FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

In January, Monsignor James Turro celebrated his 100th birthday. Monsignor Turro is a priest of the Archdiocese of Newark whom I first met at a yearly summer gathering with some brother priests. As an unofficial member of our group, the good monsignor did not talk much. When he did say something, it was always worth hearing. In recent years, he has not been able to join our group on account of the challenge of the travel. Some of you who subscribe to *Magnificat*, the monthly publication with the readings and prayers of the Mass and other reflections, may recognize his name. He used to be a contributor to *Magnificat*.

Among other things, Msgr. Turro is known for his brief, but profound homilies. As we preachers know, it is more difficult to give a brief homily than a long one. Msgr. Turro has the gift of being able to say something meaningful in five or six sentences that will stay with you throughout the day. Msgr. Turro is also a polyglot. He speaks Italian, German and French, has a good grasp of Latin and Greek and is able to read Hebrew. Two of Monsignor's aunts were religious sisters. It was from them that he felt moved to consider a vocation to the priesthood. After studying in the United States and Rome early in his priesthood, Msgr. Turro taught New Testament at a number of seminaries for over 60 years. As if he didn't have enough on his plate, Monsignor has found time to write four books over the years. At the top of the list of highlights during 74 years of priesthood, Msgr. Turro points to the time when Saint Mother Teresa of Calcutta invited him to give a retreat to her and to her fellow Missionaries of Charity.

You have heard me speak before about the importance of surrounding ourselves with people who encourage us to be holy. I am grateful for the brother priests here in the Diocese whom I see regularly for a monthly Holy Hour and supper. I give thanks for the brother priests with whom I get together with every summer. They are good role models for me; we check up on each other to make sure we are doing what we are supposed to be doing as priests. I am thankful that one of these priests has been Msgr. Turro. He has taught me much about charity and humility. To be sure, I could write a dozen of these articles about the number of laity, married and single, who encourage me in my vocation. Together, all of us who journey together in this life with our eyes fixed on the life to come, make up the "community of persons" that God calls us to foster, a community which in turn is fashioned after the "community of Divine Persons" of the Holy Trinity. As we walk with Jesus during this Lent, may we encourage and edify each other along the way by our holiness, piety and faithfulness. And, to Monsignor James Turro: *ad multos annos!*

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO

Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

En enero, el Monseñor James Turro celebró su cumpleaños número 100. El Monseñor Turro es un sacerdote de la Arquidiócesis de Newark a quien conocí por primera vez en una reunión anual de verano con algunos hermanos sacerdotes. Como miembro no oficial de nuestro grupo, el monseñor no habló mucho. Cuando decía algo, siempre valía la pena escucharlo. En los últimos años, no ha podido unirse a nuestro grupo debido al desafío del viaje. Algunos de ustedes que se subscriben al *Magnifica*, la publicación mensual con las lecturas y oraciones de la Misa y otras reflexiones, podrán reconocer su nombre. Solía ser colaborador de *Magnifica*.

Entre otras cosas, Monseñor Turro es conocido por sus breves, pero profundas homilias. Como sabemos los predicadores, es más difícil dar una homilia breve que una larga. El Monseñor Turro tiene el don de poder decir algo significativo en cinco o seis frases que permanecerán contigo durante todo el día. El Monseñor Turro también es plurilingüe. Habla italiano, alemán y francés, tiene una buena comprensión del latín y el griego y puede leer hebreo. Dos de las tías del Monseñor eran religiosas. Fue a través de ellas que se sintió la inquietud a considerar una vocación al sacerdocio. Después de estudiar en los Estados Unidos y Roma al principio de su sacerdocio, el Monseñor Turro enseñó el Nuevo Testamento en varios seminarios durante más de 60 años. Como si no tuviera suficiente en su plato, el Monseñor ha encontrado tiempo para escribir cuatro libros a lo largo de los años. Lo que más destaca en su lista durante sus 74 años de sacerdocio, el Monseñor Turro señala el momento en que Santa Madre Teresa de Calcuta lo invitó a dar un retiro a ella y a sus compañeras Misioneras de la Caridad.

Me han escuchado hablar antes sobre la importancia de rodearnos de personas que nos motiven a ser santos. Estoy agradecido por los hermanos sacerdotes aquí en la Diócesis con quienes me reúno regularmente para una Hora Santa mensual y una cena. Doy gracias por los hermanos sacerdotes con los que me reúno cada verano. Son buenos modelos a seguir para mí; estamos al pendiente unos a otros para asegurarnos de que estamos haciendo lo que se supone que debemos hacer como sacerdotes. Estoy agradecido de que uno de estos sacerdotes haya sido el Monseñor Turro. Me ha enseñado mucho sobre la caridad y la humildad. Sin duda, podría escribir una docena de estos artículos sobre el número de laicos, casados y solteros, que me motivan en mi vocación. Juntos, todos los que caminamos

juntos en esta vida con los ojos fijados en la vida venidera, formamos la "comunidad de personas" que Dios nos llama a fomentar, una comunidad que a su vez se forma según la "comunidad de Personas Divinas" de la Santísima Trinidad. Mientras caminamos con Jesús durante esta Cuaresma, que nos animemos y edifiquemos unos a otros en el camino por nuestra santidad, piedad y fidelidad. Y, para el Monseñor James Turro: ad multos annos!
