FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

We all want happiness. It's the universal truth, crossing all national boundaries, cultures, economic status, and religions. We cannot choose otherwise. All the decisions that we make each day, from the most minut to the biggest, all relate to that goal somehow. Even the mere act of getting up in the morning to a job we dislike, for example, is made to achieve happiness. The job allows me to earn a paycheck. The paycheck allows me to pay my mortgage. The mortgage gives me a warm, safe place to sleep and raise my family. Sleeping and being with my family makes me happy (at least when they are not getting on my nerves!). We all desire to be happy. Many of us make it our goal in life. However, for the Christian disciple, this type of happiness cannot be our main objective. This type of happiness will always depend on our circumstances. Our life experience tells us that we cannot control all of the events of our lives, as hard we try. We're often left frustrated and sometimes, even bitter at our lives. We need a better definition of happiness.

Luckily, the Church has a rich answer. Fr. Robert Spitzer, who used to be the president of Gonzaga University in Washington, has done brilliant work on this subject. He wrote an entire book exploring happiness, titled, *Finding True Happiness: Satisfying Our Restless Hearts*. He brilliantly synthesizes the teachings of the ancient Greek philosophers such as Plato, Aristotle, and the great Catholic theologians of the Early Church like St. Augustine and St. Thomas Aquinas. We can think of happiness on four levels. The first (1) is "pleasure", which is based on our sensual appetites and passions, like eating a delicious steak or driving a nice big truck. There's a level of euphoria that we feel at this level of happiness is immediate but short lived. The second (2) level of happiness is more complex, called the "ego-comparative happiness." It engages my higher abilities, like mastering a skill. The elevation of the self is the primary goal here. I feel a deep sense of achievement when I earn my black belt in jiu jitsu after years of practice. However, it can create a sense of comparison with others and a sense of jealousy, fear of failure and isolation can arise if I sense they are more talented people than me.

The third level of happiness is called "contributive happiness." This higher form goes beyond our mere ego, which characterized the other two. On this level, we seek the good of another person. We strive to make a positive difference in the lives of those around us. We focus on self-sacrificial love, the family, and the wider community. In other words, our lives, is the greater good, not the elevation of my desires. The fourth and last level is called "Transcendent happiness". This reaches the depth of the human heart, from which flows our desire for the eternal qualities of unconditional truth, love, justice, and beauty. Here lies ultimate meaning. Happiness on this level is longer immediate and fading like the first level. No longer do my circumstances affect the core of my being. Happiness here endures through the darkness, pervades through the mountains and valleys of life, and runs deep like the Pacific Ocean. The Christian seeks his happiness here. In fact, for us, this happiness even has a

face – Jesus Christ. Now do you see why the blind man in this gospel this sunday rejoiced? Our Lord asked him, "Do you believe in the of Man?" He answered and said, "Who is he sir, that I may believe in him?" Jesus said to him, "You have seen him, and the one speaking with you is he." He said, "I do believe, Lord," and he worshiped him. (Cf. John 9:34-38)

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

Todos queremos la felicidad. Es la verdad universal, que cruza todas las fronteras nacionales, culturas, estatus económico y religiones. No podemos elegir de otra manera. Todas las decisiones que tomamos cada día, desde la más pequeña hasta la más grande, todas se relacionan de alguna manera con este objetivo. Incluso el mero hecho de levantarse por la mañana para ir a un trabajo que no nos gusta, por ejemplo, se hace para alcanzar la felicidad. El trabajo me permite ganar un sueldo. El cheque que gano me permite pagar mi hipoteca. La hipoteca me brinda un lugar cálido y seguro para dormir y criar a mi familia. Dormir y estar con mi familia me hace feliz (¡al menos cuando no me están poniendo de nervios!). Todos deseamos ser felices. Muchos de nosotros lo hacemos nuestra meta de vida. Sin embargo, para el discípulo cristiano, este tipo de felicidad no puede ser nuestro principal objetivo. Este tipo de felicidad siempre dependerá de nuestras circunstancias. Nuestra experiencia de vida nos dice que no podemos controlar todos los eventos de nuestras vidas, por mucho que lo intentemos. A menudo nos sentimos frustrados y, a veces, incluso amargados con nuestras vidas. Necesitamos una mejor definición de lo que es felicidad.

Afortunadamente, la Iglesia tiene una respuesta profunda. El Padre Robert Spitzer, quien era el presidente de la Universidad de Gonzaga en Washington, ha realizado un trabajo brillante sobre este tema. Escribió un libro completo explorando la felicidad, titulado *Encontrando la Verdadera Felicidad: Satisfaciendo Nuestros Corazones Inquietos*. El sintetiza brillantemente las enseñanzas de los antiguos filósofos griegos como Platón, Aristóteles y los grandes teólogos católicos de la Iglesia primitiva como San Agustín y Santo Tomás de Aquino. Podemos pensar en la felicidad en cuatro niveles. El **primero** (1) es el "placer", que se basa en nuestros apetitos y pasiones sensuales, como comer un bistec delicioso o conducir una camioneta grande y bonita. Hay un nivel de euforia que sentimos al nivel de la felicidad, pero de corta duración. El **segundo** (2) nivel de felicidad es más complejo, llamado "felicidad comparativa del ego". Involucra mis habilidades superiores, como dominar una habilidad. Elevarse uno mismo es el objetivo principal. Siento una profunda sensación de logro cuando gano mi cinturón negro en jiu jitsu, después de años de entrenamiento. Sin embargo, puede crear una sensación de comparación con los demás y un sentido de envidia, temor al fracaso y aislamiento pueden surgir, al sentir que otros tienen más talento que yo. El **tercer** nivel de felicidad se llama "felicidad contributiva". Esta forma superior va más allá de nuestro mero ego, el cual caracteriza a los otros dos. En este nivel, buscamos el bien de otras personas. Nos esforzamos por marcar una diferencia positiva en la vida de quienes nos rodean. Nos enfocamos en el amor abnegado, la familia y la comunidad en general. En otras palabras, nuestra vida, es el bien mayor, no la elevación de mis propios deseos. El **cuarto** y último nivel se llama "Felicidad trascendente". Esto llega a lo más profundo del corazón humano, de donde fluye nuestro deseo por las cualidades eternas de la verdad, el amor, la justicia y la belleza incondicionales. Aquí yace el significado máximo. La felicidad en este nivel es más inmediata y se desvanece como el primer nivel. Mis circunstancias ya no afectan el centro de mi

ser. La felicidad aquí perdura a través de la oscuridad, impregna las montañas y los valles de la vida y se extiende profundamente como el Océano Pacífico.

El cristiano busca aquí su felicidad. De hecho, para nosotros, esta felicidad incluso tiene un rostro: Jesucristo. ¿Ves ahora por qué el ciego en el evangelio de este domingo se alegró? Nuestro Señor le preguntó: "*¿Crees tú en el Hijo del hombre?*" Él contestó: "*¿Y quién es, Señor, para que yo crea en él?*" Jesús le dijo: "*Ya lo has visto; el que está hablando contigo, ése es*". Él dijo: "*Creo, Señor*". Y postrándose, lo adoró. (Cf. Juan 9, 34-38)
