FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear St. Mary's Parishioners,

Last Sunday in my homily, I shared the story of two of our newest parishioners, Zachary and Justine (The photo on the bulletin cover is from their wedding last Saturday). Like so many of us, they carry huge burdens unbeknownst to those around them. In such moments, we cry out to God, begging for help. Yet oftentimes we're met with a gut-wrenching silence. We go on with our daily routine, barely knowing where to go next. This is what makes the Gospel story this Sunday of Mary and Martha so utterly human. They are us and we are them. We hear in the reading, a death in the family has tragically happened. Jesus arrives and immediately they cry out to him, "*Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died.*" (Cf. John 11:21). Don't we all say this to God in our darkest hour? We lament from the depths of our hearts begging him to act and yet nothing happens. Crickets. Am I just talking to myself?

It is here in this moment when the temptation to believe the lie of the "serpent" that was uttered into the ear of our first parents in Genesis 3:1, "Did God really say..." He slithers doubt into our hearts that God is not to be trusted. He tricks us to believe that God has abandoned us. God is indifferent to our pain. He has other more important things to do. Even more so, he tries to make us ultimately believe that God is not our loving Father. Yet despite the pain of losing her brother, Martha does not let her suffering destroy her faith. Instead, she trusts heroically, even though she does not fully comprehend God's plan. She stands resolute, "*But even now I know that whatever you ask of God, God will give you.*" (Cf. John 11:22). Look at her faith! She stays with Jesus in her pain.

As Jesus approaches the tomb of Lazarus, something spectacular happens next. We're told that "*Jesus wept.*" (Cf. John 13:35). This is the shortest scripture verse in the entire Bible. Its significance outshines its brevity. Here is God in the flesh staring directly into humanity's greatest fear. Standing toe to toe with death itself, Jesus does something strange – he cries. This shows us that God is not indifferent to our plight. In fact, God is closest to us when we think we have been abandoned. Or let's put it another way, God enters into our suffering *with* us. The lasting healing that we seek can only be found in the divine healer himself, Jesus Christ. This is precisely the reason that he comes.

When Justine and Zach walked into our parish on a random Sunday for Mass, they encountered this healing power of Christ. A flame was lit in their hearts at that Mass, which would change the course of their lives forever. They had their marriage blessed in the Church and now Zach will be baptized, confirmed, and receive his first Holy Communion this Easter vigil.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PÁRROCO



Estimados Feligreses de Santa María,

El domingo pasado en mi homilía, compartí la historia de dos de nuestros feligreses más nuevos, Zachary y Justine (La foto en la portada del boletín es de su boda el sábado pasado). Como muchos de nosotros, ellos llevan enormes cargas sin que las personas que les rodean lo sepan. En dichos momentos, clamamos a Dios, pidiendo ayuda. Sin embargo, a menudo nos encontramos con un silencio desgarrador. Continuamos con nuestra rutina diaria, sin saber a dónde dirigirnos. Esto hace que la historia del Evangelio de este domingo de María y Marta sea tan absolutamente humana. Ellas son nosotros y nosotros somos ellas. Escuchamos en la lectura, que una muerte en la familia sucedió trágicamente. Jesús llega e inmediatamente le gritan: “Señor, si hubieras estado aquí, no habría muerto mi hermano.” (Cf. Juan 11:21). ¿No le decimos todos esto a Dios en nuestra hora más oscura? Nos lamentamos desde lo más profundo de nuestro corazón rogándole que actúe y sin embargo no pasa nada. Absoluto silencio ¿Solo estoy hablando conmigo mismo?

Es aquí en este momento cuando la tentación de creer la mentira de la “serpiente” que pronuncio al oído de nuestros primeros padres en Génesis 3:1, “¿De verdad dijo Dios...?” Desliza la duda en nuestros corazones, de que Dios no es confiable. Nos engaña para que creamos que Dios nos ha abandonado. Que Dios es indiferente a nuestro dolor. Tiene otras cosas más importantes que hacer. Más aún, trata de hacernos creer ultimadamente que Dios no es nuestro Padre amoroso. Sin embargo, a pesar del dolor de perder a su hermano, Martha no permite que el sufrimiento destruya su fe. En cambio, confía heroicamente, aunque no comprende completamente el plan de Dios. Ella se muestra resuelta: “*Mas también sé ahora que todo lo que pidas a Dios, Dios te lo dará.*” (Cf. Juan 11:22). ¡Mira su fe! Ella se queda con Jesús en su dolor.

Cuando Jesús se acerca a la tumba de Lázaro, algo espectacular sucede enseguida. Se nos dice que “Jesús lloró”. (Cf. Juan 11:35). Este es el versículo bíblico más corto de toda la Biblia. Su significado eclipsa su brevedad. Aquí está Dios en la carne mirando directamente al mayor temor de la humanidad. De pie cara a cara con la muerte misma, Jesús hace algo extraño: llora. Esto nos muestra que Dios no es indiferente a nuestra situación. De hecho, Dios está más cerca de nosotros cuando pensamos que hemos sido abandonados. En otras palabras, Dios entra en nuestro sufrimiento con nosotros. La curación duradera que buscamos solo se puede encontrar en el mismo sanador divino, Jesucristo. Esta es precisamente la razón por la que viene.

Cuando Justine y Zach entraron a nuestra parroquia un domingo al azar para asistir a Misa, se encontraron con este poder sanador de Cristo. Una llama se encendió en sus corazones en esa Misa, que cambiaría el rumbo de sus vidas para siempre. Tuvieron la bendición de matrimonio en la Iglesia y ahora Zach será bautizado, confirmado y recibirá su primera Comunión en esta vigilia de Pascua.
