

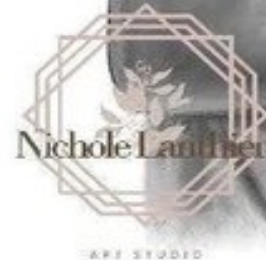

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

The Christmas celebration always leaves me with goosebumps. We behold the bright lights that pierces the darkness, no matter the density of the fog. The smell of evergreen trees permeates the room as their colors stay true, living up to their name. The banquet of food at our dinner tables makes us feel like royalty, dining sumptuously in our stoned castles, albeit in the suburbs. We rejoice, we sing, we laugh, and some of us even cry. We miss our loved ones during this time of year. Something about the Christmas season touches the soul deeply, regardless of where we are in our walk of faith.

I dare say Christmas reminds us that we are made for relationships; we are made for love. Never forget that. We constantly all bemoan the fact that Christmas has become commercialized. The pressure we feel to buy the perfect gift for that perfect someone can suffocate us from the true meaning of the season. Yet, even that constant complaint points to the intuitive gut reality that we know we are made for infinitely more. And it's true, we are more than mere consumers; we're made for communion. God knows this. After all, he created and designed us. He's woven each of us intimately in our mother's womb as the Prophet Isaiah reminded us, "The Lord called me before I was born, while I was in my mother's womb he named me." (Cf. Isaiah 49:1)

Keep this always in mind when we try to make sense of ourselves, the world, and even our precious religion. We are made for love. As a Catholic priest, I've been privileged to prepare souls to die. Families call me to enter into their darkest hour. Never once in all my years of priesthood have heard anyone on their deathbed bemoan this or that thing they could never buy. They never talk about how bedrooms they have or the karats of their shiny gold necklace. Never. They always talk about love, their spouses, their parents, their children and most fundamentally, they talk about their relationship with God.

Here now the beauty of the Christian faith doth shine. Love itself will become incarnate. Truth itself will take on a baby face: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it... The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us." (Cf. John 1:1-14) Ahh the goosebumps!

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

La celebración Navideña siempre me deja con la piel chinita. Miramos las luces brillantes que atraviesan la oscuridad, sin importar la densidad de la niebla. El olor de los árboles de hojas perenne (Pinos) impregnan el lugar mientras sus colores se mantienen reales, haciendo honor a su nombre. El banquete de comida en nuestras mesas nos hace sentir como reyes, cenando lujosamente en nuestros castillos de piedra, aunque sea en los suburbios. Estamos alegres, cantamos, reímos y algunos hasta lloramos. Extrañamos a nuestros seres queridos en esta época del año. Algo acerca de la temporada navideña toca el alma profundamente, independientemente de dónde nos encontremos en nuestra jornada de fe.

Me atrevo a decir que la Navidad nos recuerda que estamos hechos para las relaciones; estamos hechos para el amor. Nunca olvides eso. Todos lamentamos constantemente el hecho de que la Navidad se ha comercializado. La presión que sentimos por comprar el regalo perfecto para esa persona perfecta puede sofocarnos del verdadero significado de la temporada. Sin embargo, incluso esa queja constante nos conduce a la realidad intuitiva de que sabemos que estamos hechos infinitamente para más. Y es verdad, somos más que meros consumidores; estamos hechos para la comunión. Dios sabe esto. Después de todo, él nos creó y nos diseñó. Él nos ha entrelazado íntimamente a cada uno de nosotros en el vientre de nuestra madre, como nos recordó el profeta Isaías: " El Señor me llamó antes de que yo naciera, en el vientre de mi madre pronunció mi nombre." (Cf. Isaías 49:1)

Tengan esto siempre en mente cuando tratemos de dar sentido a nosotros mismos, al mundo e incluso a nuestra preciosa religión. Estamos hechos para el amor. Como sacerdote católico, he tenido el privilegio de preparar almas para la muerte. Las familias me llaman para entrar en su hora más oscura. Ni una sola vez en todos mis años de sacerdocio he escuchado a alguien en su lecho de muerte lamentarse de tal o cual cosa que nunca pudieron comprar. Nunca hablan de cuantos dormitorios tienen, ni de los quilates de oro en sus brillante collares. Nunca. Siempre hablan del amor, de sus cónyuges, de sus padres, de sus hijos y lo más fundamental, hablan de su relación con Dios.

Aquí ahora brilla la belleza de la fe cristiana. El amor mismo se encarnará. La verdad misma tomará un rostro de bebe: "En el principio era la Palabra, y la Palabra estaba ante Dios, y la Palabra era Dios. Ella estaba ante Dios en el principio. Por Ella se hizo todo, y nada llegó a ser sin Ella. Lo que fue hecho tenía vida en ella, y para los hombres la vida era luz. La luz brilla en las tinieblas, y las tinieblas no la recibieron. Y la Palabra se hizo carne, puso su tienda entre nosotros, y hemos visto su Gloria: la Gloria

que recibe del Padre el Hijo único, en él todo era don amoroso y verdad."(Cf. Juan 1:1-14) ¡Wow, la piel chinita!

En ese momento ellos, y nosotros, sabemos para qué ha servido toda la espera.
