Dios con poder, según el Espíritu de santidad ... entre las cuales estáis también vosotros, llamados a ser de Jesucristo”. (Cf. Rom 1,1-7).

La pregunta ahora ante nosotros: "¿Cómo responderás al nacimiento de Jesús?" La respuesta es simple pero desafiante. La respuesta es dulce pero también amarga. Debemos ser obedientes. Sí, la horrible palabra "o". Obediencia. No nos gusta esa palabra en el mundo moderno, el cual defiende la libertad como objetivo final. Siempre veo esto cuando trato de compartir la fe católica con otras personas. La resistencia es siempre la misma. Recientemente, en las redes sociales, donde publico eventos y noticias de la parroquia, un viejo amigo del sexto grado hizo un comentario debajo de una imagen que compartí de las personas reunidas por millones en el santuario de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe en la Ciudad de México. La imagen de los fieles era tremenda e inspiradora. Escribió sarcásticamente: "¡Son obedientes! Buenos seguidores. Sin argumentos/sin preguntas. Lo que quieres es un servidor. ¡Perfecto!" Después de leer su comentario, mi reacción gutural fue responderle de la misma manera, abrumarle con mi propio sarcasmo y menospreciarlo con mi intelecto imponente.

Por suerte, recordé las palabras de San Pedro, “mediante el Espíritu, para el amor fraternal no fingido, amaos unos a otros entrañablemente, *de corazón puro*”. (Cf. 1 Pedro 1:22). Ese verso siempre me detiene de mi comportamiento idiota. En cambio, simplemente señalé la belleza del estilo de vida cristiana. Para nosotros, la obediencia es una virtud. Mire el asombroso testimonio de San José en el evangelio de hoy. Cuando se entera de que María está embarazada del Niño Jesús, trata de separarse discretamente de ella para no “exponerla a la vergüenza”. Entonces, de repente, en un sueño, un ángel del Señor se le aparece y le dice: “no temas recibir a María tu esposa en tu casa”. ¿Cómo respondió San José? Él respondió con la palabra "o". Obediencia. Tú y yo estamos llamados a hacer lo mismo con nuestras vidas. Queridos hermanos, si queremos ser santos, si queremos ser discípulos según el corazón de nuestro Señor, si queremos arder con el mismo “Espíritu de santidad” transformador, primero debemos ser obedientes a la voluntad de Dios. Sé que esta no es una forma popular de vivir en nuestra cultura moderna, pero a quién le importa. No quiero seguir la corriente de la multitud. Quiero ser un rebelde.

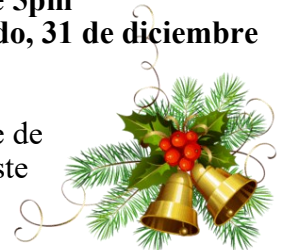
