FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

As most of you know, at the Masses last weekend it was announced that effective this July 1st, Bishop Jaime Soto has assigned me to serve full-time on the faculty of St. Patrick's Seminary in Menlo Park. As I noted in my remarks last weekend, it was a surprise when Bishop Soto first called me almost a year ago and asked me to spend a day each week at the seminary. As sometime happens, what is talked about as an idea becomes something more when it is put into practice. In my case, the seminary asked me to teach a course, or actually two courses. Initially, they wanted me to teach a course last academic semester and another one this semester. When I explained to the seminary folks that my planned sabbatical in the fall would make it difficult for me to teach a course in the fall, they asked if I could still teach a course this semester. Since there are normally two classes of 75 minutes each week for the 3 unit course that I was asked to teach, it was decided that I would teach one of the twice weekly sessions in-person and one by teleconference. Thus, the idea that Bishop Soto initially had in mind that I would spend one day a week at the seminary evolved into spending one day at the seminary, plus a part of another day teaching, plus the amount of time needed to prepare the lectures for each class time. Fortunately, during the first three weeks of my sabbatical I was able to live at the seminary and begin to do some reading and planning for the course that I am teaching this semester.

By now, I am already six weeks into the semester. The class that I am teaching is called "Theological Anthropology" which is basically a course on grace. The course explores how we are created in grace, how that grace was lost through original sin, how we are redeemed in Christ and how we will be in heaven. I teach virtually on Tuesdays and in-person on Fridays. In order to miss the freeway traffic, I have found the best time to drive to Menlo Park is in the evening. Thus, I usually drive there on Thursday evening after my day off, spend Thursday night and all day Friday at the seminary and return to Vacaville on Friday evening. I don't like being away from St. Mary's for two days in a row every week, but I know that the parish is in the good hands of Fr. Joseph, our excellent staff and our many generous volunteers.

This July will be a transition for all of us. I feel so blessed to be here at St. Mary's. You are very loving, faithful and affirming. When I was preparing to go on sabbatical last August, I realized that I was feeling anxious because I did not know how I would do without being able to be with you on a day to day basis. One of the things I learned when I served as the Vicar for Clergy for four years, was how much parishioners love their priests, despite our many weaknesses. This is a beautiful thing. Even though we are far from perfect, you support us through your faithfulness and goodness. I have certainly experienced

your love and support here.

Bishop Soto knows that we have a vibrant parish and he has expressed to me that he plans to appoint a pastor who will keep all the good things going that we have going. Hopefully, within a couple of months, we will know who the next pastor will be. In the meantime, we can pray that God's will be known and carried out. We can trust that as long as we stay faithful and obedient to God, God will bless us beyond measure. I have always believed that and have experienced it a number of times throughout the 24 years of my priesthood.

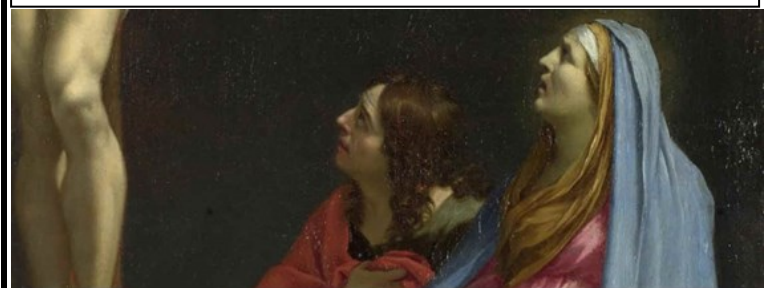

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Como la mayoría de ustedes saben, en las Misas del pasado fin de semana se anunció que, a partir del 1^o de julio, el Obispo Jaime Soto me ha asignado para servir a tiempo completo en la facultad del Seminario de San Patricio en Menlo Park. Como mencione en mis comentarios el fin de semana pasado, fue una sorpresa cuando el Obispo Soto me llamó por primera vez hace casi un año y me pidió que pasara un día a la semana en el seminario. Como sucede en ocasiones, lo que se habla como una idea se convierte en algo más cuando se pone en práctica. En mi caso, el seminario me pidió que enseñara un curso, o en realidad dos cursos. Inicialmente querían que enseñara un curso el último semestre académico y otro este semestre. Cuando le expliqué al personal del seminario que mi año sabático planificado para el otoño lo haría difícil que enseñara un curso en el otoño, me preguntaron si todavía podía enseñar un curso este semestre. Dado que normalmente hay dos clases de 75 minutos cada semana para el curso de 3 unidades que me pidieron que enseñara, se decidió que enseñaría una de las dos sesiones semanales en persona y otra por teleconferencia. Así, la idea que el Obispo Soto tenía inicialmente en mente de que yo pasaría un día a la semana en el seminario evolucionó a pasar un día en el seminario, más una parte de otro día enseñando, más el tiempo necesario que me toma para preparar las lecciones para cada clase. Afortunadamente, durante las primeras tres semanas de mi tiempo sabático pude vivir en el seminario y comenzar a leer y planificar el curso que estoy enseñando este semestre.

Hasta ahora, ya llevo seis semanas en el semestre. La clase que estoy enseñando se llama “Antropología Teológica”, que es básicamente un curso sobre la gracia. El curso explora cómo somos creados en gracia, cómo se perdió esa gracia a través del pecado original, cómo somos redimidos en Cristo y cómo estaremos en el cielo. Enseño virtualmente los martes y en persona los viernes. Para evitar el tráfico en la autopista, he notado que el mejor horario para conducir hasta Menlo Park es por la noche. Por lo tanto, generalmente me voy el jueves por la tarde después de mi día de descanso, paso la noche del jueves y todo el viernes en el seminario y regreso a Vacaville el viernes por la tarde. No me gusta estar lejos de Santa Maria durante dos días seguidos cada semana, pero sé que la parroquia está en las buenas manos del Padre. Joseph, nuestro excelente personal y nuestros muchos generosos voluntarios.

Este julio será una transición para todos nosotros. Me siento muy bendecido de estar aquí en Santa Maria.

Son muy cariñosos, fieles y afirmativos. Cuando me estaba preparando para tomarme el tiempo sabático en agosto pasado, me di cuenta de que me sentía ansioso porque no sabía cómo me iría sin poder estar con ustedes en el día a día. Una de las cosas que aprendí cuando serví como Vicario para el Clero durante cuatro años fue cuánto aman los feligreses a sus sacerdotes, a pesar de nuestras muchas debilidades. Esto es una cosa hermosa. Aunque estamos lejos de ser perfectos, ustedes nos sostienen con su fidelidad y bondad. Por supuesto que aquí he sentido su amor y apoyo.

El Obispo Soto sabe que tenemos una parroquia vibrante y me ha expresado que planea nombrar un párroco que mantendrá en marcha todas las cosas buenas que actualmente tenemos. Espero que, dentro de un par de meses, sabremos quién será el próximo párroco. Mientras tanto, podemos orar para que se conozca y se lleve a cabo la voluntad de Dios. Podemos confiar en que, mientras nos mantengamos fieles y obedientes a Dios, Dios nos bendecirá sin medida. Siempre lo he creído y lo he experimentado varias veces a lo largo de los 24 años de mi sacerdocio. Que tengan una semana bendecida.
